// IMPORTATION, CUSTOMS, TOLLS ETC.

Importation and Customs

On 31 December 2020, the temporary transition arrangements in place between the UK and the EU expired, affecting the importation of motorsport vehicles and equipment into the UK.

Because the United Kingdom is outside the EU, there are strong regulations regarding the temporary importation of cars and equipment. An ATA Carnet will be required to temporarily move motorsport vehicles and equipment across the border.

An ATA Carnet is an international Customs document that operates like a passport for your goods. It allows the temporary importation of goods into countries that are part of the ATA Carnet system (the EU and 40+ additional countries) and avoids you having to pay unnecessary taxes or duties.

ATA Carnets cover all goods that are temporarily entering the UK and exiting within a 12-month period. They do not cover disposable goods (oil, fluids) that will be used while out of the country or items that will not be returning to the EU.

The ATA Carnet simplifies the customs procedure into a single document and makes the importation process much quicker and easier to handle. To avoid unnecessary border delays and customs checks, the Carnet should be acquired in advance of travel.

Tolls

Competitors should be aware that there are Tolls payable within the vicinity of Lydden Hill as follows:

- **Dartford Crossing on M25** - see <https://www.gov.uk/pay-dartford-crossing-charge>
- **London** - Transport for London require vehicles to meet minimum emissions and safety standards to drive in London. Any vehicle failing to meet these standards must pay a daily charge either for Congestion Charge or the Ultra Low Emission Zone (ULEZ). // NATIONAL & LOCAL INFORMATION

Lydden Hill is a one mile, mixed surface, motor racing venue situated halfway between Canterbury and Dover offering an array of Motorsport action on two, three and four wheels. The mixed surface circuit made up of both asphalt and loose was the birthplace to Rallycross back in 1967 which has led to an amazing year of 50th anniversary celebrations throughout 2017. Since the last visit of the FIA World Rallycross Championship, the circuit now features a reprofiled banking section at Chessons and a new table top jump.

Being a natural amphitheatre the circuit offers supreme views of the whole circuit from almost all of the spectator viewing areas. Access to all areas during events means you will have the chance to be amongst the excitement in the paddock, surrounded by the adrenaline filled atmosphere while getting up close with the teams as they prepare for the race ahead

Currency

The local currency is GB Sterling (£). There are no ATMs on-site but debit/credit cards are widely accepted at the venue. The nearest ATM is situated at Tesco Dover which is 6 miles from the venue.

Transport

- **Airports** - Lydden is close to all London Airports including Heathrow, Gatwick, Stansted and City Airport
- **Ferry** - Dover Port is just 10 miles from the venue
- **Eurotunnel/Le Shuttle** - travel time from the Eurotunnel terminal to Lydden Hill is just 20 minutes (please use A20 and A2)
- **Train** - the nearest British Train station is Shepherdswell

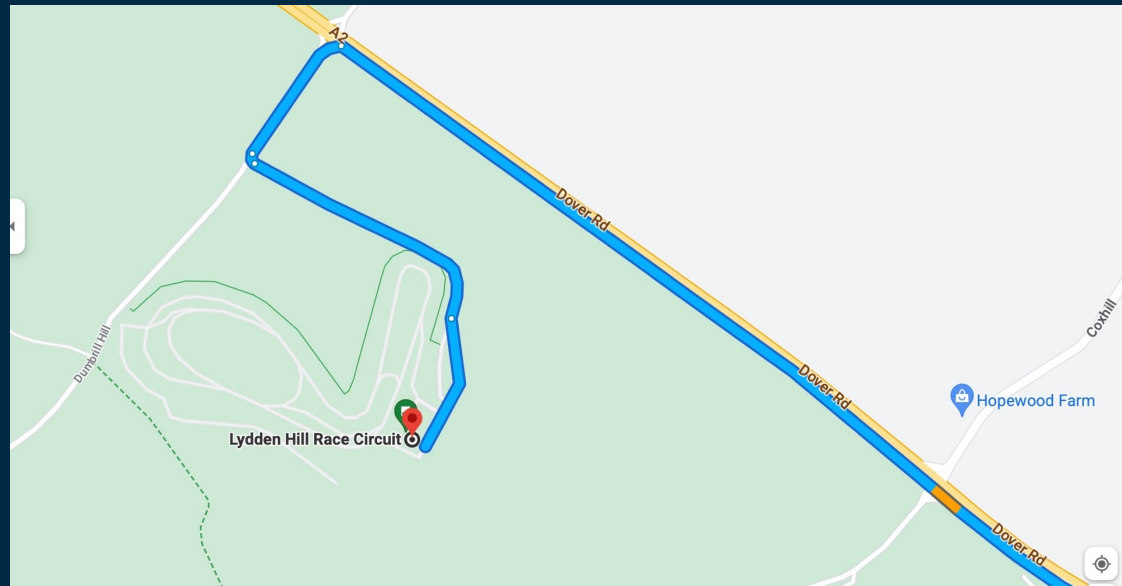

Venue Access

ALL vehicles (whether trucks, cars or vans) must access the venue via the A2 only. Traffic management will be in operation for the duration of the event. Any team vehicle trying to access the venue other than by the authorised route may be refused admission by circuit management. Admittance to the venue will only be permitted in accordance with the published arrival time. There is no access to race teams, etc. before 09:00 on Wednesday 19 July and no waiting on local roads/access road.

