FINAL INSTRUCTIONS 1 These Final Instructions form part of the event Regulations

Dear Competitor,

Thank you for your entry for this event.

Your competitor sign on declaration is now live and must be completed (complete and submit one form for driver and one form for navigator) via <u>www.rallyscore.net</u>.

Your competition number and scrutiny time can be found on the list at the end of these final instructions and also on the Rallyscore website.

ALL COMPETITORS MUST HAVE THEIR DECLARATIONS COMPLETED BY 8PM on WEDNESDAY 8TH MARCH 2023 otherwise your place will be given to a competitor on the reserve list.

To those competitors who had not entered any seeding information on the original entry form, no discussions on seeding will be entered into. The Start time list will be issued with Final Instruction 2.

Mechanical scrutineering and noise testing will be held on Saturday 11th of March 2023, at Bishopscourt Racing Circuit.

Noise Testing:

All competing cars and Course '0' Cars at each event have to be noise tested under sections R.4.1 & J5.18 of the Motorsport UK 2023 Regulations Yearbook. This is a mandatory Motorsport UK requirement for all rallies.

The Motorsport UK limit for the noise test is 100 decibels.

NO DOCUMENTS WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE ORGANISERS, SHOULD YOU WISH TO CARRY TIMECARDS OR THE ROUTE DIAGRAMS YOU MUST PRINT THESE AND BRING THEM TO THE EVENT YOURSELF.

TIMECARDS AND ROUTE DIAGRAMS ARE ATTACHED TO THIS EMAIL. PLEASE NOTE AS NO TIME CARDS ARE BEING USED BY THE OFFICIALS THE ATTACHED TIMECARDS ARE FOR YOUR USE ONLY. EVENT ORGANISERS TIMING AND CHECKSHEETS WILL BE FINAL. FULL DETAILS OF TIMING WILL BE IN FINAL INSTRUCTION 2.

Follow the stage type arrows from the Belfast Rd., Downpatrick through Downpatrick to Bishopscourt Racing Circuit.

Please note **only** competing vehicles and service vehicles will be allowed access to the service area.

NOTE: <u>Vehicles, whether competing or Service, arriving AFTER 08:30 hrs will</u> <u>NOT gain entry to the Service Area.</u>

On arrival at the Service Area please follow the instructions of the Marshals and park your Service Vehicle in the areas indicated. If you follow their instructions there will be plenty of room for everyone.

Planned service will take place after stages 1,2,3,4 & 5.

START AND STAGE FINIISH PROCEDURE

Full details of paperless event timing procedures will be in Final Instruction 2.

Competitors are reminded of the Motorsport UK Regulations regarding helicopters and fixed wing aircraft:-

R39.3. During the course of an event, competitors are not permitted to use, or be directly or indirectly concerned in the use of, helicopters or fixed wing aircraft in the vicinity of the event (whether in connection with servicing, aerial surveillance or any other reason whatsoever), unless previous authority has been obtained from Motorsport UK in writing and in compliance with CAA regulations (E.2.2.6).

R39.3.1. Before considering any application for authorisation Motorsport UK must be satisfied that any liabilities they consider apply to the activities, including indemnity cover from Motorsport UK, the event promoters, Organisers and the landowner, have been made available by the operator on their behalf to specified minimum requirements.

R39.3.2. Any application must be made at least 14 days before an event.

R39.3.3. In accordance with CAA regulations, no aircraft is allowed within 500ft of the route, or within 3,000ft of any large crowd.

Penalties for breach of these regulations are left to the discretion of the Clerk of the Course which may go as far as exclusion (G.5.3).

DRONES POLICY

Recreational use of drones is not allowed at events run under a Motorsport UK Permit

Commercial/media operators may only use drones for aerial work at events run under a Motorsport UK Permit when all of the following requirements are met:

1 The drone operator holds a valid CAA Permission and operates within the parameters of that CAA Permission at all times

2 The drone operator holds a minimum £5million public liability insurance cover, specific to aerial work

3 The drone operator prepares an operations plan and submits it to the event organiser in advance

4 The drone operator has the prior written agreement of the event organiser and venue owner, and operates within the parameters of their permissions, which may be more restrictive than a CAA Permission

5 The drone operator signs on with the event organisers before operating the drone

6 The drone operator does not overfly the competition course (track or stage), and any assembly areas, including spectator areas, paddocks and service areas

7 The drone operator obeys the instructions of event Marshals and/or Officials at all times.

In the case of stage rally events, the drone operator must also hold Motorsport UK Rally Media Accreditation.

Note the following amendments/additions to the Supplementary Regulations:-

SPILL KITS

Spill kits MUST be carried by all competing cars during the rally and if used they must be placed in the bag provided and taken to your local recycling centre for disposal.

SAFETY NOTES

Safety notes are **NOT** permitted on this event. The organisers will appoint Judges of Fact whose duties may include carrying out searches for notes. Only the organisers map may be used.

RECONNAISSANCE

In accordance with regulations you will be permitted to make a reconnaissance of the stages on Saturday 11thMarch 2023 between 06:30 hrs & 08:30 hrs. Competitors may recce ONLY ON FOOT OR PEDAL CYCLE between these times. NO MOTORISED TRANSPORT WILL BE PERMITTED.

NO PERSON WILL BE PERMITTED TO USE ANY FORM OF MOTORISED OR PEDAL TRANSPORT IN OR AROUND THE CIRCUIT AFTER 0900 THIS PARTICULARY <u>APPLIES TO CHILDREN</u>. If any person ignoring this instruction is connected to a competitor he/she will BE EXCLUDED.

THIS IS FOR EVERYBODYS SAFETY AND WILL BE ENFORCED.

Competitors are reminded as per Motorsport UK regulations

R48.5.13. The use of tyre heating devices are prohibited. Competing cars may warm their tyres and brakes on the way from the Service Area to the Stage Start via the circuit main straight, however there is a strict one-way traffic system and irresponsible driving including doughnuts, circles or U-turns will not be tolerated. A judge of fact will be appointed to monitor the use of tyre heating devices. Tyre temperatures may be monitored throughout the event. Should the Clerk of the course suspect any competitor to be in breach of this regulation the competitor will be penalised as per SR21.27. The Clerk of the Course's decision will be final.

R46.1.1. All cars must be currently registered and taxed as a private car, unless specific event regulations relax the requirement for taxation, by virtue of the entire event taking place wholly on private property.

(The organisers have decided to relax the requirement for taxation for this event as the event takes place wholly on private property).

J 5.13.7 All cars must be equipped with the facility to enable a fuel sample to be taken. For fuel injected cars the facility must be a dry break fuel sampling coupling approved by the FIA.

Please note the following request from the scrutineers.

• Any turbo charged car must have restrictor wired before coming to scrutiny to be sealed.

• Any car running as a Homologated car must bring wire and tools to scrutiny to be sealed.

Eligible entrants

The event is open to all fully elected members of Rathfriland Motor Club Ltd, Ballynahinch and District Motor Club Ltd and all members of a club affiliated to Motorsport UK or Motorsport Ireland. All drivers must complete an on-line declaration that they hold a valid Motorsport UK RS Interclub, or above, Stage Rally Competition Licence or equivalent MSI licence and a club membership card.

Co-drivers must complete an on-line declaration that they hold a valid Motorsport UK RS Interclub, or above, Competition Licence or equivalent MSI licence and a club membership card.

Where applicable an entrant's licence must also be held.
