## Written Drivers Briefing

Dear participants,

I want to point out some topics regarding the regulations and the behaviour at the stages:

- We are using the RallySafe tracking system. If you have to stop your car for any reason on or beside a special stage, whether temporarily or permanently, you must activated the OK switch on the emergency console within on minute.

- If the red "SOS" sign displayed to you, or you see a car which has suffered an accident, and the OK sign is not shown, you must immediately and without exception stop to render assistance.

- We are only using Red Flags on the stage and an electronic Red Flag. On passing a displayed Red Flag and/or receiving an electronic Red Flag, whichever happens first, you must immediately reduce speed, maintain this reduced speed until the end of the special stage, and follow the instructions of any marshals or intervention car drivers.

- If we have an incident on the stage, we will interrupt the SS. Affected crews will be send to the next stage via the alternative route. When the incident that caused the interruption has been resolved and the route is clear, crews that have not yet been sent to the alternative route will be started to the SS. The crews will be informed at the TC when the start of the SS is resumed.
