The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Judge of Fact, regarding an incident between cars #12 Jens HVAAL and #8 Espen ISAKSÆTRE in H4 R2, of the FIA European RX3 Rallycross Championship, after having examined the video evidence MVRC, have considered the matter, determine the following:

<b>Driver and car No:</b>	#12 Jens HVAAL
<b>Competitor:</b>	Jens Hvaal
<b>Time (fact):</b>	11:15
<b>Session:</b>	H4 R2
<b>Fact:</b>	Side to side contact in T1
<b>Offence:</b>	Breach of FIA International Sporting Code 12.2.1.j, and Appendix L, Chapter V 2.(b)
<b>Decision:</b>	<b>REPRIMAND</b>
<b>Reason:</b>	After having reviewed the MVRC evidence the stewards find that #12 caused avoidable contact with #8 leading to T1 not respecting the driver to his left. In accordance with FIA European Rallycross Championship Sporting Regulations Article 17 (Penalties), item 23 the stewards consider this to be unsporting behaviour

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
