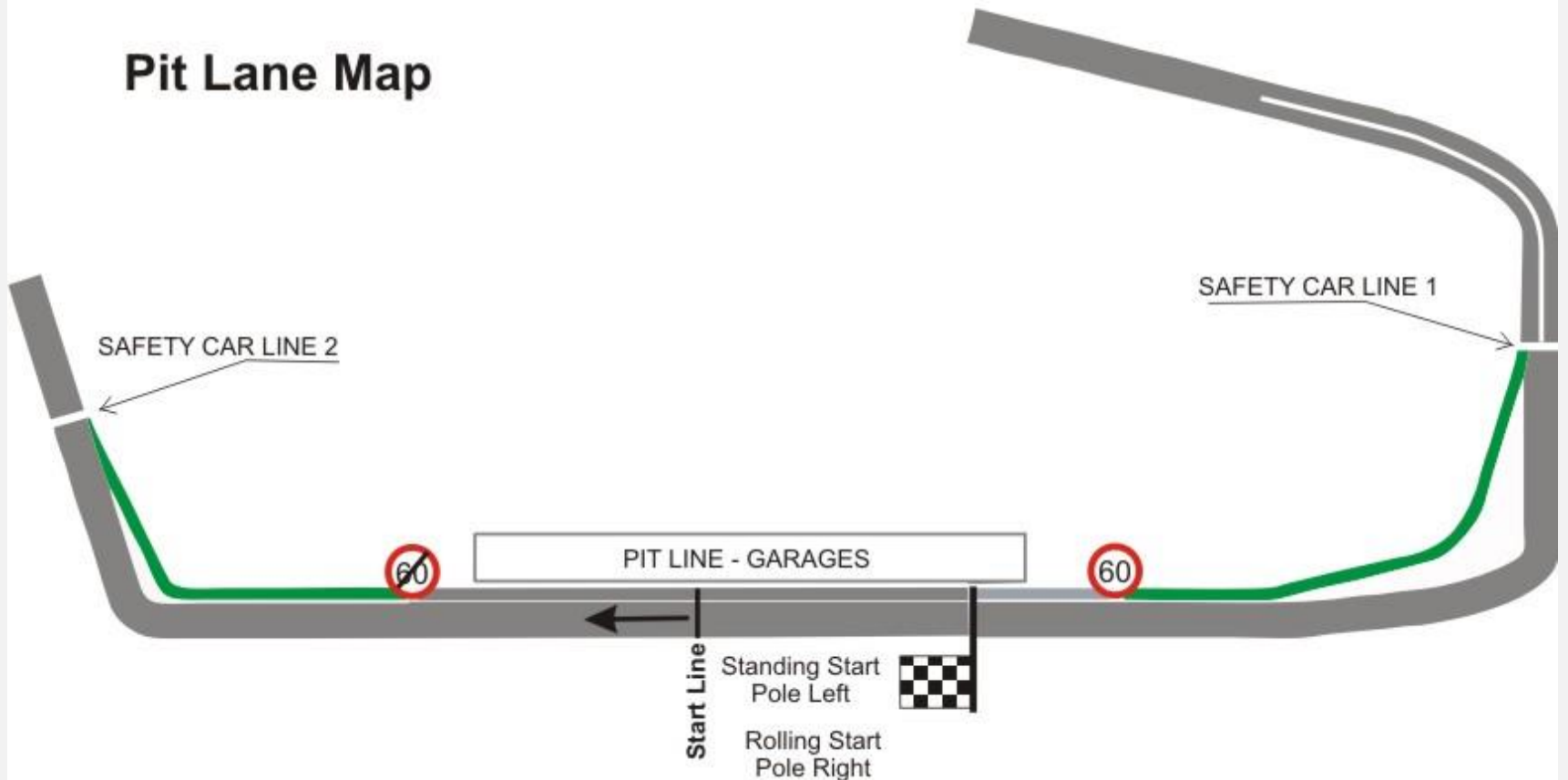

Pit entry white line

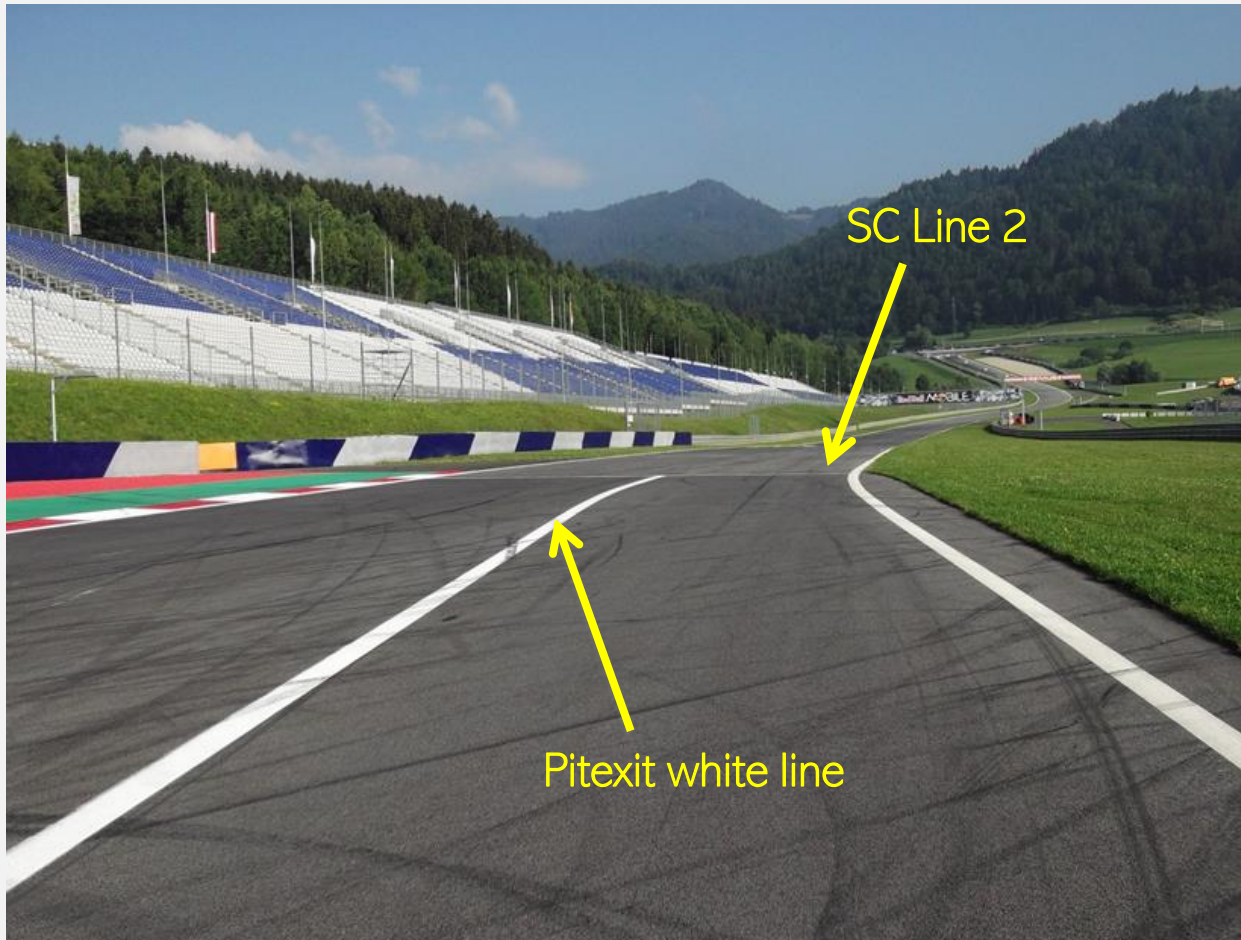


Pit entry/approach

- decide early enough - before turn 9 - and get into position on the right-hand side

