The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Judge of Fact, regarding an incident between cars #12 Jens HVAAL and #146 Joaquim MACHADO in H3 R1, of the FIA European RX3 Rallycross Championship, after having examined the video evidence MVRC, having summoned (summons no 02) and heard from the driver #12 Jens HVAAL and team representative Alexander HVAAL and driver #146 Joaquim MACHADO and team representative Nuno SILVANO, technician César SANTOS presented the on board camera footage have considered the matter, determine the following:

Driver and car No: #12 Jens HVAAL
Competitor: Jens Hvaal
Time (fact): 17:04
Session: H3 R1
Fact: Alleged contact
Offence: alleged breach of FIA International Sporting Code 12.2.1.j, and Appendix L, Chapter V 2.(b)
Decision: No further action
Reason: After having reviewed the MVRC evidence and viewed the onboard footage from both cars the stewards consider that this was avoidable. Never the less the steward’s concluded that no driver was wholly or predominately to blame for the incident and decided to take no further action.
#146 in T8 had rode the kerb and the car being slightly destabilised had reduced speed and contact was made to the rear of #12. Leading into T9 #12 was quicker into the corner and both vehicle made contact
