Competition regulations

The competition will be conducted using the ISU Judging System with Video Replay according to the guidelines for competitions 2025/2026, the regulations of the Austrian Figure Skating Association (ÖWO 2025), the International Skating Union (ISU), as well as relevant Skate Austria guidelines and ISU Communications. The calculation and announcement of results will follow the Int. Special Regulations S&P in all groups.

Eligibility to participate

Participation in the Feldkirch Trophy is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member or an affiliated club and qualify with regard to eligibility and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109 and ISU Communication 2526 or any updates.

Liability

The organizing club takes no liability for participants and officials (ÖWO Rule 130).
The ice surface may only be accessed by competitors and officials during the event.

Traveling and Accommodation

No reimbursement for travel, accommodation or expenses is provided.
Referees, technical panel officials and judges will have their costs covered according to ÖWO Rule 163a.

Music

The music must be sent to: feldkirchtrophy.music@gmail.com until February 5th 2026
Two backup USB sticks should be brought to the competition and submitted in case of music issues.

The music files should be labeled as follows: LAND_Category_SP/FS_FAMILY NAME-Given name.
Example: **AUT_Men-AdvNov_SP_MUSTERMANN-Max**

Draw

The start order will be randomly generated via an electronic drawing system at least 72 hours and at most 24 hours before the start of each group.
The schedule, entry list, and start lists will be published immediately on the Sportity app.

Entries

Entries must be sent together with the PPC sheets and the music files to: nicole@pepperpot.at

Entry and result lists, as well as photos of participants, will be published online and via the Sportity app. The submitting club and the skaters acknowledge this in the registration. By entering the competition, skaters or their legal guardians agree to the publication.

Deadline for Entries

05.02.2026

Late entries are only possible via e-mail with approval from the hosting club.

Withdrawal

Withdrawal before the deadline is permitted via e-mail. Any entry fees paid will be refunded.

Withdrawal after the deadline must be submitted via e-mail; the fee must be paid and will not be refunded.

Jury

The composition of the judging panels and technical panels will follow the Skate Austria guidelines. The organization of the panels must be submitted to the Skate Austria secretariat at least 7 days before the competition.

Categories

Programs must comply with the Skate Austria Competition Guidelines 2025/2026 and ÖWO.

Participation in multiple groups within a single discipline is not permitted.

The announced categories will follow the ISU rules and specifications in the Skate Austria competition guideline.

Rules for Seniors, Juniors, Advanced Novice, Intermediate Novice, Basic Novice

According to the rules of the ISU.

Rules for Pre-Novice (Cubs) & Juvenile (Chicks)

According to "Special Regulations for competitions in Austria 2025/26" under this link:

A well balanced Free Skating program for Pre-Novice (Cubs) & Juvenile (Chicks) Girls & Boys must contain:

- Maximum of four (4) jump elements for girls and boys. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or jump sequences. Jump combinations or sequences can contain only two (2) jumps.
 - Juvenile (Chicks): Double and triple jumps are not permitted. Only one (1) single jump may be executed twice.
 - Pre-Novice (Cubs): Triple jumps are not permitted. Only one (1) single or double jump (incl. Double Axel) may be executed twice.
- There must be a maximum of two (2) spins (different abbreviations):
 - one spin in one position without change of foot in a basic position with a minimum of four (4) revolutions, no level features are allowed, and max. level basic will be called. Flying entry is not allowed. 8 revolutions can be done but will not count as an attempted feature.
 - one spin free of choice with a different abbreviation to the spin in one position (for example: USp and SSp are different abbreviations), minimum of four (4) revolutions, max. level 1, flying entry/entrance is not allowed.
- There must be a maximum one (1) step sequence. The step sequence must fully cover the ice surface and include at least one (1) skating movement (such as spirals, spread eagles, Ina Bauer, hydroblading etc.) to be counted. If the skating movement is missing, the sequence will receive no value.
 - Juvenile: Maximum level basic
 - Pre-Novice: Maximum level 1. A minimum of one (1) clean difficult step or turn must be included (rocker/counter/bracket/twizzle/loop/choctaw), if the difficult step or turn is missing the sequence will receive no value.
- Girls under 8 years will participate in the group “Pre-Juvenile” (same program as “Juvenile”).

The following Program Components are judged (factor 1,67):

- Composition
- Presentation
- Skating Skills
