Due to the delay in delivery of an integral part of the safety structure of the track the format and schedule for Round 9 (11th November) of the FIA World Rallycross Championship has been changed.

In order to facilitate this change the Stewards amend the Supplementary Regulations and the Sporting Regulations of the FIA World Rallycross Championship for this Event under the provision of 11.9.1. and 11.9.3.c. of the FIA International Sporting Code.

In summary Round 9 will consist of Official Practice, Qualifying Practice, two Heats, Semi-Finals and Final. Full Championship points will be awarded.

15.1.b. Free Practice is removed

15.1c Each Competition will comprise official practice and/or Qualifying Practice sessions, one SuperPole, four a minimum of two Heats, two Semi-Finals and one Final. In case a double-header is organised, the number of Heats will be reduced to three. A Qualifying Practice will be run over four timed laps. The Joker Lap will not be used during the session. Starting grid for the session will be based on the reverse order of the Championship standings and its overall classification will be based on the best lap for each driver with the fastest overall lap in first place. Touching a track marker during qualifying practice will lead to an automatic lap time cancellation.

15.5 Heats

There will be 2 3 to 4 Heats with a maximum of 5 cars starting abreast in each race over 5 laps as per Drawing No.1.]

15.5.1 Heat One (H1): Starting positions in the races will be based on the classification of the Qualifying Practice SuperPole. Slowest Drivers will participate in the first race.

15.5.2 Heat Two (H2): Race starters determined according to the classification of H1. Fastest Drivers will participate in the first race.