It is forbidden to cross the white line at the pit lane exit

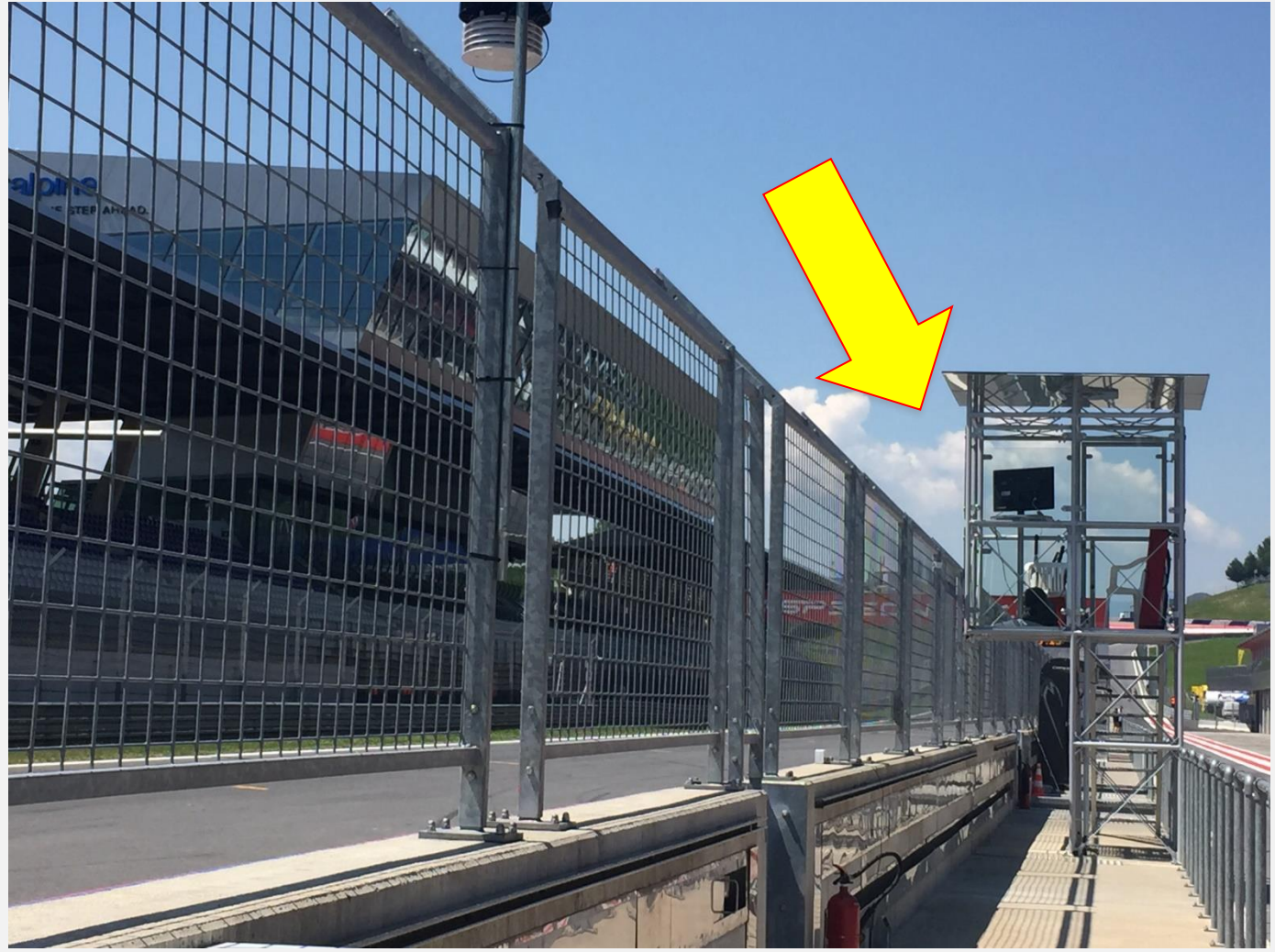

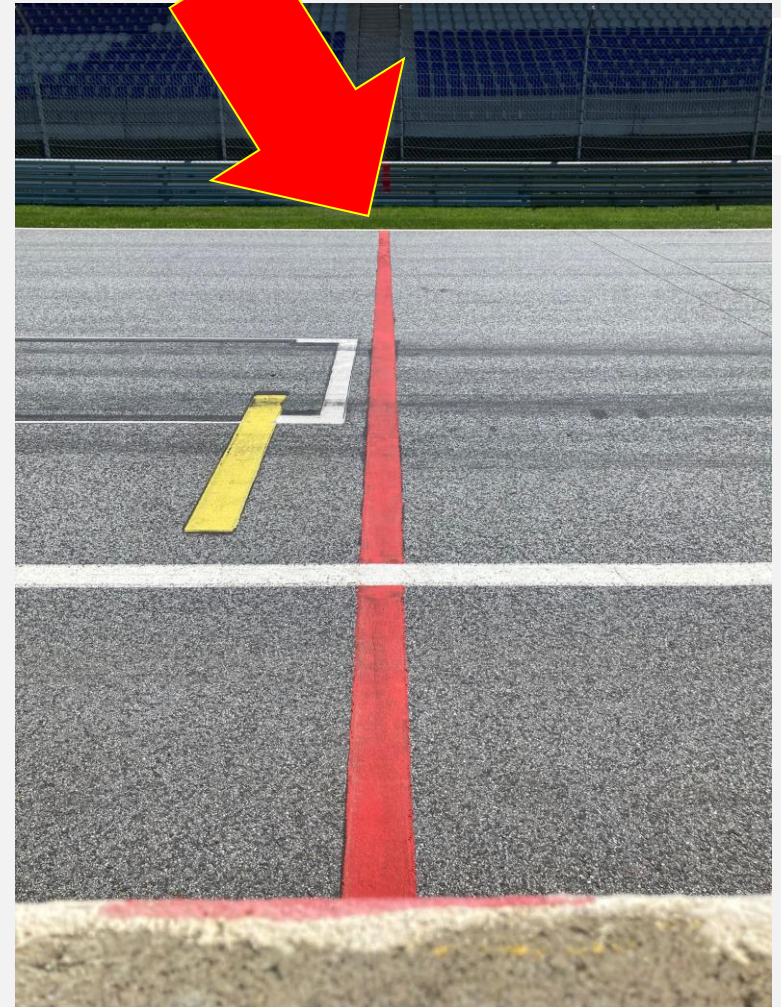

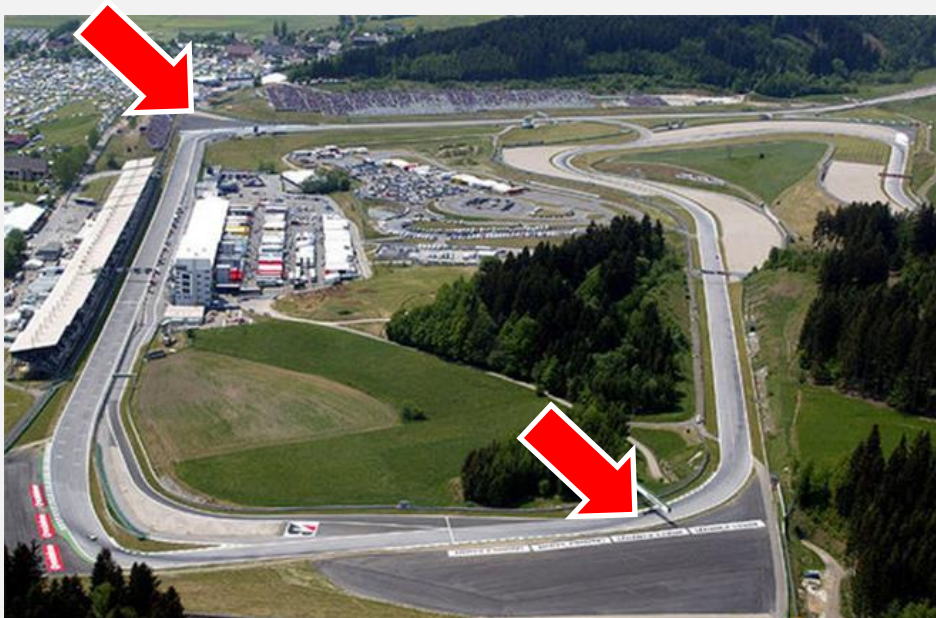


Opening for Cars



Track Limits

→ In accordance with the provisions of Article 33.3, the white lines define the track edges. During Qualifying and the Race, each time a driver fails to negotiate with the track limits, this will result in that lap time being invalidated by the Stewards.

