4. GENERAL INFORMATION

This rally will be run in compliance with the effective National Sporting Regulations, Finnish Rally Championship Regulations 2026, Terminal Autoralli Eesti Meistrivõistlused ja karikavõistlused 2026 Regulations and Jyväskylä SM Ralli 2026 Supplementary Regulations (which AKK Motorsport has approved with [Visa No. 19111/RA/26](#)). The supplementary regulations are also published in English. In case of any dispute, the Finnish versions will be determinative.

For classes 1-19 rally will include Sections 1 and 2. Total distance of the itinerary is 356,15 km including seven (7) Special Stages. Distance of the Special Stages is 91,4 km in total.

For classes 20-31 rally will include Section 2. Total distance of the itinerary is 340,52 km including six (6) Special Stages. Distance of the Special Stages is 87,28 km in total.

Section 1 driven on 12. June 2026. Total distance of Section 1 is 15,63 km, including one (1) Special Stage, distance 4,12 km total.

Section 2 driven on 13. June 2026. Total distance of Section 2 is 340,52 km, including six (6) Special Stages, distance 87,28 km total.

If a competitor or their Delegate is met prior to his starting time on the roads used as Special Stages in the Rally and marked yellow, grey or black or unmarked roads in the road map of Finland in the area of Jyväskylä, Muurame, Jämsä, Petäjävesi or Uurainen, the competitor will be prohibited to participate in the Rally.

The event follows the regulations by Finnish Center for Integrity in Sports (FNCIS), which can be found at [suek.fi](#), as well all doping related Finnish legislation.

VIRTUAL CHICANE

Virtual Chicane will be set up in the location given in the Road Book on SS 6. There will be approach warning signs 100 meters before the chicane area. Distance of the chicane area is 100 meters, and within these 100 metres, the speed of the rally car must go down to a maximum of 60 km/h. There will be speed sign boards installed before the area and before end of the area, where Competitors can control their own speed. At the chicane area, there is narrow wooden bridge, which requires extra caution and must be crossed by slow speed!

6. ENTRY PROCEDURE

By the order of entries, 170 first crews who did the registration according to the regulations are accepted to the Rally.

Possible elimination is performed by following criterias:

- Elimination from classes 20 - 31
- Time of the Entry has been made
- Competitors background and previous success

The administrative check will be done electronically via the forms (contact details during the event and information for the commentator) available at the Official Notice Board (Sportity). The forms must be returned at the latest on 10. June 2026 at 15:00.

8. SERVICE

Servicing is only allowed at Service Park in the Rally, located at Jyväskylä Paviljonki.

For classes 1-19, there is one service after SS1, and two (2) Service Areas after TC 3A and TC5A.

For classes 20-31, there will be two (2) Service Areas after TC 3A and TC5A.

Service A:

Service time includes Road Section time between SS1 and TC1A (TC1A is Parc Ferme IN).

Service B and C:

Competitors will be given Service OUT time (for TC 3B/5B) already at TC 3A/3B (Service IN). Upon arriving at these services' Regroup In TC, competitors will be given a Service Out time. The time includes 3 minutes for technical inspection (scrutineering), regrouping time and a service time of 30 minutes

The competitor may start the 30 minute service at a time of their choosing by marking the start time on the Road Book page. The page must be placed visibly on the windscreen. The service is monitored by the organizer. Same procedure follows at Service B and C.

When 30 minute Service Time is used, it is not allowed to do any other service acts for the car.

Competitors will leave from the service through TC 3B/TC 5B (Service OUT) by their own due time, no matter what time the servicing has ended.

Violations related to the service time (starting service too early or exceeding the service time) are sanctioned according to the Finnish Rally Championship Regulations 2026 art. 15.8

Sanctions for other violations in the service and refueling areas:

- 1st violation 300€
- 2nd violation 600€
- 3rd violation Exclusion from the Rally imposed by the Clerk of the Course

Organizer reserves service area according to the Finnish Rally Championship 2026 regulations Art. 15.5.

After this time, the organizer charges 100 €/competitor for the possible changes. The organizer reserves the right to reject the requests.

Service cars must have a fire extinguisher and ready-to-use oil spill kit for each crew. Each Rally car must have a liquidimpermeable protective ground sheet covering the area of the car under the car during the service. Also the protective ground sheet is required under the engine bay of Service Car/Van. Lack of any of the above-mentioned leads to immediate exclusion from the Rally imposed by the Clerk of the Course.

Service Park is located Downtown of Jyväskylä, and there is plenty of civil traffic around the area. It is strictly forbidden to leave any trash around the area, and waste collecting points must be respected.

