In the contact info above write down how we can contact you at the rally. A Cell phone number, hotel location, Ham Radio call sign, etc. will be helpful in reaching you in case there is something that needs further explanation.						
If there is a gap in the sequence number find out what happened from the competitors in the control zone: ASK THE FOLLOWING: Did the car pass anyone? Did they see a car off? Where? What car #? Was the OK sign displayed? Note this information in the log and tell your control captain so that this information can be relayed to net control.						

Write down the actual time when the competitor hands you the timecard. It is OK for them to ask you for the current time and for you to tell them before they hand in the card. They should hand you the timecard during the same minute they enter the control. If not, make a note on the log. If the control zone is backed up they may enter on foot, this is OK. Use the notes section to indicate any discrepancy, unusual circumstance, or competitor reports noted by the competitors or control workers. Make sure your notes will make sense later.

Add 3 minutes to the check in time and write that time in the ideal start time column. Copy both times onto the competitor's timecard.

It is OK for cars to trade places at a start control as long as all agree. If that happens, give them each their actual check in time and swap their ideal start times.

If the stage is stopped for any reason, continue to check in cars and assign ideal start time. Do not let the start assign actual start times until the stage is reopened.

Waving In: If you wave in car(s), please check the WI (Waved In) box. Enter the time the competitor requests in the Time In column. Enter the actual time in the Notes column. The Ideal Start time will be 1 minute from the previous car's Ideal Start time, but at least 3 minutes after the actual arrival time. Check with Control Captain for exceptions.
