Art 5.1 Start

The Ceremonial Start of the event will take place at The Beach, Filey, North Yorkshire. YO14 9LE, Friday 23 September 2022 at 19:01. Google Plus Code 6P58+H2 MR. 101/120814 **WHAT3WORDS**: ///boasted.comedy.casual

Restart

Due to unforeseen circumstances on the first road section on Saturday from MTC3 (Bridestones) to Stage 2 Cropton, it has been necessary to relocate MTC3 Saturday start to NY500 Café, Malton Road, Pickering YO18 8EA, located 2.1miles south of Pickering on the A169 Pickering to Malton Road. The entrance is signposted **Waste Transfer Station Ind Estate** and will be arrowed. **(See Appendix B for revised maps)**

The start time for the first car remains at 08.46rs and your individual MTC3 due times will be separately published.

Hot refreshments and drinks will be available.

Competitors are kindly requested to NOT arrive more than 30 minutes before their MTC3 due time.

Competitor's cars ONLY at the start. STRICTLY NO TRAILERS OR UNLOADING AT NY500

All published times are for guidance only. Please refer to the published starters list on the Official Notice Board (virtual).

Access Times for Service Vehicles

Service vehicles will only be permitted to enter the Service Area at Filey Brigg Country Park, as follows: Friday 23 September 2022 from 11:00 hrs (N.B. NOW closes at 23:00 hrs) reopens Saturday 24 September 2022 – from 07:30 to 18:00.

Art 7.1 Identification

Competitors are requested that the rear rally plate is affixed to the top right hand corner of the rear screen (when viewed from the rear of the car).

Art 8.13 Documentation

Although signing on is by electronic means, there will be a random physical check of licences of both crew members of approximately 20% of the entry at Documentation Collection.

Article 10 Results

During the event, interim results will be available via the results tab on the Sportity App. (See Article 25) Provisional results will be posted on the Official Notice Board (virtual) as soon as possible following the finish of the last car.

Article 11.1 Route/Road Book/Documentation

Your Competitor Record Card will be issued at Documentation collection, subject to both competitors having signed on. These documents will contain all the necessary information to enable competitors to comply with R 2.3.3 and R 33.

ROADBOOK 2 AMENDMENTS:

MTC3 will now be located at NY500 Café, Malton Road, Pickering YO18 8EA, located 2.1miles south of Pickering on the A169 Pickering to Malton Road.

The start time for the first car remains at 08.46hrs and your individual MTC3 due times will be separately published.

Road section time from MTC3 to TC2 Cropton remains the same – 0hr 40mins.

Page 12, post 20 proceed straight on along the A170 to Pickering, **DO NOT** turn right. Delete page 13.

In Pickering turn left at the roundabout onto the A169 towards Malton. NY500 is located 2.1 miles south of Pickering on the right hand side of the road and will be arrowed.

Delete Page 15.

From MTC3 NY500, turn left onto the A169 towards Pickering. Page 16, delete post 7 and turn left at post 8 (roundabout), re-joining the rally route.

Page 61: Post 11: Insert mandatory radio. Post 13 - Delete Mid Point Rescue and Medical location. Post 14 - Insert Mid Point Rescue and Medical location.

Art 11.8

There is NO PARC FERME on Friday 23 September 2022.

Art 15.3

Procedure at Passage Controls - As you approach the PC please display your Competitor Record Card on the navigator's side window so that the Marshal can note the Arrival, Start and Finish times on the check sheet for the stage you have just completed.

Art 15.6 Early check in at the end of a leg

At the end of the day, competitors are allowed to check in at the final Time

Control, in advance of their due time GR. R.30.3.3. Competitors who arrive early must request their due time from the timekeeper at the MTC; those arriving later than their due time must have their actual time of arrival recorded.

Art 16 Reconnaissance

Reconnaissance will start from Adderstone Arena, MR/101/884897 what three words reference ///camper.skyrocket.rabble Friday 23 September – Signing on by 07:15 latest for a prompt start to the first stage at 07:30.

Art 17 Servicing

The organisers have set a speed limit of 10mph within the Service Area for <u>all vehicles</u>. Failure to comply will result in penalties, which may go as far as disqualification.

