- 1. Each competitor will receive an envelope with 1 free ticket for the rider and 4 free tickets for the mechanics and escort upon arrival at the parking lot. A fee of 300 CZK (15€) will be collected for each additional team member at the administrative handover. Riders are asked to pay in CZK.
- 2. Each driver is obliged to follow the ONLINE official scoreboard and is also responsible for arriving at the pre-start area on time, the radio announcement is only informative.
- 3. Only one member of the competition team has access to the pre-start area. No team member has access to the starting grid (except in the racer buggy division, where a team member is allowed to access the starting grid from the pre-start area).
- 4. The paddock will be closed every day from 22:00 07:00.
- 5. In the event of an early start, continue driving on the circuit and follow the instructions of the marshals and the organizer.
- 6. After reaching the finish line, the riders leave the track to the parking lot (on the right behind the marshal's station No. 1).
- 7. All competitors and team members must take care of the environment in all areas of the racetrack.
- 8. A rider who does not have his own transponder can borrow one at the administrative check-in.
- 9. Return the transponders in the headquarters building.
- 10. It is forbidden to start and burn open fires in all areas of the racetrack.
- 11. Cleaning tires in the starting area is prohibited. Violation of this prohibition will be punished. There is an area designated for cleaning tires, which starts at the exit from the pre-start area and ends at the approach to the start. The space is marked with marking tape.
- 12. The light board with the number of the rider who is awarded the black and white or black flag is placed in the finish area on the left side under the wheel indicator.
- 13. Change of parking space in the paddock reserved.
