IMPORTANT REMINDERS TO ALL COMPETITORS

- 1. Rally car's <u>extinguisher system must be armed at all times</u>. This will be checked throughout the rally by the scrutineers and all infringements will be reported to the Stewards who will impose a penalty.
- 2. We remind ALL participants that ALL FLAME-RESISTANT CLOTHING must be homologated as the FIA standard FIA 8856 2018 (Technical List N. 74) or FIA 8856-2000 (Technical List No 27, authorized for all drivers and co-drivers in the events of the European Baja Cups).
- 3. Drivers must ensure that they <u>wear their safety equipment properly on special stages all</u> <u>the way until the stop control</u> (helmets and seat belts fastened, balaclava inside the overall, overall zipper closed, driver's gloves worn etc.) and <u>have their safety belts correctly fastened</u>. All infringements will be reported to the Stewards who may impose a penalty. Please see art. 47.1 of FIA CCR SR.
- 4. Any crew which has the red "SOS" sign displayed to them, or which sees a car which has suffered an accident and the OK sign is not shown, shall immediately and without exception stop to render assistance. Any crew stopping on a special stage and who does not require immediate medical assistance, must activate the OK display in the FIA safety tracking device within one minute and show the OK sign to all other cars. All infringements will be reported to the Stewards who may impose a penalty. Please see art. 47.4 of FIA CCR SR.
- 5. In order to access a refuelling zone, all personnel involved in refueling operations must wear clothing that provides adequate protection against fire and includes at least: long trousers, long-sleeved top, closed shoes, gloves and a balaclava. It is required that the crew remain outside the car during refuelling. Please see art. 54.2 of FIA CCR SR.
