Important Information for Competitors

Start Time

- On both race days: 09:00
 - Only the red markings must be followed!
-

Bridge Crossing Rules

- There is a STOP sign on both sides of the bridge – stopping is mandatory!
 - After the STOP sign, the engine must be turned off and the motorcycle must be pushed across the bridge on foot until reaching the next trail.
 - A marshal will supervise the crossing – violations will be penalized.
 - This rule applies in both directions, at the beginning and end of the liaison section.

Liaison Section Safety

- Marshals will assist with crossing when exiting onto paved roads.
 - Please follow their instructions! If asked to stop, do so immediately.
 - Extra caution is required at any point where the route crosses a paved road.
 - On certain liaison sections (e.g. leading to the cross and enduro test), team members, assistants, and spectators may also be present.
 - Be mindful of one another – especially pedestrians!

Cross Test

- Everyone is required to walk and familiarize themselves with the course in advance.
 - Start signal: red light turns off.
 - You must start within 5 seconds after the start signal.
 - Start interval: 30 seconds.
 - After the cross test, another liaison section follows – continue to follow the red markings.

Liaison Section – Traffic Rules

- All junctions on the connecting dirt roads will be closed, but extra caution is still required.
 - Agricultural vehicles and hikers may appear at any time!
 - It is strictly forbidden to leave the designated main route or to enter agricultural land!
 - Leaving the marked route will result in immediate disqualification.

Enduro Test

- Everyone is required to walk and familiarize themselves with the course in advance.
 - Start signal: red light turns off.
 - You must start within 5 seconds after the start signal.
 - Start interval: 30 seconds.
 - After the enduro test, another liaison section follows – continue to follow the red markings.

Race Signage

- During the race, exclamation mark (!) symbols will be used to indicate:
 - Start of an enduro section
 - Dangerous areas
 - General warning
 - These symbols typically appear where:
 - Direction changes (turns)
 - Trail deviations occur
 - Particularly hazardous sections follow (e.g. descent, climb)
 - Please pay extra attention to these!

End of Liaison Section Rules

- The end of the section is marked by a STOP sign and an exclamation mark.
 - After this point, the maximum permitted speed is 25 km/h in the following areas:
 - Liaison sections
 - Entire paddock area
 - Gravel road leading to the paddock – this will be strictly monitored
 - Speed compliance will be checked by marshals using speed measuring devices.
 - The 25 km/h limit applies to competitors, team members, and assistants alike.

Environmental Regulations

- An oil collection point has been designated – its use is mandatory!
- Waste must be disposed of only in the designated containers.
- After the race, all participants must leave their area clean.