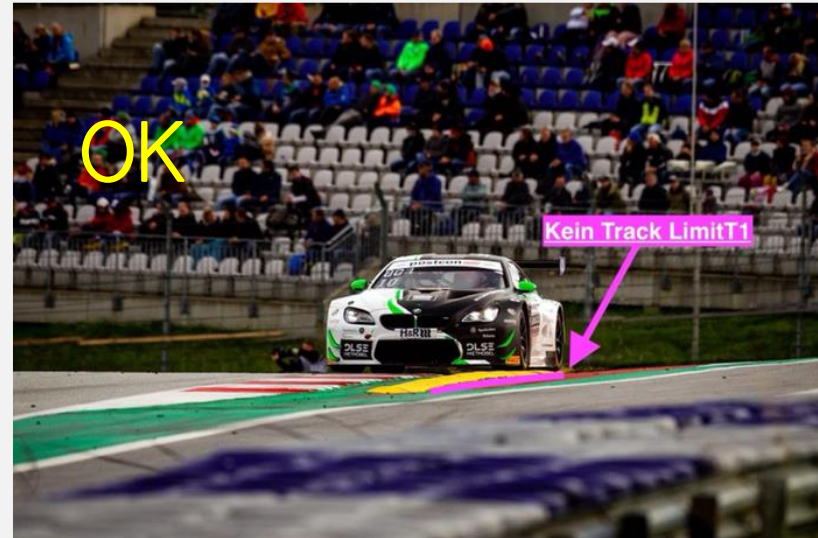

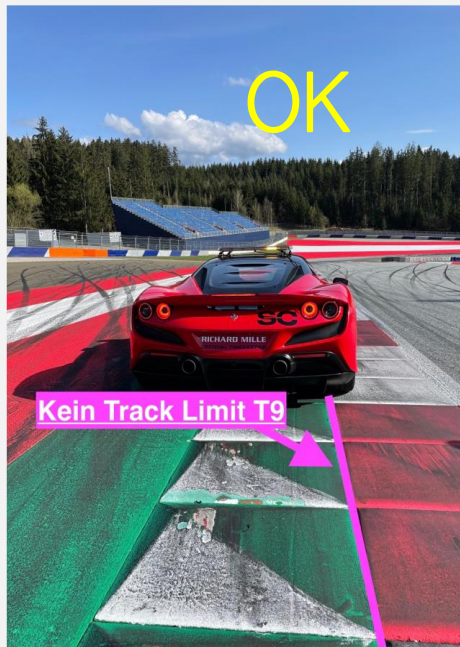

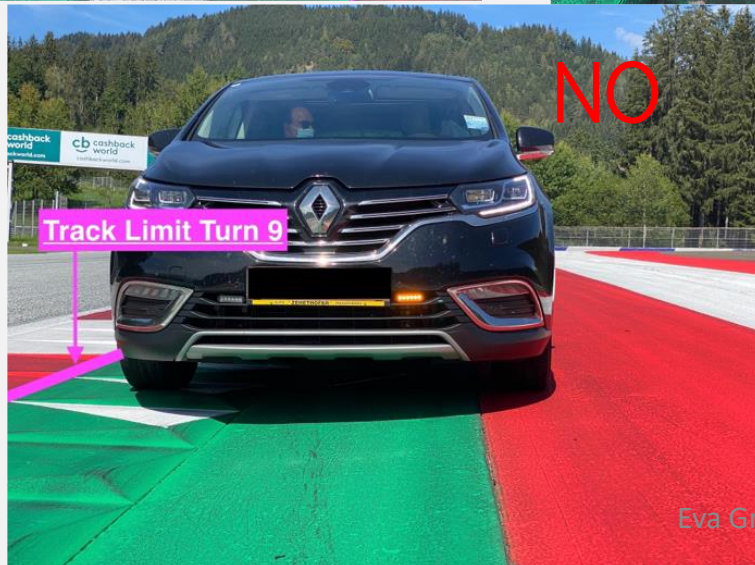


Infringement: Car is with 2 tyres over the yellow kerb

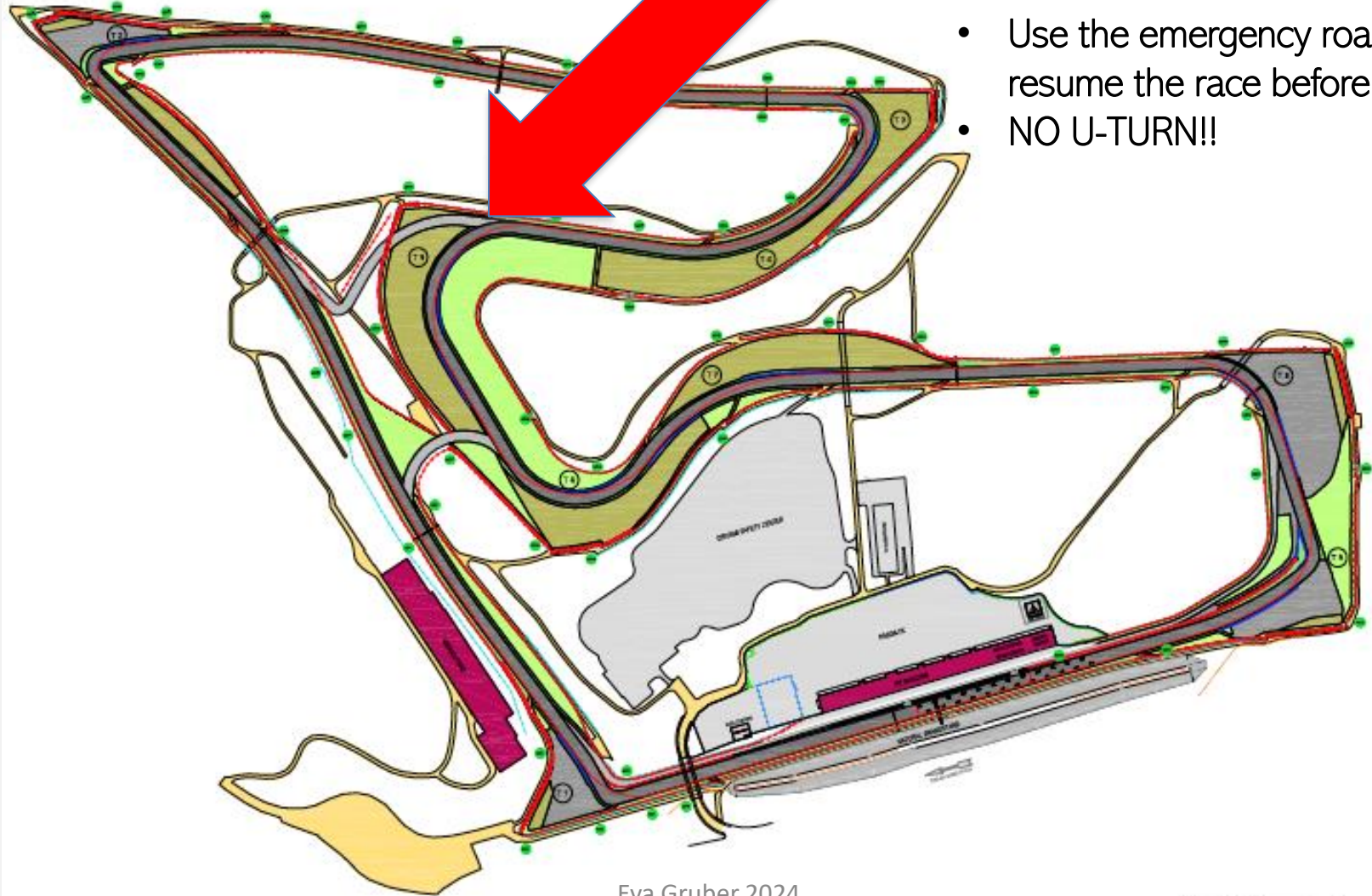

- Use the emergency road and resume the race before T7
- NO U-TURN!!

