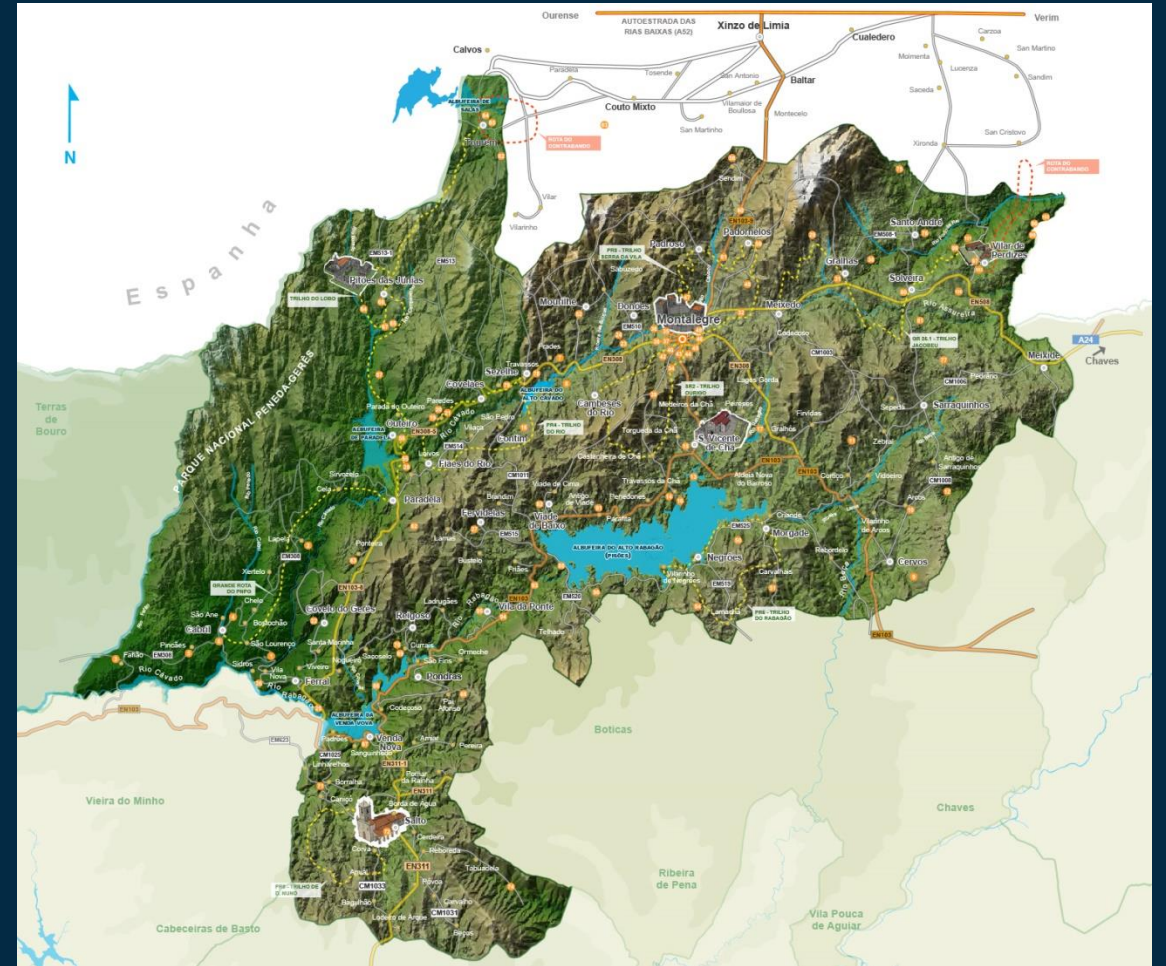
// NATIONAL & LOCAL INFORMATION

Montalegre is in Barroso, a sub-region of Trás-os-Montes e Alto Douro, in Vila Real district.

It is composed of the border municipality of Montalegre (about 800km²) and Boticas (322km²). This region is fringed to the north by Galiza (more than 70km of which borders Spain), to the west by Terras de Bouro, to the south by Cabeceiras de Basto, Vila Pouca and Ribeira de Pena and to the east by Chaves. The geography of Barroso is dominated by high lands and rocky formations, separated by valleys and plateaus.