Art 17.1

Different service plates are available and therefore ensure the correct plate is obtained to correspond with the size of the service vehicle, and that all service plates are attached to the front of the vehicle before leaving the Trailer Park. Consideration must be shown to local residents and therefore engines MUST NOT be run between Friday 23 September 2022, 23:00 hrs to Saturday 24 September 2022, 07:00 hrs.

Article 17.5

Additional vehicles can be parked in the adjoining Northern Council Car Park adjacent to the Service Area. Two car park passes will be issued to each competing crew to enable them to park there free of charge for the duration of the event. Any additional vehicles will be subject to Scarborough Council's normal charges and terms and conditions.

Please note that CCTV will be in operation throughout the event in the Service Area to ensure that only vehicles displaying a Service Pass or Competing Cars have access to the Service Area, and to ensure the safety of the marshals. CCTV will be covering the approach road to the Service Area and the Service Area itself.

Art 17.6

Servicing of vehicles will be on a predominantly grass surface and limited hard standing gravel area at Filey Brigg Country Park. A tarpaulin/groundsheet must be used.

All competitors must provide a spillage mat. Non-compliance will incur a penalty of £40.00. Spillage mats may be obtained from the Environmental Scrutineer.

Art 17.8

Service Area operational times on Friday will be 11:00-23:00

Art 19.6 Prize Presentations

Awards for First, Second and Third overall will be presented at the Finish. All remaining awards will be posted to competitors after the event. Please note that the trophies will be despatched directly from the supplier and consequently the event will therefore share the address and phone contact details of the named contact on the entry form for all award winners to enable despatch to take place.

However, all competitors finishing the event will receive a souvenir finishers award at the finish.

Article 25 General Communication during the event

During the event, individual and general communication between all rally officials the competitors/crew members will primarily and as far as possible be conducted electronically (mobile phone, Sportity, WhatsApp).

The Official Notice Board will be the Virtual Notice Board (VNB), published on www.rallyyorkshire.co.uk There will be no physical official notice board. All competitors will be informed via the Sportity app about the publication of any documents on the digital notice board.

The Sportity app will be the primary route for the issue/notification of rally documents (e.g. start and restart lists, bulletins and on-event information). As a result, it is important that the crew have access to the app and that support members of the team are also encouraged to arrange access.

The app can be downloaded for iOS devices on Appstore and for Android devices on Google Play.

What3words: ///mouth.perusing.hazy Please park as directed. Trailers can be left here for the duration of the event. Please do not take trailers to Filey Brigg Country Park at any time during the event – there is nowhere to park them and they will not be admitted!!! If you need to recover a stricken vehicle that has retired from the event please contact the Service Area Co-ordinator, Martin Douglas, on mobile telephone number 07815 371276.

Your noise test time has been selected as near as possible to the time you requested, so please help us by arriving promptly.

Rally Plate Collection/Documentation Distribution - Rally Plates, door numbers and additional transparent plates with fluorescent numbers to be fixed on both rear side windows of the competing car, will be available prior to the Noise Test at Filey Brigg Country Park on Friday 23 September 2022. Documentation will be collected at The Scrutineering location, after completing Scrutineering. This needs to be collected by a member of the competing crew and identification (for example, competition licence) needs to be shown. Please note that we will also be undertaking a random check of competition licenses for both crew members.

All plates and decals MUST be in position before presenting the vehicle for the Noise Test (see SR Article 7.5).

2. SIGNING ON / DOCUMENTATION

Signing on should have taken place electronically by **THURSDAY 22 SEPTEMBER 2022**, **18:00 AT THE LATEST**. Registered entrants in the Championship should ensure that they also have registered with their Championship Co-ordinator.

3. SERVICE PLATES are issued at the Trailer Park prior to coming to the Service Area at Filey Brigg Country Park. (unless purchasing a Custom Plate – in which case go directly to Filey Brigg Country Park) PLEASE CHECK YOU HAVE RECEIVED WHAT YOU ORDERED!

"Service" plates must be displayed at all times during the event unless the competing car has retired. They should only be used on the registered vehicle and are NOT transferable. As you might expect, we will be checking and monitoring the use of these plates.