Signalling Flags



Please be aware of ISC signalling:

- Yellow means DANGER
- signalling takes place **via flags and/or electronic boards**, both signals must be respected in the same way
- SC boards means a **Safety Car is deployed**
- FCY boards means **Full course yellow**
- Blue means you are going to be overtaken or lapped
- **Red** means you have to **go slowly** to red line or to pit lane

Safety-Car



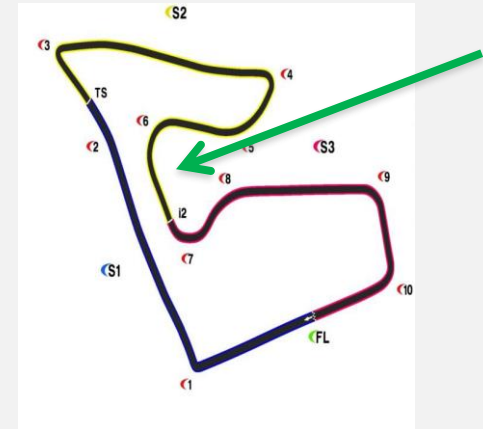
Once the Safety Car is deployed:

→ form up in line behind the safety car no more than 5 car lengths apart.

→ under certain circumstances the Safety Car may use the pit lane if, for example, the track is blocked between the pit entry and the pit exit. Therefore, if the Safety Car enters the pit lane and the lights remain on, drivers must follow it into the pits

Safety-Car

- when ordered to do so by the RD/Clerk of the Course, the observer in the safety car will use a green light to signal to any cars between it and the race leader that they should pass. These cars will continue at reduced speed and without overtaking until they reach the line of cars behind the safety car
- Safety Car lights off at T-6 / T-7
- once the lights on the Safety Car have been turned off the leader dictates the pace
- Restart: Once the cars (your car!) cross the Finish Line 1 overtaking is allowed!
- green flags are shown starting from the finish line and continuing around the ring



Full Course Yellow



- the Clerk of the Course/Race Director may order a "Full Course Yellow Phase" (FCY phase) as an alternative to the deployment of the safety car
- all competition vehicles must move in a row behind each other while maintaining the distance to the vehicle in front
- once the yellow flag and the FCY sign are displayed simultaneously at all marshals.....
- all drivers must immediately reduce their speed to 80 km/h on the entire route
- no emergency braking but also no slow coasting

Full Course Yellow

- Overtaking is prohibited
- exception
 - cars entering the pits **as soon** as it has crossed SC line 1
 - cars leaving the pit **before** as it has crossed SC line 2
 - cars slows down due to an obvious problem
- passing through the pit lane is only permitted if the car stops in the pits for repairs.
for repair work
- Drive-through/stop-and-go/time penalties may not be incurred during an "FCY phase"
- the resumption of the session after a "FCY phase" follows the same procedure
- when the yellow flags and the FCY signs are retracted, the green flag is shown at all marshals
and the start/finish line at the same time
- at this point, practice, qualifying or the race will resume on the entire track
- an FCY phase can be converted into an SC phase

Starting procedure

Rolling Start (Indianapolis – Start)

- All cars take up their position on the grid
- After you arrived the start position on the grid, please stop the engine!

10 Min



Pit exit green – only one reconnaissance lap

5 Min



Pit exit red

3 Min



Everybody except drivers, officials and team technical staff (one person) must leave the grid

1 Min



Engines must be started

30 sec

Any driver who is unable to start must signal this!!!!

