The 28th Eiscup Innsbruck will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Figure Skating as well as pertinent ISU Communications for the categories Seniors, Juniors, Advanced Novice, Intermediate Novice, Basic Novice, Pre-Novice and Juvenile and in accordance with Skate Austria ÖWO (Skate Austria Wettlaufordnung and Richtlinie 2024/2025: <https://skateaustria.at/wp-content/uploads/2024/08/Richtlinie-fuer-Wettbewerbe-in-Oesterreich-2024-2025-V3-final.pdf>).

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 2.
Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.
Duration: 4 min., +/- 10 sec.

WOMEN

Short Program

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024 Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 2.
Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.
Duration: 4 min., +/- 10 sec.

Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.
Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.

JUNIOR WOMEN

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024 Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2024/25.
Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.
Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.

	<p>An Intermediate Novice Skater is a Skater who has met the following requirements before July 1st preceding the competition: Intermediate Novice - has not reached the age of sixteen (16)</p>
	<p>Duration of the Programs: Single Skating Intermediate Novice Free Skating: 3:00 min, +/-10 sec.</p>
BASIC NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS	In accordance with ISU Communication 2624 and the relevant ISU Communication Age requirements
	<p>A Basic Novice Skater is a Skater who has met the following requirements before July 1st preceding the competition: Basic Novice - has not reached the age of fourteen (14)</p>
	<p>Duration of the Programs: Single Skating Basic Novice Free Skating: 2:30 min, +/-10 sec.</p>
PRE-NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS	In accordance with Skate Austria Richtlinie 2024/205
	<p>A Pre- Novice Skater is a Skater who has met the following requirements before July 1st preceding the competition: Pre-Novice – at least 8 but not yet 10</p>
	<p>Duration of the Programs: Single Skating Pre-Novice Free Skating: 2:00 min, +/-10 sec.</p>
JUVENILE GIRLS & BOYS	In accordance with Skate Austria Richtlinie 2024/2025
	<p>A Juvenile Skater is a Skater who has met the following requirements before July 1st preceding the competition: Juvenile - at least 6 but not yet 8</p>
	<p>Duration of the Programs: Single Skating Juvenile Free Skating: 2:00 min, +/-10 sec.</p>

A well balanced Free Skating program for Pre-Novice & Juvenile Boys & Girls must contain:

- Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations. Jump combinations can contain only two (2) jumps.
 - Juvenile: Double and Triple jumps are not permitted.
Only one (1) single jump may be executed twice.
 - Pre-Novice: Triple jumps are not permitted.
Only one (1) single or double jump (incl. Double Axel) may be executed twice.
- There must be a maximum of two (2) spins (different abbreviations)
 - one Spin without a change of foot in a basic position with a minimum of 4 revolutions, no level features shall be shown, max. Level Base, flying entrance is not allowed
 - one spin of free choice with a different abbreviation (for example: USp and SSp are different abbreviations), minimum of 4 revolutions, max. Level 1, flying entrance is not allowed
- There must be a maximum one (1) step sequence with a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only. The step sequence must cover the ice surface and include a free skating move to be counted.
 - Juvenile: Maximum Level Base
 - Pre-Novice: Maximum Level 1: a minimum of one (1) correctly executed difficult step or turn must be included (Rocker/Counter/Bracket/Twizzle/Loop/Choctaw)

The Program Components are judged in

- Composition
- Presentation
- Skating Skills

The Factor of the Program Components is 1.67

Deductions (e.g. falls, time violation): -0,5

ENTRIES

- **Clubs from Austria** have to register skaters for Eiscup via **Skate Austria Portal** latest by **October 5, 2024**. If the category differs to your national category, please contact thomas.biegler@skateaustria.at
- **Clubs from all other countries** must send the entry forms for their skaters latest by **October 5, 2024** to: [eislauf@eislaufen-innsbruck.at](mailto:eiscup@eislaufen-innsbruck.at)

Each Club may enter four (4) skaters per category. The organizer reserves the right to limit the number of entries per club or / and enter more than four skaters. Entries of skaters may be made only by the club concerned on the designated Official Forms.

Entry lists, competition schedules, competition results will be published at the Sportity-App. The organizing committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries due to limited ice availability. If the limit is reached we will close the entry list and offer further skaters to be put on the waiting list.

Entries will be on first come first serve principle. Those skaters who have not paid their entry fees till the entry fee deadline will be replaced by skaters next on the waiting list.

Entries will only be confirmed if the entry fee is paid via bank transfer by October 5, 2024. Reimbursement of entry fees can only be offered for cancellations done latest by October 5, 2024. In very special cases we may offer reimbursement also later (medical attests need to be sent along with withdrawals).

Attention: Please send all entry fees as one payment for the whole club.

Music

To minimize direct contact during the competition the music playback will be exclusively digital (via computer)!

The uploaded/sent music files must show competitor's name, nationality, category, program (short/free skating). Mandatory music format is .mp3 file format.

We highly recommend to send the music files very soon after confirmation of participation. This will give us time to check compatibility of the music and to contact participating clubs if problems should arise.

The organizing committee will publish them via the Sportity-App. Starting orders for Seniors, Juniors and Advanced Novice Free Program will be in reverse order to the final result of the short programs.

The trophy „**Internationaler Pokal der Stadt Innsbruck**“ („International Cup of Innsbruck“) will be awarded to the skaters with the **highest total score** (Ladies and Men).
