Recce Information

This Recce Information is part of the Supplementary Regulations for the 2023 Boone Forest Rally.

Check-In. Driver and Co-driver MUST check-in BEFORE you start your reconnaissance. Check-In will be at an administration table inside the PRTC warehouse at the Service Park. It will be open on Friday 22 September from 14:00 to 20:00 and on Saturday 23 September from 07:00 to 14:00.

Recce Vehicle. Vehicles used in reconnaissance must be normal street vehicles with no lettering, advertising or other markings/customizations which would call attention to the vehicle. Exhausts must be quiet. The Clerk of the Course will be the final arbiter of the suitability of a vehicle intended to be used for reconnaissance.

RSLite. You must have the RSLite App loaded on your phone, per ARA Bulletin 2023-5 and get your unique code.

Speed Limit. The maximum speed on the stages is 30mph in accordance with ARA Rally Competition Rules 1.3.1.

Road Usage. The two stage roads used for competition are open for reconnaissance on Saturday between 08:00 to 13:00. You may make as many runs as you wish within this time frame respecting the speed limit constraints. The Shakedown stage is open for recce on Friday between 14:30 and 16:30.

You may travel on the stages ONLY in the direction of the stages as they will be run in competition and shakedown.

Expect local traffic in both directions on the stages and transits.

Stage Marshals will be on the roads setting up the stages during your recce times on Friday and Saturday morning. **Please take extreme care for everyone's safety.**

Stage Markings. Stage controls will be marked with wooden stakes on the right side of the road. GPS coordinates appear in the routebook.

Chicanes will be marked with small signs located on the right side of the road in the same positions as the 1st set of chicane hay bales will be located. All chicanes are right entry per ARA RCR 1.3.2

Tussy Hill 1955 has 1 chicane on gravel to slow you down past a house that is very near the road.

Gravel Lick S-Tree has 2 chicanes on pavement within 100 yards of each other to appease the residents of 2 houses.

Schedule.

Expect 1-pass Saturday recce of the competition stages to take about 2 hours.

2-pass recce of the competition stage will take about 4 hours.

Below is a nominal 2-pass target schedule for 15mph average speed on the stages on your 1st pass; 20mph average speed on the stages for your 2nd pass; and 35mph average speed on the transits.

08:00	Leave the Service Park. Follow the Routebook from TC 0 / MTC 1 OUT (11.48 mi)
08:20	SS 1/3 The Anderson Start 1 st pass (12.09 mi)
09:10	Stage STOP. Follow the Routebook to TC 2 (11.84 mi)
09:30	SS 2/4/5 The Strong Start 1 st pass (8.47mi)
10:05	Stage STOP. Follow the Routebook to mileage 10.05 instruction 29 on page 26 (1.37 mi from the STOP of The Strong). At this instruction turn RIGHT and travel 6.59 mi to the Start of The Anderson
10:20	SS 1/3 The Anderson Start 2 nd pass (12.09 mi)
11:00	Stage STOP. Follow the Routebook to TC 2 (11.84 mi)
11:20	SS 2/4/5 The Strong 2 nd pass (8.47 mi)
11:50	Stage STOP. Follow the Routebook to TC2A at the Service Park (6.26 mi)
12:00	Arrive at the Service Park
