





PIT LANE RULES



- Maximum speed 60kph
- The tyres, guns and material are allowed in the inner lane of the pits the lap when the car is coming to pits.
- ONCE THE CAR HAS LEFT THE GARAGE ALL REPAIRS MUST BE DONE IN THE INNER LANE

During the starting procedure the inner lane must be free of any material









PIT STOP















FLAG SIGNALS



Chequered End of race or practice session.



Yellow & Red Stripes Slippery surface ahead.



Blue To indicate that a quicker competitor is closing or trying to pass.



Black Displayed with vehicle number on board to indicate driver must stop within one lap and report to the Clerk of the Course. A penalty of exclusion may be enforced.



Yellow

Danger, slow down sufficiently to ensure that full control of the vehicle can be retained. No overtaking.



Black with Orange Disc

Displayed with vehicle number on board to indicate mechanical problems of which the driver may be unaware. Driver must report to pits on the next lap.



Green

All clear, at the end of a danger area controlled by yellow flags. Also used to signal the start of a formation lap.



Black & White Diagonal

Shown with a number board to warn a driver his track conduct is causing concern




Red

Immediately cease driving at racing speed and proceed slowly, without overtaking, and with maximum caution to pits or startline. Be prepared to stop if track is blocked.

White

A service car or slow moving vehicle is on the circuit. The white flag will be waved to indicate the sector the slow moving vehicle is in,











SC











- Procedure to be used in Free practice, Qualifying and Race: during the Race, before the restart, Race Control use the Safety Car
- All marshall posts with yellow flags and FCY boards

Reduce speed to 80 kph. LAP TIME REFERENCE - 3.56.025



- Keep the same gap to the car in the front and behind
- Overtaking is forbidden
- When the procedure ends all marshall posts will wave green flags

STARTING PROCEDURE



Teams will receive the starting procedure before the race

No laps through the pit lane are allowed – if this changes teams will be informed on the starting procedure document or on the screen.

Cars to go straight from the pit lane to the grid

START ABORT





• In case of a problem raise your arms aboveyour head to inform the marshals

- Yellow flags will be shown from that row to the end of the Grid
- Start may be aborted and we will go for anextra formation lap

The car will be pushed into the pit lane **RACE DISTANCE WILL BE REDUCED BY 1**









SAFETY CAR – Art 37 EFO SR



- Safety car procedure: yellow flags and SC boards in all marshal posts
- Overtaking is forbidden until you cross the finish line at the end of the procedure.
- SC turns off lights at T11-12. When the SC turns off lights all signalling will be removed and a green flag will be displayed at the finish line. Overtaking remain forbidden until you cross the finish line.
- If it's deployed during the last lap, it will enter the pit lane and all the cars will take the chequered flag without overtaking.

START THE RACE BEHIND SC – Art 38 EFO SR



- If we need to start the race behind de SC at the **5minute board** the SC willturn on lights and will remain on the grid
- With the green flag all cars will start the race following the SC, the race time will start then, no formation lap.
- All marshal posts will show yellow flags and SC boards.
- When the race director considers it's safe to do so we will go green in a normal SC restart (green flag on the finish line)

RED FLAG SUSPENDING A RACE – Art 39 EFO SR



- If we need to suspend the race: all marshal posts will wave RED FLAGS
- Time remaining will stop
- Reduce your speed, overtaking is forbidden.
- All cars to the pit lane, stop in the fast lane in the order you arrive.
- Cars can be worked, the work must not impede the resumption of the race
- REFUELING IS NOT ALLOWED











RESUMING THE RACE BEHIND SC – Art 40 & 41 EFO SR



- If the race can be resumed we will do it behind the SC with a minimum 7' minute warning on the screens and messaging system.
- We will have 5' 3' 1' and 15" boards at pit exit
- Cars between SC and the leader will be waved off after the 3' signal and they will join the line of cars behind the SC
- At the end of the lap, if everything is OK, we will restart with a green flag at the finish line (SC restart)











It's possible cut the track near Savelli corner – Turn 7 only in free practice and qualifying but <u>not during the race</u>; only for technical or safety reason you can use this part of the track during the race, but in this case, you must stop near the Box n.20 and you will receive a time penalty of 2' minutes added to the race time.

If you use this part of the track during the Formation Lap for the Races, you can start only from the Pit Lane after the start of the race.
