Art. 1.1 Preamble

These supplementary regulations are based on the current version of the FIA International Sporting Code including the appendices, the DMSB Rally Regulations with the technical provisions, the DMSB Event Regulations, the DMSB Licence Regulations, the general and special DMSB Award Regulations, the DMSB Environmental Regulations, the WADA/NADA Doping Regulations and the FIA Anti-Doping Regulations as well as the Sporting and Technical Series Regulations (if applicable), the FIA Code of Ethics and Code of Conduct and the DMSB Code of Ethics as well as the other FIA and DMSB regulations. Furthermore, the StVO and StVZO of the Federal Republic of Germany. Unless otherwise stipulated in these regulations, the provisions of the above-mentioned regulations apply.

If pyrotechnic devices are to be used, the guidelines issued by local authorities must be followed, and further details must be provided under the "Additional Provisions" section of the supplementary regulations.

Modifications, amendments and/or additions to these regulations shall be made by publication of numbered and dated bulletins.

In any case of doubt, contradiction or ambiguity, only the German Supplementary Regulations are binding!

The entry is binding when the organiser has bindingly confirmed the entry to the participant by letter or other means of communication or has published a binding entry list. The entry fee remains payable from this point in time (DMSB Event Regulations Art. 6 (4)).

Art. 4.6 Refund of entry fee

The entry fee will be refunded in full:

- if the event does not take place
- to teams whose entry has been rejected

The organiser may refund the entry fee on a pro rata basis to those competitors who are unable to start due to force majeure.

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Art. 5 Insurance and Exclusion of Liability

The insurance cover begins at the START and ends at the STOP of each special stage or with the exclusion of the participant from the event or the abandonment of the event by the participant, in accordance with the respective organiser's liability insurance.

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Art. 8.2 National Regulations, Maximum Speed on Special Stages

During Recce, the regulations of the German Road Traffic Regulations (StVO) and the road traffic authorities, in particular with regard to speed limits, must be observed at all times.

Maximum permitted speed on the special stages: 80 km/h

Please note that the special stages are not closed during Recce and that other road users must therefore be expected at all times. The organiser may individually specify a reduced speed for the inspection in the road book and by means of appropriate markings along the special stages compared to the German Road Traffic Regulations (StVO)/these supplementary regulations. Compliance with this regulation may be monitored.

The speed will be reduced to 50 or 30 km/h in specially defined areas. These areas are marked accordingly in the road book.



Speed in the specified areas will be monitored / controlled and infringements will be penalised in accordance with the regulations / catalogue of penalties. Multiple offences may result in non-admission to the start. The entry fee will not be refunded in this case.

Art. 8.3 Description of the Reconnaissance

All participants must adhere to the Recce times according to the timetable. Recce with competition vehicles is not permitted. The vehicles must be marked with a departure marking specified by the organiser. **The start numbers provided for Recce (colour: bright orange) must be affixed to the windscreen and the rear window (top, centre).** If these are already attached to the vehicle, they must be covered with a wide adhesive tape (X-shape).

The restrictions of the Reconnaissance (see DMSB Rally Regulations 2026, Art. 35) must be observed.

Art. 9 Administrative Checks

In order to minimise the time required for administrative checks, the following documents must be brought and presented.

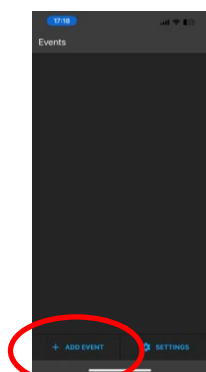

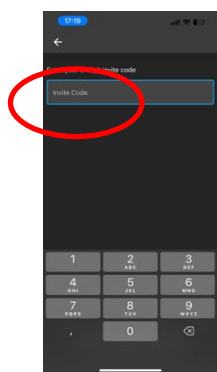

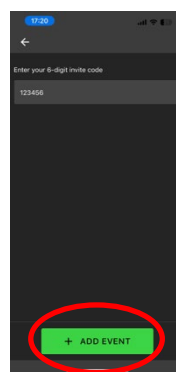
If you take part in an event and arrive there, you must log in for the event. Each vehicle/crew is assigned a unique code for logging into the app.



