**Decision:** The driver is allowed to present the missing equipment to the scrutineers on

**Reason:** During the initial scrutineering it was found that the driver's equipment of #

17 Gustav BERGSTRÖM in the FIA World Rallycross Championship were missing. The scrutineers were told that the equipment is with the driver and the driver is not present at the track. The stewards in this instance therefore grant a waiver for the driver to present the missing equipment on the moring
