







ENDUROGP SLOVAKIA: "THE FUTURE IS HERE"

"The Future is Here" is a slogan that reflects a commitment to advancing towards a more sustainable, environmentally friendly future. It embodies the integration of cutting-edge technology and eco-conscious practices within the world of Enduro racing and beyond.

In the words of the G.L.Moto Team President, "Gelnica is located deep within a forest. Our river water is cleaner than tap water, and our air quality index averages an impressive 20 per year. With strong "green" roots and a deep love for nature, we never forget where we come from and the 'green blood' in our veins".

SUSTAINABLE TREE PLANTING PROGRAM:

The local organizer's commitment to the environment extends to tree planting. Over the years, they have planted more than 1,000 trees to offset their carbon footprint and contribute positively to the ecosystem. They will always protect their fauna and flora. They believe that if they take something from nature, they must give back. The local Enduro organizer team has started a sustainable program to be clear and sustainable and to give back to nature.

In 2022, the first year they hosted EnduroGP in Slovakia, they planted 600 trees; in 2023, 800 trees; and in 2024, they will plant over 1,000 trees.

ECO-FRIENDLY PRACTICES:

Events and operations are designed to be environmentally friendly. The team and events fully comply with the latest FIM regulations. Our eco-collecting program for waste is fully compatible with the latest European Commission programs. They use advanced waste management systems, water recirculation, and drainage solutions that minimize the ecological footprint. Toilet systems are isolated and utilize containers for recycling water. They also care for all drained water from the Factory Trucks, collecting and cleaning it through our separator system.

ENDUROGP BRACELET:

Paper bracelets with QR codes will be introduced, providing all essential information about the race, KISS program activities, and locations. This eco-friendly solution will eliminate the need for printed programs, reducing paper waste and promoting sustainability.































































SOLAR PANELS:

At the Slovakia EnduroGP, solar panels will be installed in the Supertest area for lighting and in Paddock A for the promoter's use. This initiative highlights the importance of sustainable energy solutions, reducing the event's carbon footprint, and promoting environmental responsibility within the motorsport community.

BAR AND FOOD TRUCKS AREA:

In the bar and food trucks area, staff will serve food and drinks without single-use plastics. They will replace plastic straws, plates, cups, cutlery, bags, and food packaging with products that are reusable or non-plastic and can be recycled effectively.

ENVIRONMENTAL MAT:

According to the FIM Environmental Code, a Slovak manufacturer has developed and produced an environmental mat. It meets strict technical standards. The mat is red with the logo of the Slovak Motorcycle Federation. It highlights the need and seriousness of its use for soil protection. It will be available to all teams and interested parties.

COMMUNITY AND INCLUSIVITY:

E-MINI ACADEMY BY KTM:

This initiative is designed to educate and inspire the next generation. Kids are introduced to electric bikes and the possibilities of the new "E-era." They will learn about sustainable practices and the benefits of electric vehicles in reducing pollution and preserving nature. During the most popular Super Test Event, a greener future will be showcased to all spectators, especially kids. They will start with full education on the "Zero Emissions Future," which is already here - E-MINI ACADEMY by KTM.

What is it?

The academy provides practical learning experiences. Kids not only learn about electric bikes but also get to ride them, participating in races and competitions. This hands-on approach helps them understand and appreciate the technology and its benefits.

KTM Slovakia will teach the kids how to start riding and explore the possibilities of the new electric era. They will learn about an exciting future that is already here.