Formation lap



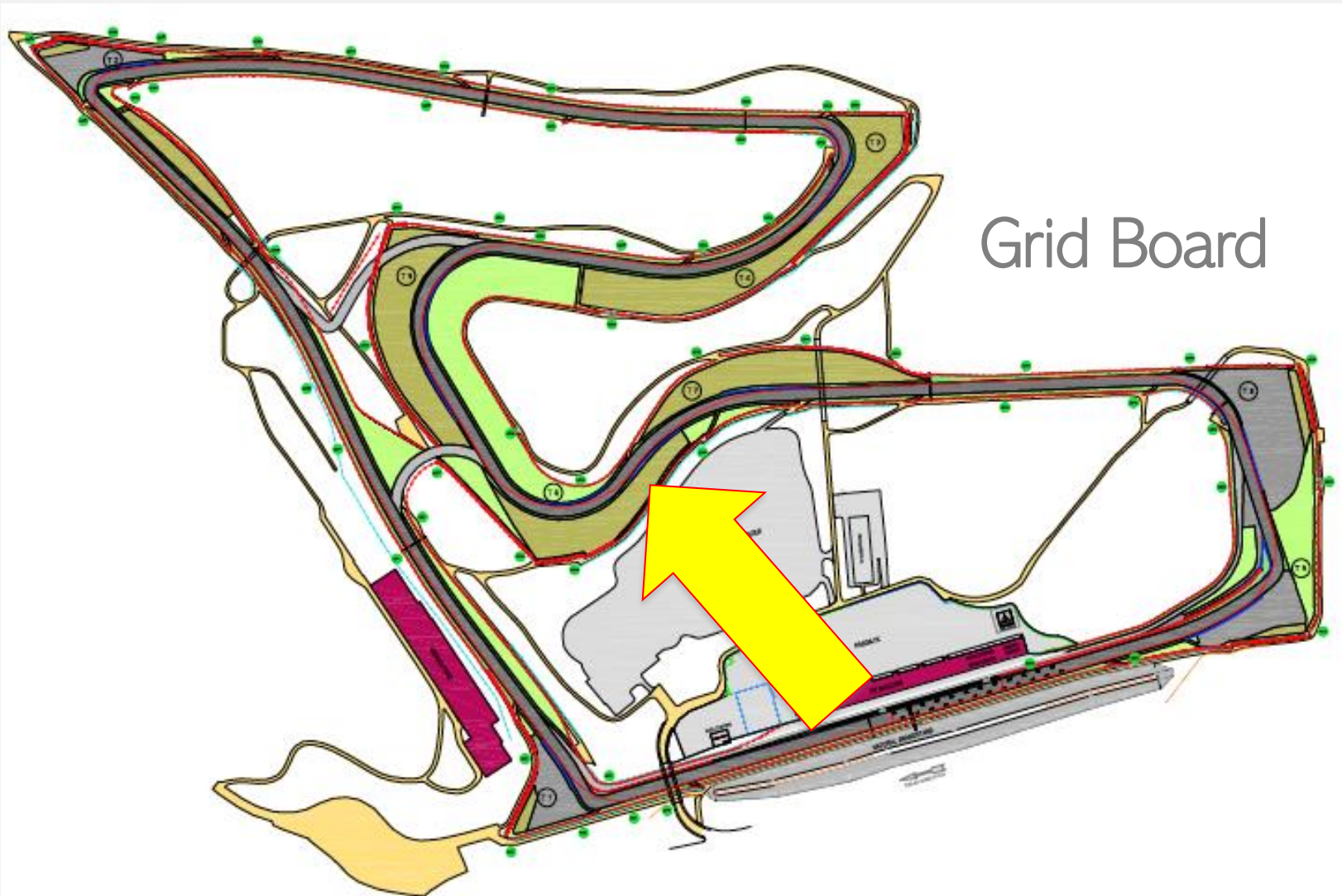
after showing the green flag the cars will begin the formation lap!



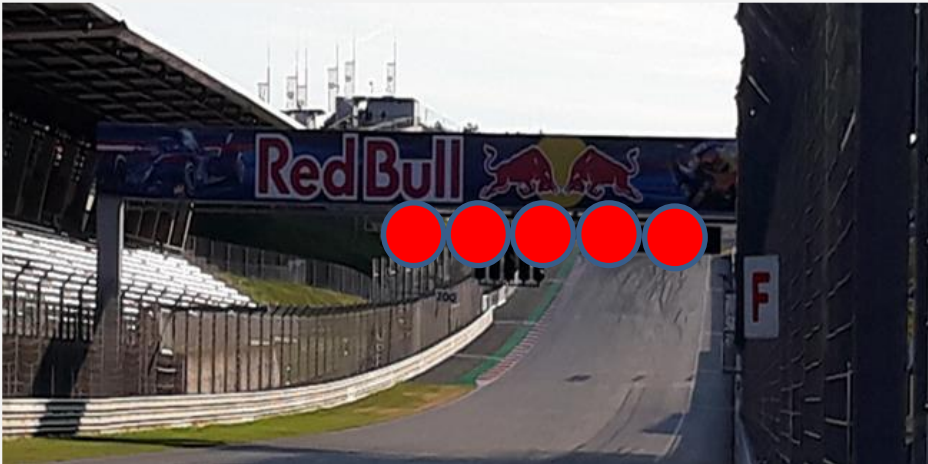
No overtaking!

- Formation must be kept as tight as possible, maximum three (3) car length!
- Pole must drive the same speed.
- all other Cars must hold their position until the start signal is given

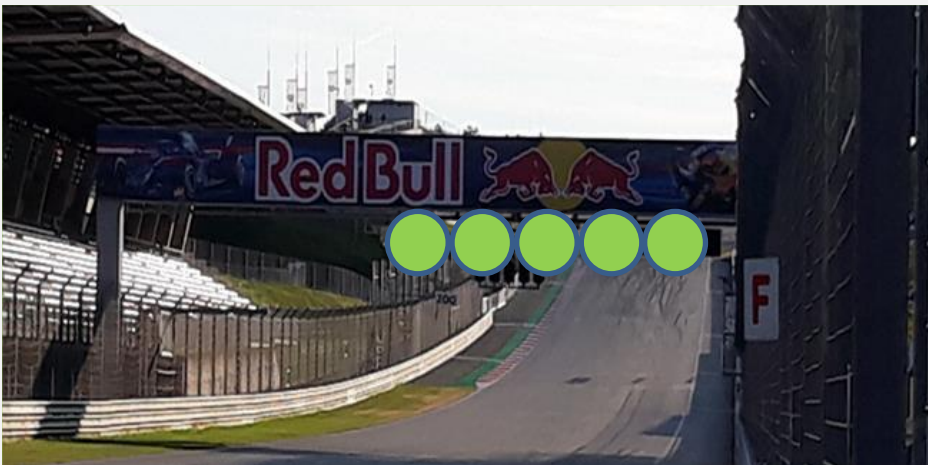

Start Procedure

Start: red lights off → green lights on → START

- when the green light is on, it is allowed to
- break the formation
- start overtaking

Start delayed

- Start countdown 5' Board
- Race distance the same

Extra Formation Lap

- Board Extraformation Lap if possible
- Light keeps in red
- all Marshal Posts with yellow Flag
- Pole dictates the Peace

