4. INFORMATION

The rally will be run in compliance with the effective National Sporting Regulations and Finnish Rally Championship Regulations, Estonian Rally Championship Regulations, Baltic Sea Rally Championship Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations, which AKK Motorsport has approved with Visa number 12/R/24.

An English version of these Supplementary Regulations is to be published, but in a contradictory situation the Finnish regulations are ruling.























Total distance of the itinerary for classes 1-18 is 405,60 km, including 8 special stages, with a total distance of 101,26 km.

- Friday 24.5.: 2 special stages, of which tarmac 14,5 km, gravel 3,94 km.
- Saturday 25.5.: 6 special stages, of which tarmac 2,62 km, gravel 80,2 km.

Total distance of the itinerary for classes 19-21 is 333,09 km, including 6 special stages, with a total distance of 82,82 km.

Of which tarmac 2,62 km.

If a competitor or his/her delegate is met on the roads in Masku, Nousiainen, Mynämäki, Rusko, Sauvo, Salo and Lieto in the yellow, grey, black or unmarked roads on the road map of Finland before the competitor's start time, excluding designated reconnaissance time for classes 1-18 according to the Supplementary Regulations Art. 9, the competitor will be excluded from the Rally.

Competitors of Estonian Rally Championship will be placed in the road starting order with the Finnish Championship classes.

6. **ENTRY**

Everyone who wants to participate in SM Mad-Croc Länsirannikon Ralli must register via KITI portal, competitors from outside of Finland must use the entry form found in the Official Notice Board. Secondary instructions for entries are given by the Secretary of the Rally.

Upon entering the rally, competitors must state the fuel they are using and the fueling method in Kiti portal under "additional information".

By the order of the entries, first 150 crews who have completed the registration according to the rules are accepted for the rally. Possible eliminations is performed from the extra classes, not from the competitors competing for the Western Finland local championship competitors.

Registration must be with the organizer no later than 13.5.2024 at 21:00 local time.

Usage of the competitor's information by the organizer:

Upon completing the registration competitors accept the usage of his/her personal information by the organizer and publication of the pre-determined personal information (name, nationality etc.) in the entry list, results etc. Rally media.

8. COMPETITOR MATERIAL

Competitor's identity will be subject of inspection upon the collection of competitor material.

Classes 1-18 competitors are handed a road book that indicates the detailed itinerary, 2 x road maps, door numbers, timing cards, and GPS tracking device from the Rally Office on Thursday 23.05.2024 between 18:00 and 21:00 and on Friday 24.05.2024 between 7:00 and 10:00.

Classes 19-21 competitors are handed the material (road book, 2 x road maps, door numbers, timing cards) and GPS tracking device from the Rally Office on Saturday 25.5.2024 from 8:00.

Timing transponders are handed during Safety Scrutineering for all classes.

9. RECONNAISSANCE

Competitors may collect the reconnaissance material on Thursday 23.05.2024 between 18:00 – 21:00 or on Friday 24.05.2024 between 7:00-10:00 from the Rally Office. The reconnaissance starts 24.5.2024 at 8:00 and ends 24.5.2024 at 18:00. Reconnaissance is allowed in classes 1-18.

Reconnaissance on special stages 1 and 2 is restricted to 24.5.2024 between 14:00-18:00.

Competitor's identity will be subject of inspection upon the collection of competitor material.

GPS tracking devices are given with the reconnaissance material, and they must be in use for the whole duration of the reconnaissance. The competitors must have a USB power outlet in his/her reconnaissance car for the GPS device and it must be powered for the whole reconnaissance. After the reconnaissance, before the competitor's starting time for the section 1, the driver must move the GPS tracking device to his/her rally car.

Organizer provided two (2) reconnaissance car identifications must be fitted in the middle and up of the windscreen and to the right back side window and must be visible for the whole reconnaissance time.

The speed limit of 80 km/h is valid on all Special Stages during the reconnaissance unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or signs placed by the organizer. Driving during the reconnaissance must not endanger or inconvenience other traffic or people close by.

Driving in the opposite direction of the special stage is prohibited.

The identifications on the reconnaissance cars must be removed immediately after the end of the reconnaissance period. Cars used in the reconnaissance must not be parked on the service area after the end of the reconnaissance. Upon breaching these rules, the competitor will be penalized with a 100 euro fine. In case of repeated breaches, the competitor may be penalized further.























10. COMPETITOR NUMBERS AND ADVERTISEMENTS

The competition number bases used in the Rally are according to the FRC Regulations.

Championship Rally windscreen advertisement: According to the rules of the FRC. Classes 8-15 windscreen advertisement is open.

