## 4. GENERAL INFORMATION


This rally will be run in compliance with the effective National Sporting Regulations, Finnish Rally Championship Regulations 2026(FRC26), and SM RALLI MIKKELI 2026 Supplementary Regulations (which AKK Motorsport has approved with Visa No. 19183/RA/26). The supplementary regulations are also published in English. All other documents

in the event will also be published in Finnish and in English. In case of any dispute, the Finnish versions will be determinative. The Rally is NEAFP classified and thus open for ASN license holders from other countries.

Total distance of the itinerary is 188,79 km including seven (7) Special Stages. Distance of the Special Stages is 96,4 km in total.

The competitor is responsible for insuring the car with an insurance towards third parties which is also valid on Special Stages.

The international Time Card is used in the rally. National turning signs (see below) are used in the rally.



If a competitor or their Delegate is met prior to his starting time on the roads used as Special Stages in the Rally and marked yellow, grey or black or unmarked roads in the road map of Finland in the area of Mikkeli, the competitor will be prohibited to participate in the Rally. Reconnaissance for classes 1–17 according to Supplementary regulations Art. 11 is excluded from this.

The Rally follows the regulations of the Finnish Center for Integrity in Sports (FINCIS), which can be found at [suek.fi](http://suek.fi), and the legislation regarding doping.

## 6. ENTRIES

Anybody wishing to take part in Future SM RALLI MIKKELI must submit their entry via the KITI system (finnish licence) or ask secondary registration instructions from Secretary of the Rally. Entries close at 5th of January at 12:00.

Foreign competitors register via entry form which is available at Sportity. The entry form needs to be returned at the latest on 5.1.2026 at 12:00.

By the order of entries, 150 first crews who did the registration according to the regulations are accepted to the Rally. Possible elimination is performed from other classes than Finnish Rally Championship and Suomi Cup. In case there are less than three (3) crews entered for the classes 18-24, the classes can be combined with another class.

The administrative check will be done electronically via the forms (contact details during the event and information for the commentator) available at Sportity and website [www.seinajokiralli.fi](http://www.seinajokiralli.fi). The forms must be returned at the latest on 13.1.2026 at 18:00. The organizer confirms the approval of the documents to the competitor.

According to Finnish traffic law foreign cars must have Transfer permit and Temporary motor liability insurance. The Organiser will acquire and invoice the insurances for foreign racing cars. Entry fee will be refunded in full to candidates whose entry has not been accepted, in case the competitor cancels their participation before the closing date for entries or in case the rally is not taking place. In case the competitor cancels their participation by 12.1.2026 at 22:00, the entry fee will be returned but 50 € administrative fee will be reserved. ## 8. SERVICE

Service Park in the Rally is located in Ratsurinkuja, 50100 Mikkeli.

In the Rally there is one service between SS4 and SS5, Service time is 33 min. The time includes 3 minutes for technical inspection (scrutineering), regrouping time and a service time of 30 minutes Upon arriving to the service competitors will be given a Service Out time. The competitors may start the service at a time of their choosing by marking the start time on the paper given to them when arriving to service. It must be placed visibly on the windscreen or to another window. The service is monitored by organizer.

Organizer reserves service area according to the Finnish Rally Championship 2026 regulations Art. 15.5.

In case of special requests or shared services, a detailed written request (with the size of the service area mentioned) should be sent to the organizer via email [jouni.hakkanen@gmail.com](mailto:jouni.hakkanen@gmail.com) at the latest on 9.1.2026 at 20:00. Please also inform in case you wish to have an adjacent service area with certain competitors/teams. After this time, the organizer charges 100 €/crew for the possible changes. The organizer reserves the right to reject the requests.

Service cars must have a fire extinguisher and ready-to-use oil spill kit for each crew. Each Rally car must have a liquid-impermeable protective ground sheet covering the area of the car under the car during the service. Lack of any of the above-mentioned leads to immediate exclusion from the Rally imposed by the Clerk of the Course.

