



FIM EUROPE – Enduro European Cup – Nagytarcsa – 18–20 July 2025

Parade Information

1. Technical Inspection

During the technical inspection, riders present their motorcycles.
After completing the inspection, each rider must place their motorcycle into the **Parc Fermé**, along with the technical data sheet.

2. Participation in the Parade – Clothing and Equipment

Participation in the parade is **mandatory in full riding gear**, including:

- riding suit
- helmet
- protective gear
- boots

The parade will be conducted on motorcycles; each rider will join using their own vehicle.

3. Parade Assembly

The **Parc Fermé will only be open between 18:35 and 18:55**. Please arrive in an organized manner.

Location: The area in front of the tennis courts

Arrival: Riders may arrive with engines running, but engines must be switched off once in place.

Motorcycles may only be restarted on signal.

4. Team Members and Assistants

Team members and assistants may approach the site **on foot or by car via public roads**, using the gravel road behind the venue.

Only riders are allowed to enter the temporary Parc Fermé.

5. Parade Procedure

Start time: 19:00, with police escort.

Riders will proceed in groups of 2–3, at a slow pace.

- Crossing the center line is prohibited.
- Wheelies or any disruptive behavior are strictly forbidden.

Track marshals will supervise the parade. A police vehicle will close the procession.

6. Route

The parade starts from the **Grund-Paddock** and ends at the **church garden**, via public roads. Upon arrival, all motorcycles must be parked in the **temporary Parc Fermé**.

- No specific order is required
 - Motorcycles must be parked neatly and side by side
 - Marshals will assist with the arrangement

7. Presentation at the Church Square

After parking, all riders must leave the temporary Parc Fermé and group with their national teams.

Please do not obstruct bus or car traffic on the connecting road.

The presentation of countries and riders will take place on the stage set up in the church square.

8. Reassembling After the Presentation

After the presentation, riders will **return gradually** to the temporary Parc Fermé under marshal supervision.

Motorcycles must be pushed into place and lined up with engines off.

Bike stands and carpets are to be handed over to team members or assistants.

9. Return and Closing of the Day

Once all riders have exited the temporary Parc Fermé, they will return to the paddock under escort.
All motorcycles must be brought back into the **official Parc Fermé by 21:00**, with engines running.