The following mountains can be found in the Barrosão Plateau: Larouco (1,525m), Gerês (1,434m), Alturas (1,279m), Cabreira (1,262m) and Leiranco (1,156m). Rivers and various reservoirs hydrographically define Barroso. The Cávado, which springs in Larouco, is the main river in Montalegre municipality. The Beça river, both fertile in trout and famous for sport fishing joins the Cávado. With similar importance there are the Rabagão, Terva and Covas rivers, not forgetting the Alto Cávado, Alto Rabagão, Paradela and Venda Nova reservoirs.

The weather in the region is varied. This results in snow and low temperatures in the winters and contrastingly warm summers. The climate is summed-up by the local saying: '9 meses de inverno, 3 de inferno' (9 months of winter, 3 of hell).



// NATIONAL & LOCAL INFORMATION

WEATHER

In Montalegre, the climate is warm and temperate, except at higher altitude where it tends to be cold. The winters are rainier than the summers. The climate here is classified as Csb by the Köppen-Geiger system. The average temperature is 10.5°C. Precipitation here averages 1,348mm.

TIME ZONE

Montalegre uses the UTC+00:00 time zone. Daylight saving time (locally known as Hora de Verão, meaning 'summer time') is observed nationwide from the last Sunday in March to the last Sunday in October, so that every year, continental Portugal temporarily uses UTC+01:00.

CURRENCY

The local currency in Montalegre is Euro (€).
ATMs are widely available. Credit cards are accepted at most businesses, but smaller food places, including weekly markets are cash-only.

AIRPORTS

The closest airports are Francisco Sá Carneiro Airport in Oporto and Humberto Delgado Airport in Lisbon. There are also close airports in Vigo and Santiago de Compostela, Spain.

The international dialling code for Portugal is +351.
The national emergency number is 112.

// RADIO

During any event, the organisation, security and broadcasting usually imply there will be intensive use of related radiocommunications systems, such as the ones associated with race control, teams communication, etc.

In order to avoid interference between the different radiocommunications systems used to cover the event, it is necessary that the user requires a radio licence for such systems.

Radio Licence

The radio licence is an administrative authorisation, which confers upon the licence holder the right to use a radiocommunications station or network, within the scope of a radiocommunications service, in accordance with the terms and subject to the conditions established therein.

Frequency allocation at temporary events is based on the principle 'First come first served' so all licensing applications should be submitted in advance and at least 10 days prior to the date on which it is proposed the licence come into force.

Supervision

The supervisory technical teams will ensure that the use of the radiocommunications stations is in accordance with the legislation in force, free from harmful interferences, accessing all installations, lands, equipment, infrastructures, transport and service means of the entities, and of all collaborating parties, subject to the inspection and control of ANACOM, as established in ANACOM's statutes and Decree-Law no. 151-A/2000, of 20 July, as amended by Decree-Law no. 264/2009, of 28 September. Failure to comply with the legal rules in force, namely the provisions of the above-mentioned legal diploma, will constitute an offence subject to being punished with a fine.