NOTE THAT THERE ARE NO EMERGENCY SERVICE FACILITIES ON THIS EVENT – SO NO "CHASE CARS – Service Observers will be patrolling the route to ensure no competitor is receiving outside assistance.

ONLY VEHICLES CARRYING THE APPROPRIATE PASSES I.E. THE COMPETING VEHICLE OR THE SERVICE VEHICLE WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE SERVICE AREA.

4. THE SERVICE AREA – FILEY BRIGG COUNTRY PARK

Sportity contains guidelines for Safety in Service Areas – please ensure that you and your Service Crews read them.

We remind competitors of Article 17 of the Supplementary Regulations which advises that NO servicing is allowed anywhere other than the Service Area at Filey Brigg Country Park.

Please note that THE SERVICE AREA & RALLY H/Q are designated as NO SMOKING

5. TYRES AND OTHER SUPPORT VEHICLES

Tyre/support vehicles will be parked at Filey Brigg Country Park for the duration of the event.

6. REFRESHMENT & TOILET FACILITIES

At Filey Brigg County Park:

Toilet Facilities together with food and drinks facilities have been arranged. Additionally, there are facilities in Filey for refreshments.

7. RALLY ROUTE INFORMATION

We will undertake a route survey during Thursday 22 September and provide up-to-date information regarding any road works on the public highway together with relevant information regarding any logging operations and/or major road damage in the forests. Details will be displayed on the Official Notice Board (virtual) when available and is provided for information and guidance only. Remember our stages are operational forest roads and other activity may damage the surface prior to the event. We work closely with the Forestry Commission to ensure that re-grading is undertaken but adverse weather conditions sometimes affects this work before, during and after completion.

If you are aware of any major delays during the event, please call the Rally Office.

8. DRIVING STANDARDS

Driving standards will be under close scrutiny. Everyone associated with the event is requested to drive with due consideration for other road users on public roads. Please remember that there is no need to "race" between the stages so PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY AND QUIETLY through villages and built up areas.

You are reminded that it is a legal requirement to use "ROAD LEGAL" tyres on the public highway and for your number plates to be of legal size & lettering and be legible. We have been advised that the North Yorkshire Police are to have extra officers on patrol in the area on the day of the rally. They are helpful and friendly as long as you obey the LAW!

Please note that North Yorkshire Police has invested heavily in mobile speed cameras and can be sited anywhere.

9. REGROUP

Only rally cars and their relevant crews are permitted in these areas.

10. POST EVENT SCRUTINEERING

The finish control is situated at The Beach Filey. Vehicles required for post event scrutiny will be notified at the final Main Time Control. A representative of the competitor must be available to take the car directly to the post event scrutineering venue. (Directions will be given to the required competitors).

15. Litter

On recent events it has been observed that some crews are discarding empty water bottles when arriving at stage both during the recce and also on the event. Please can this practice not happen on your visit to Rally Yorkshire.

We have an excellent relationship with Forestry England in North Yorkshire and do not wish to lose that due to plastic bottles being discarded in the forest. If you do carry drinks bottles, when empty, please keep them in the car and dispose of them and any other litter thoughtfully. Ultimately it is left for the Arrival crews to potentially have to tidy up.

17. Use of SOS & OK Boards

A reminder to all Competitors that information given to Marshals or Officials regarding display of an OK/SOS Board, must ALWAYS be FACTUAL and ACCURATE. If you are not sure of the OK/SOS Board procedure, please see Sportity/ page 2-3 of the Roadbook OR please re-read section R25.4 of the Motorsport UK Yearbook.

18. A170 Road Closure at Sutton Bank

Please note for anybody proposing to approach Filey from the direction of Thirsk, along the A170, that Sutton Bank is closed for maintenance from 11 September 2022 until the first week in October 2022. North Yorkshire County Council advise the following re route:

A19 South from Thirsk to York Ring Road;

East along York Ring Road to junction with A64; or

North on A64, joining A169 to Pickering, and back onto the A170

The diversion will not follow the caravan route.





LOCATION MAPS











Amendment to Overview Map – reroute from Ebberston to Restart at NY500