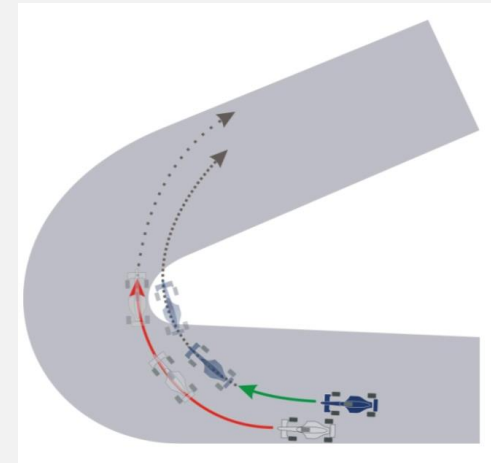
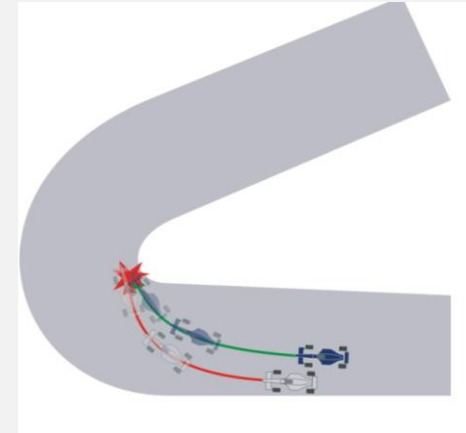
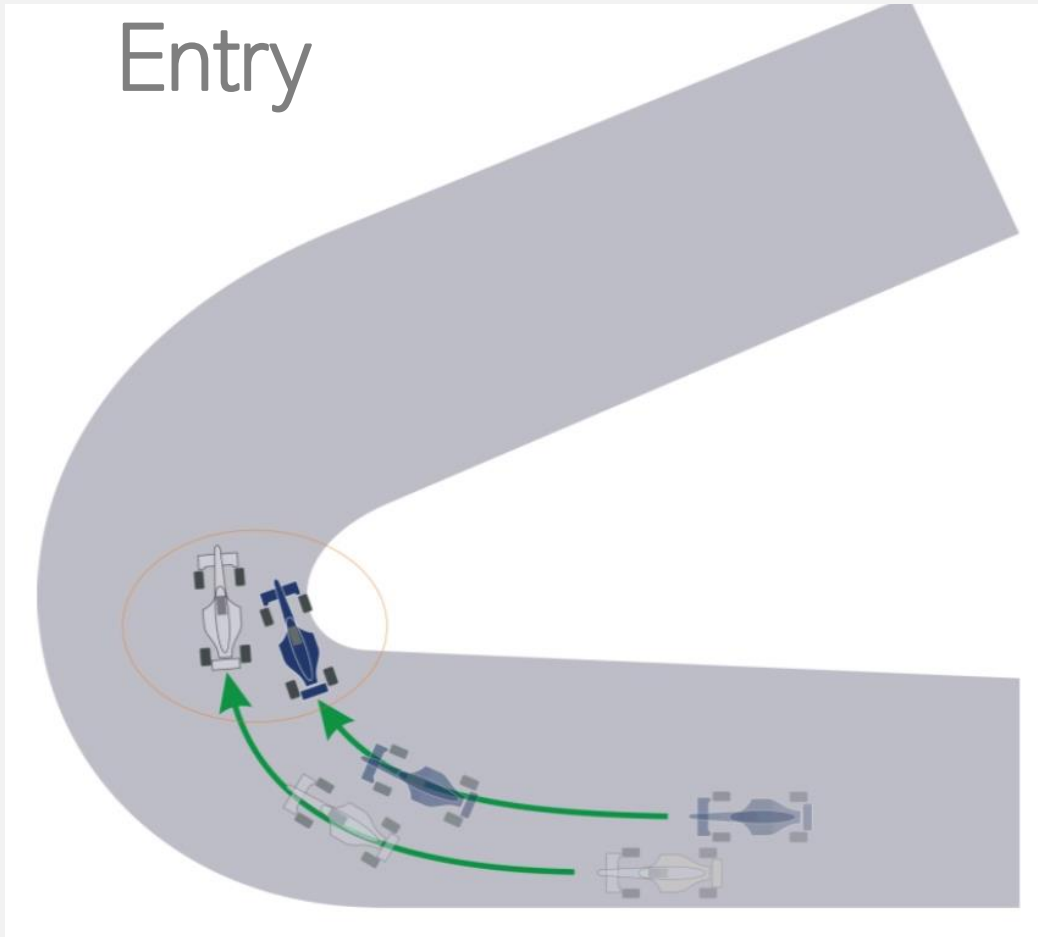
Driving behaviour

→ if you are defending your position only one change of direction is permitted!