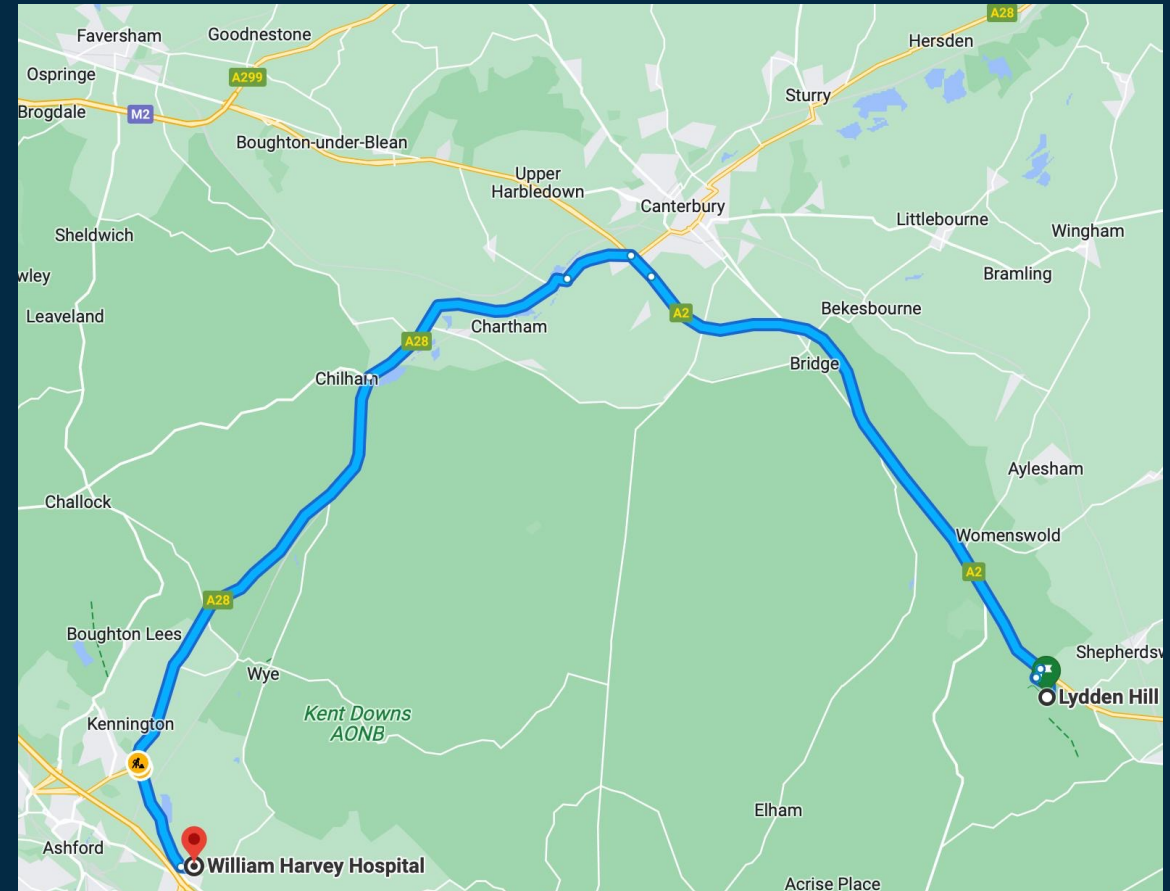

Directions to William Harvey Hospital from Lydden Hill Race Circuit

- Leave Lydden Hill circuit using main entrance
- Turn right and then join A2 towards Canterbury
- After 8.7 miles take the A28 exit towards Canterbury/Ashford
- Turn left onto Thanington Road/A28
- After 1.0 miles, at the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto A28
- After 3.5 miles turn left onto Ashford Road/A28
- After 6.8 miles turn left onto A2070
- After 1.9 miles at Spearpoint Cor, take the 2nd exit onto A2070
- After 1.7 miles take the 1st exit
- William Harvey Hospital is on the left