11. SAFETY SCRUTINEERING

Safety scrutineering will be held in the Peltola Ammatti-instituutti, Hamppukatu 2, 20740 Turku.

Entering the area with transport equipment and/or trailers is **FORBIDDEN**.

Inspection of the rally car documents is done online. Competitor must send either scanned or photographed documents no later than 22.5.2024 at 18:00 local time to rallismkatsastus@autourheilu.fi the following documents:

- Scrutineering card page 1 and page 2
- Homologation form or pass page 1
- Road inspection confirmation
- Rally car transfer permit or registration
- Safety cage homologation/certification form page 1
- Catalysator certificate page 1

Safety scrutineering ends 10 minutes after the last booked scrutineering time. In case a competitor wishes to change his/her scrutineering time after the closing of the booking system, contact Chief of Scrutineering Juho Laaksonen phone +358 41 5272 099 juho.laaksonen@turunua.fi

Organizer imposes a 50 € fee in these cases.

12. TIRES/CHASSIS

Contrary to the FRC regulations, classes 1-6 and 9-18 can use up to 12 tires.

During the rally the use of two (2) of these tires is restricted to only Friday 24.5.2024 on special stages 1 and 2. These tires must be marked in the tyre code form's first two rows with an extra marking "PE".

The make and model of the tyres used in the competition are unrestricted as long as they comply with the FRC regulations. However the tyre make, model (surface tread) and the diameter of the rim used on Friday 13.5.2022 has to be the same as in the tyres used on Saturday 14.5.2022. This applies to classes 1-18.

The competitor may have up to two spare tires in the car.

Competitors must deliver the organizer a list of all the tyres to be used in the rally by filling the series tyre code form in accordance to the FRC Regulations. The form must be returned no later than Friday 24.5.2024 at 18:00 local time via email to rallismkatsastus@autourheilu.fi, the subject of email must be the competitor number and the name of the 1st driver. The tyre code form is found on the Official Notice Board. The list must contain barcode/FIA-code, tyre make and model (for example, Michelin M80, Pirelli K4) NOTICE! In example, not Pirelli Sottozero!

In case the competitor has tires that are missing the FIA Barcode or the barcode is located only on one side of the tyre, contact Chief Scrutineer Juho Laaksonen phone number +358 41 5279 0099 the day before the start of the Rally at latest.

The usage of a special chassis (springs and shock absorbers) made for tarmac driving is prohibited. Anti-roll bars according to the class regulations.

13. START

Start time of each crew will be published according to the programme on the official notice board.

An international time card is used.

The start of the competition is at 24.05.2024 at 19:30 for classes 1-18.

Section 2 start times are published Friday evening as scheduled in programme.























Route given in the Road Book must be followed on the liaison sections, under penalty of exclusion by the Clerk of the Course

14. TIMING CARDS

Timing cards are a separate document and is given together with the competitor material. Timing cards are meant for the personal use of the competitors. Writing markings and notes on the timing cards is allowed.

Timing card is not to be handed to the officials. The competitors indicate their willingness to hand out the timing card to the official by putting the timing card against the window. The officials nod to indicate that they have notified the timing card, and write the time on a big whiteboard that corresponds to the competitor's timing card and show the board to the competitors. The competitors write the time/times to their timing card and indicate that they have received the information by putting their thumbs up.

15. SERVICE AND REGROUP

Centralized Service Park is used in the Rally, servicing in anywhere else is prohibited.

Service Park will be opened on Friday 24.5.2024 at 10:00 local time.

The parking of the reconnaissance cars in the service area is not allowed.

Servicing during the rally is done according to the following:

On Friday after SS2 there is a possibility for service for 10 min. This is included in the liaison time.

Parc Ferme in without predetermined time.

Service A 15min, Service B 30 min and Service C 30 min in the centralized service park.

Flex service is in use in services A, B, and C.

The rally does not contain a regroup. The possible reduction of the starting intervals is done in the flex services B and C.

16. REFUELING

Refueling is allowed on the service stations indicated on the road book and the refueling areas marked by the organizer.

The refueling area is located near the service park for the competitors refueling from their own equipment.

17. SPECIAL REGULATIONS

On Saturday 25.5.2024 after time control AT2C, AT4B and AT6B in the liaison is an area where the possible competitor interviews are to take place. The competitors are obligated to stop if asked. Interview time approx. 5min is taken into account in the liaison times.

18. RESULTS

The provisional results will be published by class according to the schedule in the Rally Guide on the Official Notice Board. The official results will be found on the Official Notice Board and KITI portal.

19. PRIZES AND PRIZE GIVING

The number of awarded competitors will be published at the Official Notice Board.

The prizes will the given to the both competitors according to the provisional/official results.