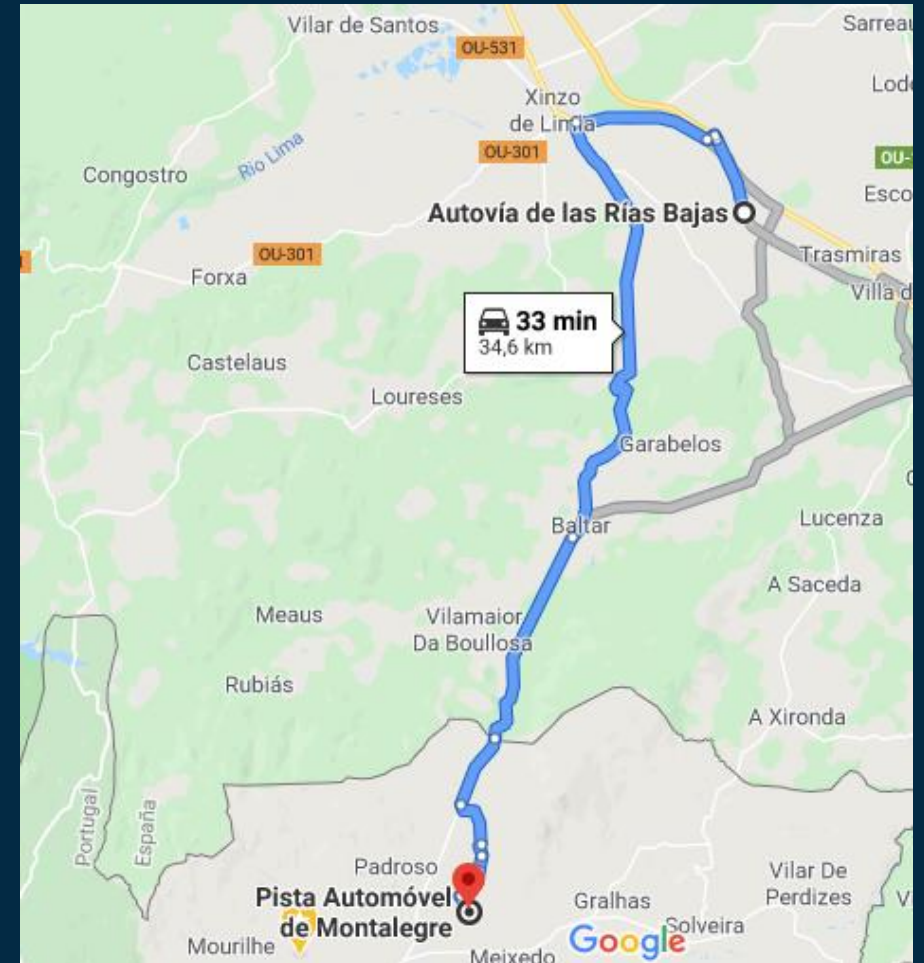

