Road Conditions and Logging Report undertaken 22.09.22

Dalby – SS1 and SS6:

- 100m after Post 11 – Logs on the right
- Post 16 to 18 (Quarry) – lower quality road surface than elsewhere
- Between Posts 27 and 28, at 864850 - logs on right, and then again 100m further on
- Post 29 – the road surface here is slightly raised, but considerably improved over the condition when the Subjective Route Notes were made.
- Between Posts 30 and 31, at 878868, logs on right
- Shortly after Post 31 - logs on both side, care after exiting the chicane
- Just before Post 37 – logs on the right

Cropton – SS2:

- Just before Post 15 – Logs on the right
- 100m after Post 16 - logs on the right, and again 50m later
- Posts 16 to 17 – some potholes along this section
- 100m after Post 24 – logs on the left
- After Post 30, at 778944, logs on the left

Gale Rigg – SS3:

- Post 3 – surface is made up of large stones, slipperier than the rest of the stage
- Halfway between Posts 12 and 13, there are some potholes next to the tree

Langdale – SS4:

- 100m after Post 10 – Logs on the left, and a toilet on the right (not for competitor use!)
- Logs continue on the left towards Post 11
- Post 12 to 13 – Logs on the left
- 100m after Post 13 – logs on the left
- Post 10 & Post 13 are the site of a tree infection called Phytophthora Ramorum. If you have cause to stop in this area, please avoid going into the undergrowth as much as possible. There is an unused track to the west of Post 13 where you can safely wait.
- Post 15 – As you exit the chicane, there are walls of logs on both sides of the road, making it quite narrow. You'll need to be tidy here to avoid them.
- Post 17 to 18 – Logs on the right all the way
- Post 20 – Digger on the right on the outside of the corner
- The road surface from posts 20 to 26 is considerably more stony than the earlier part of the stages, and thus much more slippery (especially on my road tyres!).

Staindale – SS5:

- 100m after Post 6 – logs on the right
- 100m after Post 7 – logs on the right
