





Marshal Instructions

Thank you for volunteering for the Ballyfinnane Festival of Speed

Marshals meeting point is at the Ballyfinnane Community Centre at 7.30 am.

Please note the Farmer's Bridge access is likely to be congested due to the classic car show moving from the fields to the roads so please enter from the other three entrance points The road closes at 8am

Flag marshals will be given a short training course on how a hill climb works as it is new to many of us from rally-orientated clubs

There will also be a flag test, once the red flag at the top is deployed, there is a time limit before the last flag at the start line is deployed - this will explained at the briefing - there will be trial runs on flag deployment and will not be able to start the event until the time limit is met.

Please wear yellow marshal jackets, do not wear red jackets or tops as they are easily confused for red flags at speed

We know that many of you want to see the Kerry match at 4pm - we will endeavour to have the event finished for 15:30 but we all know this depends on many factors For this reason, we won't stop for a lunch break - we will deliver food to you via a motorcycle marshal

Please park on the roadway adjacent to the community centre for the briefing until assigned your position

After the briefing, follows the chief marshal's instructions to your parking area

Stay safe and if you see something you are not happy about, say it to a senior official and we will sort it.

Enjoy your day and we will see you all at the Shanty afterwards
