The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Technical Delegate (document 6.3.2), regarding #21 Timmy HANSEN in the FIA World Rallycross Championship, having examined the report, have considered the following matter determine the following:

**Driver and car No:** #21 Timmy HANSEN  
**Competitor:** Hansen World RX Team  
**Time (fact):** 15.06.23 at 20:25  
**Session:** Initial Scrutineering  
**Fact:** New seals in a RESS  
**Offence:** Breach of 10.3.2 of the Sporting regulations of the FIA World Rallycross Championship  
**Decision:** Joker granted in accordance with 10.3.2  
**Reason:** **10.3 RESS, motors and inverters**

*10.3.2 Electric motors, RESS and inverters will be sealed. A Driver may use up to 2 (two) electric motors (or sets of seals), 1 (one) battery pack (or set of seals) and 2 (two) inverters (or sets of seals) in a Championship season. Electric motors, RESS and inverters will be sealed.*

*The penalty for any breach of this rule, the use of more components than allowed in the Championship year, will be the deduction of 15 (fifteen) Championship points for each offence. These points will be deducted from the Championship point total scored by the Driver and Team. In exceptional circumstances (accident generating serious damage to the components or technical problem not imputable to the Competitor), jokers may be granted at the discretion of the FIA stewards following the technical report from the appointed supplier and the FIA technical delegate.*

The stewards reviewed the report from the FIA Technical Delegate and due to the fact that the car was involved in an accident at a previous event and because of safety reasons the RESS had to be checked by the supplier resulting in new seals. A joker is granted in accordance with Article 10.3.2 of the Sporting regulations of the FIA World Rallycross Championship

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
