## 4. GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The rally will be run in compliance with the effective National Sporting Regulations, Finish rally Championship 2025 series regulations, Nordic Rally Championship series regulations, and these SM O.K. Auto Rally regulations, approved by AKK Motorsport under by the organizer. Driving behavior must not endanger or disturb other traffic or nearby residents. Driving against the direction of a special stage is strictly prohibited. The organizer will monitor speeds and driving conduct during reconnaissance. The police will also monitor the route and enforce traffic laws.

Instructions from officials marked with the organizer's insignia must be followed under threat of disqualification. permit number nro12/RA/25. An English version of the rules will also be published, but in case of discrepancies, the Finnish version shall prevail. The competition is a NEAFP event and is therefore open to license holders from other national ASN organizations.



The total length of the rally is 380,5 km, including 8 special stages with a combined length of approx 89 km, of which 1,50 km (SS1) is tarmac.

Part 1 of the competition will be held on 11.07.25, with a total length of 52,5 km, including 2 special stages with a combined length of 8,80 km.

Part 2 of the competition will be held on Saturday, 12.07.2025, with a total length of 327,9 km, including 6 special stages with a combined length of 80,2 km.

The competitor is responsible for insuring their competition car so that the insurance is valid on special stages and covers damage caused to third parties. If the competitor or anyone acting on their behalf is found on the route in Hamina, Kouvola, Luumäki, or on yellow, grey, black, or unmarked roads on the Finnish road map before their designated start time — excluding the authorized reconnaissance time for classes 1–22 — they will be denied the right to participate in the competition.

The competition follows the regulations of the Finnish Center for Integrity in Sports (SUEK), available at [suek.fi](http://suek.fi), and the legislation concerning doping.

#### TRAFFIC INSURANCE:

Every car participating in the rally must have valid Finnish traffic insurance. Foreign competitors must indicate during registration if they want the organizer to arrange the insurance (cost: 55 €). The fee can be added to the registration payment. The car's chassis number must be provided during registration.

#### 8. SERVICE

The service area is located at Tykkimäki Motor Track, Tehontie 51, 45200 Kouvola.

**The service area opens on Friday 11.07.25 at 11:00.**

There are service breaks along the route. The timing of service breaks is stated in the rally schedule.

The rally uses a flexi-service system. The maximum service time is 40 minutes. Each competitor must ensure that their service start and end times are clearly visible at their service location.

Requests for joint servicing and specific service area preferences must be submitted by 04.07.25 at 20:00. Changes after this will incur a fee of 100 €.

All service vehicles must be equipped with a fire extinguisher and an oil-absorbent mat, ready for use. There must be a liquid-impermeable protective sheet under the engine bay of the service vehicle and under the competition car, covering at least the full base area of the vehicles. Failure to comply will result in a sanction determined by the Clerk of the Course.

#### 9. TYRES

SM and Suomi Cup: As specified in Ralli SM Series Regulations Article 16.

The total length of special stages for the competition is approximately 89.2 km. In classes 1–6, a maximum of 8 tyres may be used, according to Article 16 of the Series Regulations.

Tyre marking and inspections will be conducted as described in Article 16.2 of the Ralli SM Series Regulations.

#### 10. REFUELING

Refueling will be done at the designated refueling area in the service park or at a refueling zone indicated in the roadbook by the organizer, or at the ABC-Utti fuel station.

The competitor guide will contain a table of distances between special stages and liaison sections.

#### 11. RECONNAISSANCE

Competitors may collect the reconnaissance materials from the rally office on 10.07.25 between 17:00–21:00 or on 11.07.25 from 07:00 onwards. The competitor must submit details of their reconnaissance vehicle and phone number using the form available in the Sportity app.

Two (2) reconnaissance car identification stickers provided by the organizer must be affixed: one to the top center of the windshield and one to the right rear side window. These must remain visible throughout the reconnaissance.  
Competitors must comply with Finnish traffic laws and additional regulations during reconnaissance and the competition on all non-special stage sections. During reconnaissance, a maximum speed limit of 80 km/h applies on all special stages unless otherwise indicated by traffic signs or signs placed

Reconnaissance times: SS 2–8 on 11.07.25 from 08:00 to 17:00.  
SS1 reconnaissance on 11.07.25 from 16:00 to 17:00.

## 12. COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING

## 14. COMPETITOR MATERIAL

Competitor identity will be verified when collecting materials. One crew member may collect the material.

Each crew will receive from the rally office on 10.07.25 between 18:00–21:00 or on 11.07.25 from 07:00 onwards: a road book with detailed route instructions, two (2) route maps, reconnaissance materials (classes 1–22), GPS tracking device, TIME CARDS (3 pcs), and a service vehicle permit.

**Timing transponders will be distributed at the start area before TC1A.**

## 15. START

The list of eligible starters will be published in the Sportity app (code KOUVOLASM25) according to the schedule on the virtual official notice board.

Start location: Paraatikenttä 3, 45100 Kouvola, starting at 19:01, at one-minute intervals.

The list of eligible starters for Part 2 will be published in Sportity on 12.07.25 at 08:30.

There will be a 15-minute service break A after the overnight pause.

Failure to follow the prescribed competition route may lead to a penalty imposed by the Clerk of the Course, depending on the severity of the offense.

## 16. RESULTS

Provisional results will be published by class according to the event schedule on the official notice board. Final official results will be available on the official notice board, the KIT1 system, and the championship's official website.



**17. PRIZES AND PRIZE-GIVING**

The number of prize recipients will be announced on the official notice board.

Prizes will be awarded to both drivers on the finish podium, based on the provisional results, in the courtyard of Sokos Hotel Kouvolaan Vaakuna. The prize-giving schedule by class will be announced in the event program.
