

## MIJRS Competitor Bulletin 2 – J1000

As you are aware, we recently received notification that the Laois Gravel Rallysprint event scheduled for October 18<sup>th</sup> will no longer be going ahead this year. The team in Laois Rally Sport Club worked tirelessly with Motorsport Ireland and the MI Rallies Commission to find a suitable alternative date but were unable to do so in the end.

Sadly, we were not able to find a suitable event that could be designated as an alternative for this event within the 2025 Calendar.

As a result, the MIJRS team wish to inform competitors of the following updates being made immediately to point scoring requirements for the 2025 MIJRS J1000 classifications;

- The minimum start requirement to be deemed eligible for final classification has now been set to **4 Events (Regardless of Rally or Sprint)**.
- The maximum score calculation will be a competitor's **best 5 scores (regardless of Rally or Sprint)**

With no alternative events scheduled and having lost two events this season, we are left with no other options! Steps are already underway with regards planning the 2026 Calendar to avoid similar issues.

The final round of the 2025 MIJRS J1000 calendar is;

- Donegal Forest Rally – November 8th
