



MEDIA ACCREDITATION RULES

We invite you to get familiar with the 6th round of the 2023 Latvian Rally Championship and the LAF Rally Cup, the 3rd round of the 2023 Baltic Sea States Rally Championship, the 4th round of the 2023 LAF Open Cup "Historic" and the 4th stage of the 2023 LAF Open Cup Rally Sprint competition accreditation rules of the media representatives.

BASIC PRINCIPLES OF ACCREDITATION

When applying for accreditation, the media representative undertakes to inform the audience of the event he/she represents properly and correctly about the event both before and after the event. The media representative undertakes to use the correct name of the event: Rallijs "Cēsis 2023" or Rally "Cēsis 2023"

Accreditation of media representatives is provided for:

- **journalists;**
- **photographers;**
- **operators.**

Accreditation is open to individuals who are at least 18 years of age at the time of application. It is possible for accredited media representatives to use ground-controlled flying aids, upon prior agreement with the competition organizer.

MEDIA VESTS

Media photographers, radio correspondents and operators who wish to receive accreditation and a media vest, as well as to be in dangerous areas of the track, need a **valid life insurance policy (including for sports competitions) worth at least 1500 EUR.**

Accredited media representatives will be able to receive media vests against a guarantee fee of 20 EUR.

Accredited media representatives who have a media vest issued by the race organizer are allowed to be in dangerous areas of the track, but no further than 1 (one) meter from the safety fence (tape, fence, etc.).

Accredited media representatives who have a media vest and a media wristband/card issued by the race organizer have the right to be in dangerous areas of the track even further than 1 (one) meter from the safety fence (tape, fence, etc.).

It is strictly forbidden to transfer the received media vest and media wristband/card to other persons.



SUBMISSION AND APPROVAL OF ACCREDITATION APPLICATION

The accreditation application must be completed on the official website of the Latvian Rally Championship: www.autorally.lv. The competition organizer does not guarantee consideration of incomplete or incorrectly completed accreditation applications.

The organizer of the competition makes a decision on the approval or rejection of the accreditation application. The competition organizer reserves the sole right to decide which media representatives to issue media cards and vests.

Confirmation of granting or rejecting accreditation to media representatives (to the e-mail specified in the accreditation application) is sent within three working days after receiving the accreditation application.

RECEIVING AND RETURNING OF MEDIA VESTS AND MEDIA CARDS

Accredited media representatives will be able to receive and hand over media cards and media vests at the media center of Rally "Cēsis 2023". Media cards and media vests can only be received in person by submitting a signed accreditation confirmation letter.

By submitting an accreditation application, you confirm that you are familiar with the safety regulations for media representatives and the accreditation regulations for media representatives, agree to them and take full responsibility for your actions.

The competition organizer reserves the right to withdraw the media representative's accreditation card and/or media vest and/or media wristband if he/she violates the media representatives' safety rules and/or the media representatives' accreditation rules.
