

LIMITED CONTACT TIMEKEEPING AND DOCUMENT UPLOAD

COMPETITOR'S INSTRUCTIONS FOR RALLY YORKSHIRE 2022

With the restrictions imposed due to the Corona-19 virus it was not recommended for marshals to handle and fill in time cards. Times were recorded by the marshals on check sheets and competitors were completing their own record cards with the time on the clock shown by the marshal and possibly on a large display clock.

Whilst the times sent direct from clocks to the results service and times recorded on the checksheets will be used by the results team to calculate results, it may be useful for the results team to have a copy of your completed time cards.

To achieve this, we now have software which runs in the web browser on your phone to enable you to photograph and send to the results team a copy of each time card, damage declaration, results query or other document. NB make sure you select the correct document type before uploading.

The QR code shown below is unique to this event.

You are encouraged to upload a document prior to the event (it does not really matter what it is) so that you are familiar with the procedure.

STEP 1



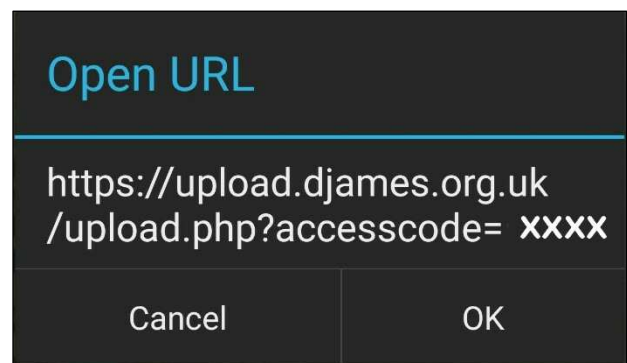
Scan the QR code with your phone. Some phones will do this by just pointing the camera at the QR code; some may have a QR scanner app installed or you can install one from the Google or Apple Store.

Alternatively, you can enter the following URL into the browser address bar of your phone:

The access code for **competitors** for this event is 4497

STEP 2



On scanning the QR code this or a similar message will be displayed depending on your phone. The "xxxx" will be replaced by the competitors access code (see left). Tap to accept.

STEP 3

Your car number will be remembered for subsequent uploads. **Please make sure you have entered your car number correctly. Also write the car number on all the actual time cards.**

The first time card number will be displayed. After uploading the photo this will change to the next card number. You can manually change the number.

The down arrow (▼) displays other options to select when necessary.

Tap "Take photo". The camera will open automatically

After the photo has been taken, it will be displayed on screen (example above).

If you are happy with it, tap "OK" (or the equivalent) to accept, when you will be taken to the screen shown in Step 5.

If you are not happy with the photo select "Retry" (or the equivalent) which will return to Step 3