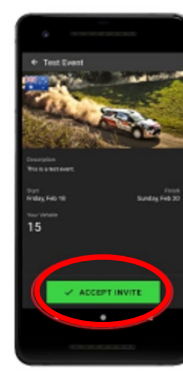

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The app is used for live tracking and real-time monitoring of each crew during Recce.

The device must both support the app and allow GPS tracking (activate or set in the respective device settings if necessary). The device must be switched on and functional at all times during the entire duration of Recce. Each crew is responsible for this! At the end of Recce, a report will be drawn up detailing any speeding offences.

Shakedown und Rally:

A tracking system (RallySafe) will be used during the event. The tracking system consists of a fitting kit (including antenna, wiring harness, mounting) and a tracking unit (for shakedown and sporting competition). To ensure safety and uninterrupted service, the tracking system requires a continuous power connection with 9 to 28 volts direct current. It is essential that the connection is **NOT CONNECTED TO THE BATTERY PLUS POLE (PERMANENT PLUS)**. It is also essential to ensure that the tracking unit is always supplied with power. The power supply must not be switched via the ignition.

The fitting kit must be pre-installed in all competition vehicles. The kit can either be hired at a price of € 30 per event or purchased online at a price of around € 160 to € 180:

Participants will receive the tracking unit and the fitting kit (if rented) for the competition vehicle at the RallySafe transporter in the service area (see programme in chronological order (Art. 3)).

The entire tracking system must be installed in the competition vehicle in working order and checked by members of RallySafe Nederland on the RallySafe transporter in the service area **BEFORE ANY TECHNICAL SCRUTINEERING**.

EVERY CREW THAT RECEIVES AN APPROVAL OF THE TRACKING SYSTEM WILL RECEIVE A STICKER ON THE WINDSCREEN, DRIVER'S SIDE, TOP - ONLY THEN WILL SCRUTINEERING TAKE PLACE!

Approval sticker RallySafe:



Vehicles for which the tracking system could not be approved, which do not pass scrutineering and / or whose tracking system is not properly installed may not participate in the shakedown / event. In this case, the respective entry fee will not be refunded!

The system must be functional during shakedown and competition (i.e. during the entire event). The tracking unit must be returned immediately at the end of the competition.

No deposit is required for the tracking unit. All participants sign for the return of the tracking unit. If the tracking unit is not returned to the organiser / RallySafe Nederland on the same day at the end of the event, the competitor / crew will immediately receive an invoice in the amount of € 2,000,00 which must be paid immediately and without deductions!

Competitors / crews who (have to) end the event prematurely and cannot enter the Parc Fermé must return the RallySafe tracking system equipment (brackets, unit, antenna, etc.) to the service area (RallySafe transporter) **IMMEDIATELY**.

Competitors / crews who finish the event regularly and enter the Parc Fermé must remove and return the RallySafe tracking system technology **IMMEDIATELY AFTER** entering the Parc Fermé (ZK/TC 13 B) independently by the CREW using only the equipment on board and without any outside help (exception: RallySafe employees).

The tracking system or the RS-Lite app must be permanently active during the inspection period, during the shakedown and during the competition (with the exception of the parc fermé). An inactive system will result in a fine of € 100, imposed by the rally organiser. Further offences will be reported to the stewards for further punishment.

For the issue of the tracking unit and - if required - the fitting kit at the RallySafe transporter in the service area, **THE ENTRY CONFIRMATION WITH THE START NUMBER MUST BE SHOWN**.

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The Power Stage will be determined in advance by the organiser / clerk of the course. If the planned POWER STAGE cannot be driven, the rally organiser will, if still possible, designate one of the remaining special stages as the POWER STAGE. The participants will be informed of this early enough.

Art. 11.5 Special Procedures and Activities

Re Art. 44.2.10 Any difference between the actual check-in time and the target check-in time shall be penalized as follows:

- for late arrival: 10 seconds per minute or fraction of a minute
- for early arrival: 60 seconds per minute or fraction of a minute

Art. 11.5.1 Conduct of Participating Crews

The organizer expressly points out that the German Road Traffic Regulations (StVO) apply on all sections of the event outside the special stages! 'Warming up' the tyres of the competition vehicles is prohibited and will be monitored by the organizer. Participants who fail to comply with the regulations will be reported to the stewards immediately.