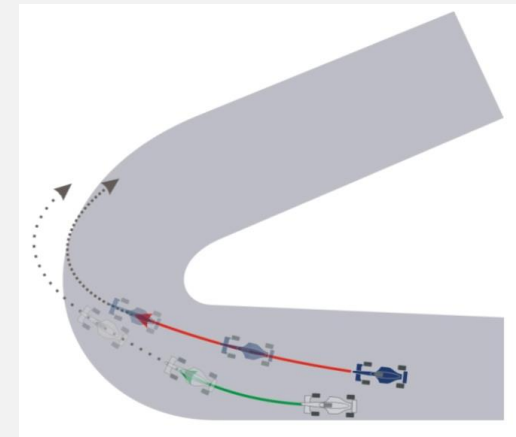
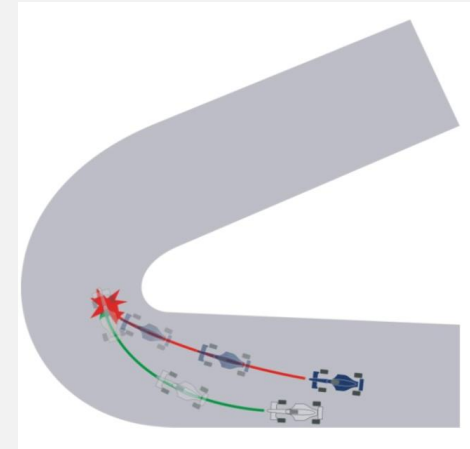
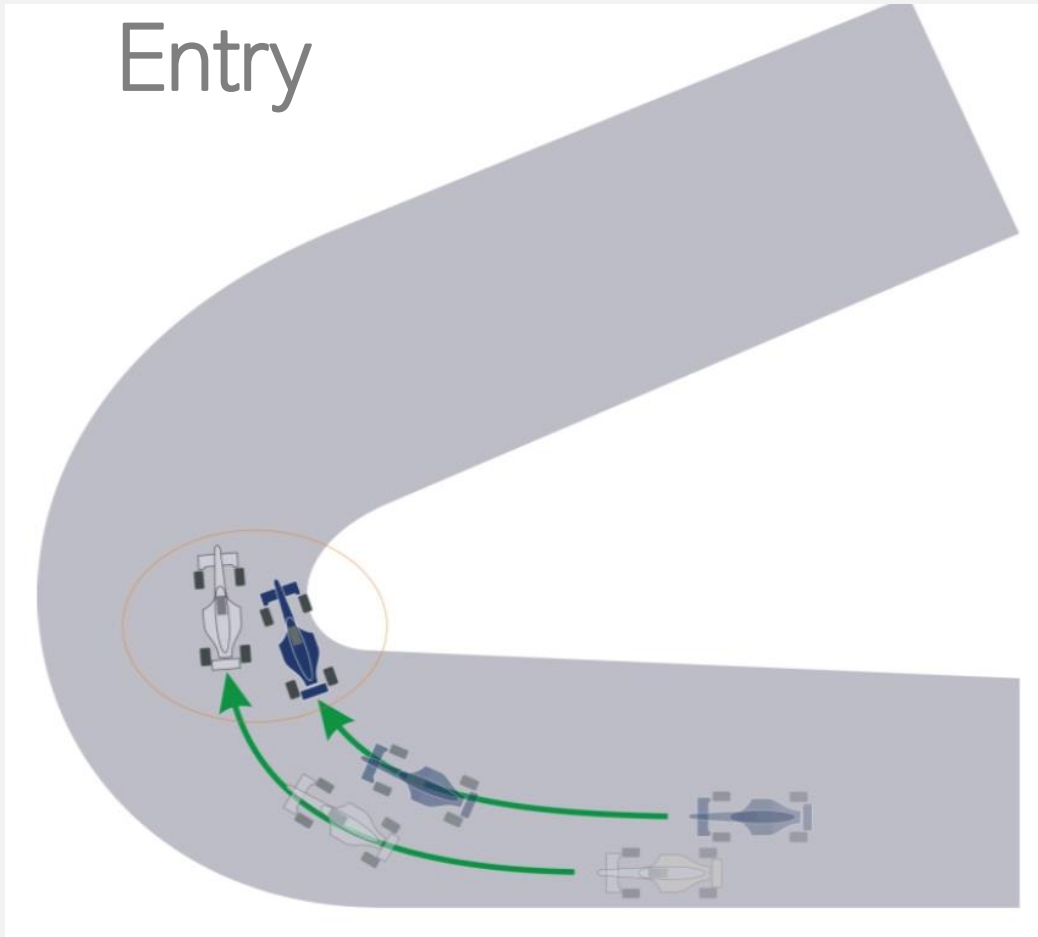
!no zigzagging!

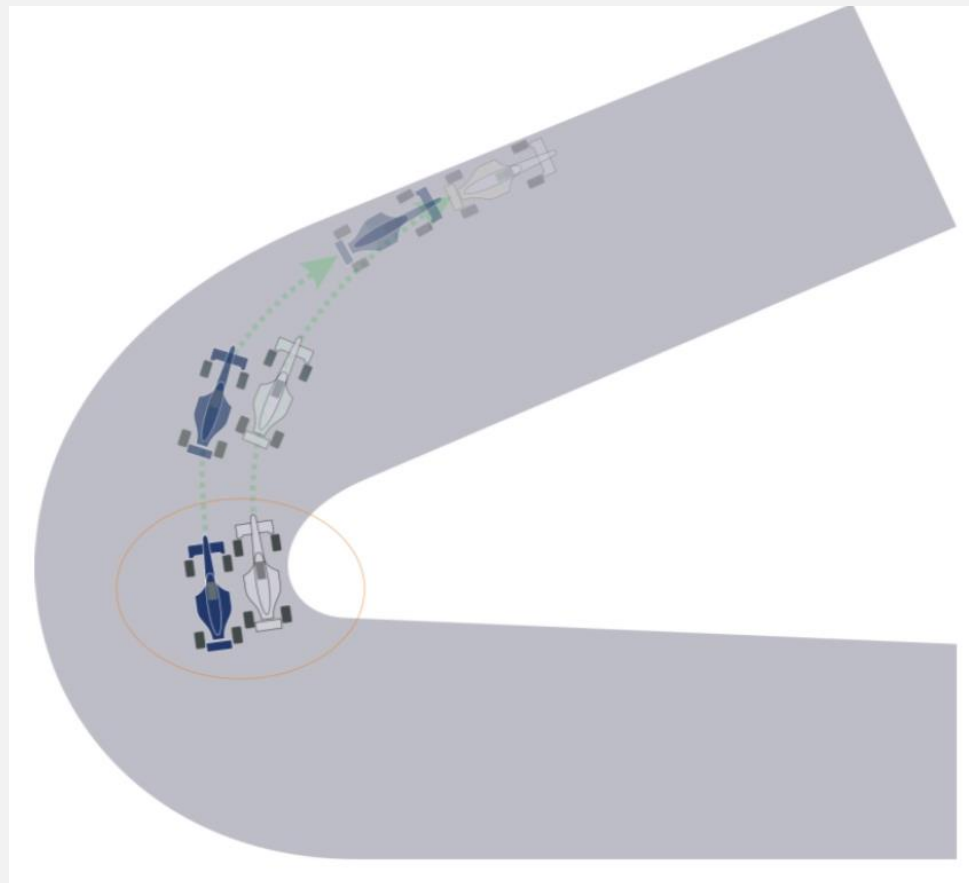