9. TYRES

In classes 1–6 it is permitted to use 8 tyres that comply with Finnish Rally Championship Regulations 2026, Art 17.1 and 17.5. These tires should be notified with the tyre bar code form which needs to be returned via email to rallismkatsastus@autourheilu.fi at the latest on Friday 12. June 2026 at 18:00. Subject of the e-mails should be competitors number and the name of the driver.

10. REFUEL

Refuelling is only allowed at petrol stations as determined by the Organiser, according to Art. 15. in the Finnish Rally Championship Regulations and at separately marked refuel zones.

On the road sections it is allowed to refuel using pumps or your own allowed petrol only at Refuel Zone, marked to the Road Book located near of the Service Park.

Competitors must inform the organiser during the administrative checks about the fuel used during the event (98E, E85, or national supplement Art 252.9 of Appendix J), and also how refueling will be executed (at petrol station, or by pump).

Refuel Zones ,including distances and calculated consumption are informed at the Rally Guide.

11. RECONNAISSANCE

Reconnaissance is accepted only for competitors in classes 1-25.

Two (2) passages are allowed on Special Stages during the reconnaissance.

Collection of Reconnaissance materials from the Race Office, Jyväskylä Paviljonki as follows:

Thursday 11. June 2026 at 18:00-21:00

Friday 12. June 2026 at 07:00-09:00

During the Reconnaissance registration, competitors must return the reconnaissance information sheet (including phone number and reconnaissance car details).

Two (2) identification numbers must be attached to the reconnaissance car at the top center of the windscreen and the right rear side window and kept visible for the whole duration of reconnaissance. The numbers must be removed after the reconnaissance

Speed limit of 80 km/h is valid on all Special Stages during the reconnaissance unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or signs placed by the organizer. Driving during the reconnaissance must not endanger or inconvenience other traffic or people living close by. Crews are only permitted to enter and leave Special Stages through the start and finish during the reconnaissance. **Exception**, SS5 it is allowed to follow the route given at Road Book partly opposite driving direction of the SS. Extra caution must be followed all the time!

The organizer will control speed as well as the manner of driving during reconnaissance. The police will also supervise on the route and may penalize traffic infringements according to the Finnish Traffic Law.

GPS tracking devices will be handed out with the reconnaissance material and must be used during the reconnaissance. The competitor must have a USB connection in the reconnaissance car and keep the tracking device connected throughout the reconnaissance. Competitor must move the GPS tracking device into their rally car after the reconnaissance, prior to their starting time.

Competitors are obligated to follow stopping requests of the Rally Officials with the organizer's identifications, or the penalty will be refusal to start.

Reconnaissance for stages 2-7 is allowed at 12. June 2026 between 7:00-17:00. Reconnaissance for Special Stage No. 1 is allowed between 14:00-17:00.

12. **COMPETITOR NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING**

Pre-event scrutineering starts on Friday 12 June at 10:00.

Documents for scrutineering must be submitted by email to rallismkatsastus@autourheilu.fi by Wednesday 10. June 2026 at 15:00 latest. Subject of the e-mails should be competitors number and the name of the driver.

If competitor wants to change the booked time for pre-event scrutineering, organiser will collect 50 euros (€) fee. Same fee will be collected, if competitor won't book the scrutineering time during the given time window. Payment must be executed to Rally Office one hour (1 hr) before own start time.

Competitors must bring the car to Scrutineering venue 10 minutes before booked time.

Sealing:

- The spare parts to be sealed and registered for the competition are inspected and, if necessary, sealed during the pre-event scrutineering
- If the competitor wishes to replace a sealed part (turbochargers or a FIA pop-off valve), the competitor must make a report by phone to Chief Scrutineer Ari Saxberg tel. +358 404123458

Pre-event scrutineering ends 10 minutes after the end of the last scrutineering time.

14. **SHAKEDOWN STAGE**

Official Shakedown Stage is NOT available.

15. **MATERIALS**

Each crew will receive one road book describing the rally route in detail, time cards, two (2) route maps, GPS-tracker, the reconnaissance car identification stickers and the competitor number stickers. Also possible Championship windscreen sticker.

Schedule for material collection:

- Classes 1-25, Thursday 11. June 2026 at 18:00 - 21:00 and Friday 12. June 2026 at 7:00 - 9:00
- Classes 26-31, Saturday 13. June 2026 at 8:00 onwards.

Both crew members must be present at material collection, presenting driving licences and personal ID's.