Art. 11.5.2 Deactivation of Automatic Emergency Notification

The automatic emergency alert (Emergency SOS) and fall detection features in the settings of mobile phones, watches and similar devices must be disabled whilst the special stage is in progress.

Art. 11.5.3 Deceleration zone

In accordance with Art. 5.5.4.1(c) of Appendix H to the FIA International Sporting Code, the organiser shall place two cones on the right and left sides of the road at the finish of each special stage to reduce the crews' speed and force them to brake. The cones will be positioned approximately 100 metres before the stop. Their locations will be marked during the reconnaissance and in the road book.

Art. 11.6 Other Special Features

Art. 11.6.1 Use of yellow/red Flags

The following flag regulations will apply in accordance with the 2026 Rally Regulations:

- FIA-Regulations

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Art. 11.6.2 Refuelling and Processes

The provisions of the DMSB Rally Regulations 2026 – V2 – Art. 62 apply. Vehicles must be fitted with an FT safety tank (in accordance with Art. 253-14, Appendix J, ISG), as well as those fitted with FIA-approved fuel connections – so-called FIA valves (e.g. from Stäubli) – and which are refuelled and vented via the aforementioned valves, may, upon application, refuel in refuelling zones (TZ) or remote refuelling zones, in accordance with Art. 62.

Art. 11.6.3 Re-start after Breakdown

Teams that have retired during leg 1 and wish to restart in leg 2 may do so in accordance with the provisions of Rally Regulations Art. 54.

Art. 11.6.4 Tyre Warming Zone

Tyre warming zones will be set up before most of the special stages in accordance with the DMSB Rally Regulations 2026; these are listed in the Road Book.

Art. 11.6.5 Accessibility of Competitors

Competitors who have parked their vehicle in the Parc Fermé after crossing the finish line must be reachable by telephone (mobile) until the end of the publication of the final results.

Art. 11.6.6 Result Lists

Results lists will not be sent out after the event, they will be available at the organiser's website <http://www.rallye-mittelrhein.de> and the SPORTITY app.

Art. 11.7 Official Time during the Event

The official time is GPS time (satellite time).

Art. 11.8 Authorised fuel (according to FIA ISG Appendix J + DMSB regulations)

Only unleaded fuel in accordance with Art. 252.9 Annex J (ISG) may be used, which complies with DIN EN 228 or diesel fuel in accordance with Art. 252.9 and DIN EN 590. Any additives, with the exception of air or lubricating oil for 2-stroke engines, are prohibited. In addition, the octane limit value of max. 103 RON instead of 102 RON applies to petrol.

Art. 11.9 Drivers' Briefing (VR Art. 18)

A drivers' briefing will take place in accordance with the programme (Art. 3). The drivers' briefing will be organised in writing by the clerk of the course. Each competitor / crew is obliged to inform himself about the publication on the Official Notice Board.

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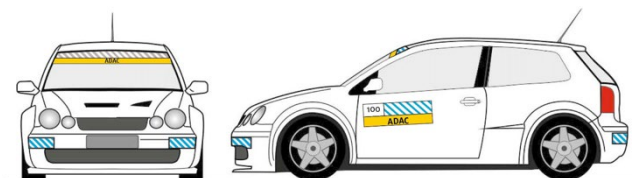
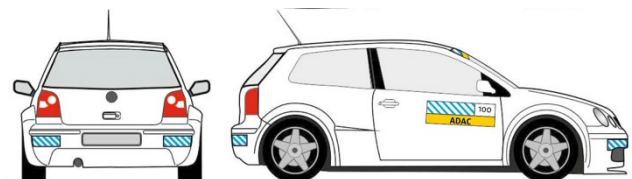
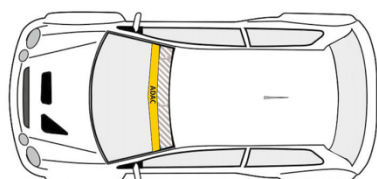