Violations related to the service time (starting service too early or exceeding the service time) are sanctioned according to the Finnish Rally Championship Regulations 2026 art. 15.8.

Sanctions for other violations in the service and refueling areas:

1st violation 300€  
 2nd violation 600€  
 3rd violation Exclusion from the Rally imposed by the Clerk of the Course

Parking for car used in reconnaissance is not possible at service park. Space is reserved at trailer park.

## 9. TIRES

In classes 1–6 it is permitted to use 8 tyres that comply with Finnish Rally Championship Regulations 2026, Art 17.1 and 17.5.

These tires should be notified with the tyre bar code form which needs to be returned via email to [rallismkatsastus@autourheilu.fi](mailto:rallismkatsastus@autourheilu.fi) at the latest on Friday 16.1.2026 at 21:00. Tyre bar code form is available at Sportity. Subject of the emails should be competitors number and the name of the driver. In the form must be mentioned barcode / FIA-code, mark and model of the tyre.

Classes 7-24 are allowed to use 8 tires according to the old regulations ,sizes 15" or 16".

## 10. REFUEL

All classes will refuel on the route according to the road book at the gas station ABC Pitkäjärvi from the pump and from their own containers in the separate refuel zone at service park.

## 11. RECONNAISSANCE

Administrative check and collection of materials (classes 1-17) from the Race Office, Patteristonkatu 3 D, 50100 Mikkeli Identity card, passport etc. will be checked in the Rally Office during the administrative check and collection of the materials

Thursday	15.1.2026 at 18:00-20:00
Friday	16.1.2026 at 07:30-12:00.

Reconnaissance starts on Friday 16.1.2026 at 08:00 and ends 16.1.2026 at 17:00.

GPS tracking devices will be handed out with the reconnaissance material and must be used during the reconnaissance. The competitor must have a USB connection in the reconnaissance car and keep the tracking device connected throughout the reconnaissance. Only two (2) passages are allowed on Special Stages during the reconnaissance. The organizer will control the number of passages on each Special Stage with the tracking device. Competitor must move the GPS tracking device into their rally car after the reconnaissance, prior to their starting time.

Two (2) identification numbers must be attached to the reconnaissance car at the top center of the windscreen and the right rear side window and kept visible for the whole duration of reconnaissance. The numbers must be removed after the reconnaissance.

Speed limit of 80 km/h is valid on all Special Stages during the reconnaissance unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or signs placed by the organizer. Driving during the reconnaissance must not endanger or inconvenience other traffic or people living close by. Crews are only permitted to enter and leave Special Stages through the start and finish during the reconnaissance. Driving in the opposite direction of the rally is prohibited. The organizer will control speed as well as the manner of driving during reconnaissance. The police will also supervise on the route and may penalize traffic infringements according to the Finnish Traffic Law. Competitors are obligated to follow stopping requests of the Rally Officials with the organizer's identifications, or the penalty will be refusal to start.

The Clerk of the Course can impose sanctions for speeding during the reconnaissance measured with the speed control device by the police or the organizer or for other traffic violation according to Finnish Rally Championship Regulations 2026 Art 10.1. and Rally Regulations 2026

Reconnaissance for competitors in classes 18-24 is not allowed. If a competitor in class 18-24 or their Delegate is found on the rally routes prior to their starting time, the competitor will be prohibited to participate in the Rally. This does not exclude possible extra sanctions given by ASN.

## 13. SAFETY SCRUTINEERING

Safety scrutineering will take place on Soisalon Liikenne, Pomonkatu 4, 50100 Mikkeli  
Arriving to safety scrutineering using only road legal tires.

System opens on Friday 9.1.26 at 12:00 and closes on Tuesday 13.1.26 at 15:00

Competitors or their representatives must enter the area 10 minutes before their own scrutineering time in order to ensure arrival on time. After check-in will be carried out equipment check. After that cars will be transferred to the scrutineering hall.

The spare parts to be sealed and registered for the competition are inspected and, if necessary, sealed during the safety check. ## 17. REGROUP