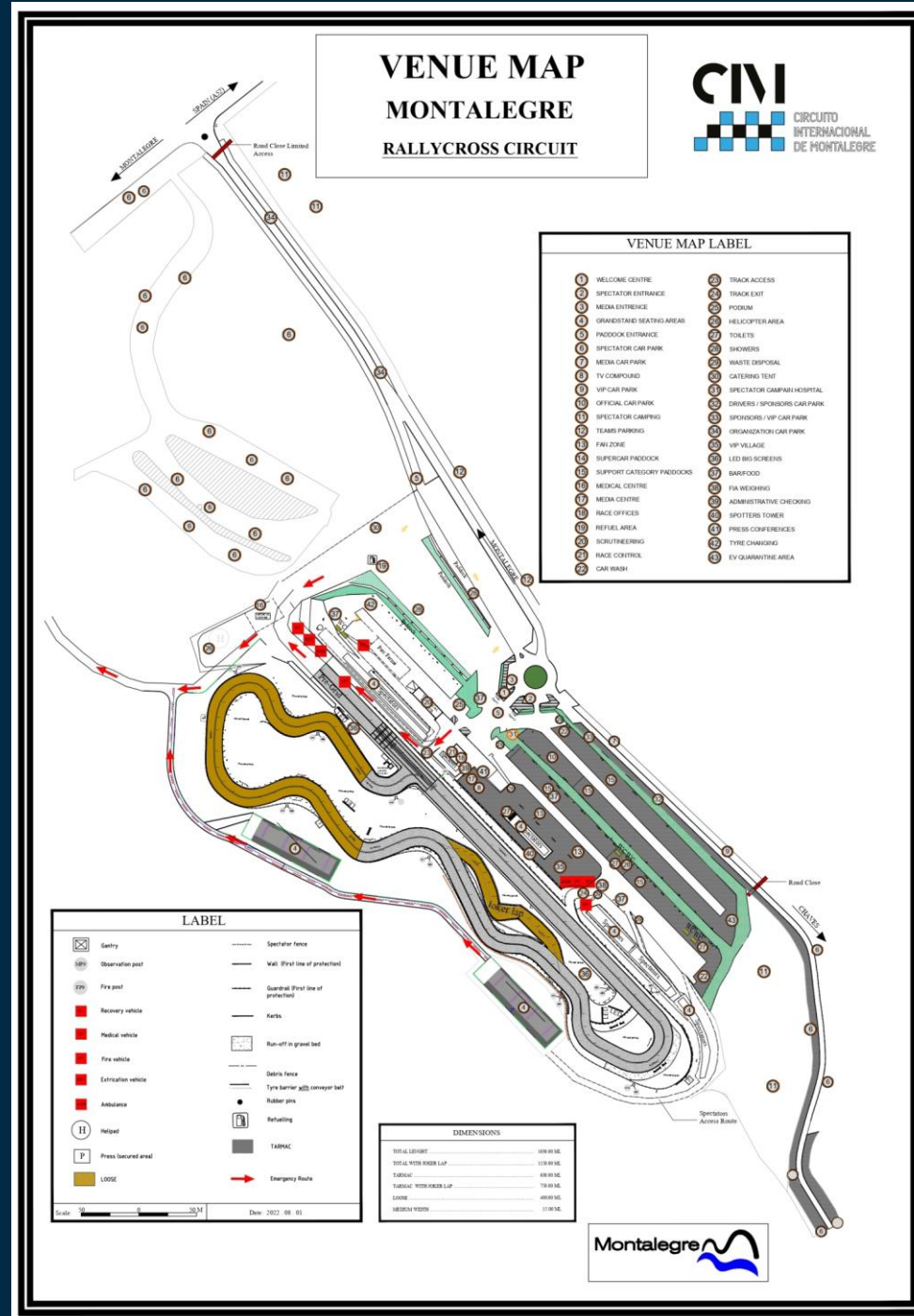

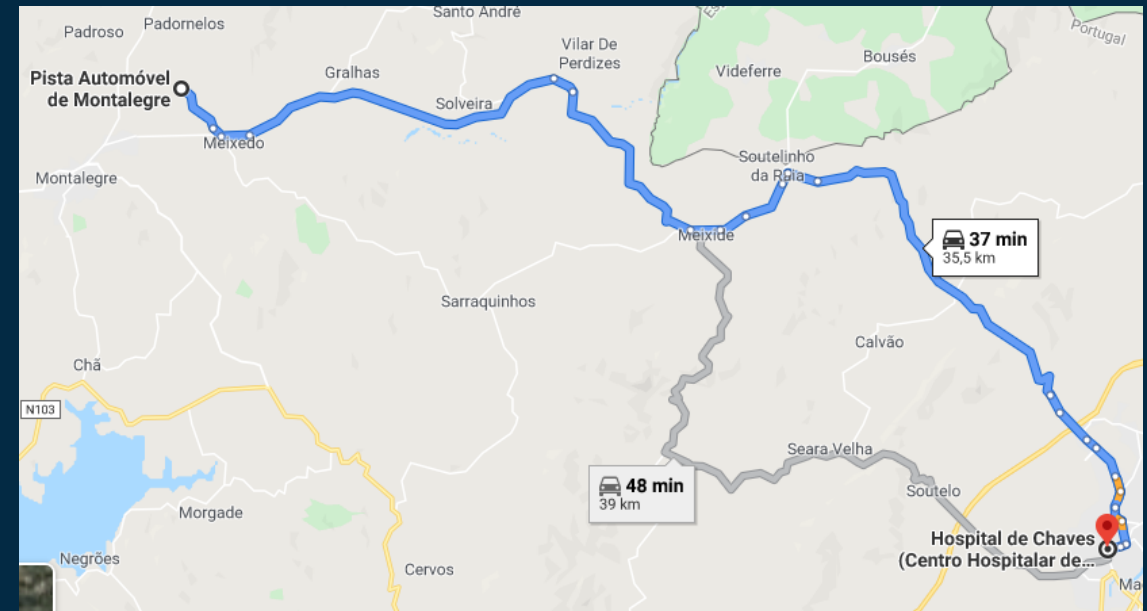
