General Regulation

The Feldkirch Trophy will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Figure Skating as well as pertinent ISU Communications for the categories Seniors, Juniors, Advanced Novice, Intermediate Novice, Basic Novice, Pre-Novice and Juvenile and in accordance with Skate Austria ÖWO (Skate Austria Wettlaufordnung and Richtlinie 2024/2025: https://skateaustria.at/wp-content/uploads/2024/08/Richtlinie-fuer-Wettbewerbe-in-Oesterreich-2024-2025-V3-final.pdf).

Liability

In accordance with the ISU Rule 119, the Organizer accepts no liability for bodily or personal injury, or for property loss or damage incurred by any Competitors or any kind of Officials.

Musik

The music should only be provided digitally (via computer)!

- Skaters/clubs from Austria should upload their music for the Feldkirch Trophy via Skate Austria Portal. If the category differs to your national category, please contact <u>thomas.biegler@skateaustria.at</u>
- Skaters/clubs from all other countries should send their music by E-Mail <u>nicole@pepperpot.at</u>

The sent music files must show competitor's name, nationality, category, program (short/free skating). Mandatory music format is a mp3 file.

We highly recommend to send the music files very soon after confirmation of participation. This will give us time to check compatibility of the music and to contact participating clubs if problems should arise.

Draw

The draw for the starting order takes place after the closing date of entries using a random generator (computer-supported draw) at the earliest 72 hours and at the latest 24 hours before the start of the respective starting group. The schedule as well as the entry list and start lists will be published immediately via Sportity app. The starting order for the free program is run in the reverse order of the short program results (reverse order).



Entries

- Clubs from Austria have to register skaters for Eiscup via Skate Austria Portal latest by <u>February 2nd</u>, <u>2025</u>.
- <u>Clubs from all other countries</u> must send the entry forms for their skaters latest by <u>February 2nd, 2025</u> to: <u>nicole@pepperpot.at</u>

The organizer reserves the right to limit the number of entries per club. Entries of skaters may be made only by the club concerned on the designated Official Forms.

Entry lists, competition schedules and results will be published at the Sportity-App. The organizing committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries due to limited ice availability. If the limit is reached we will close the entry list and offer further skaters to be put on the waiting list.

Entries will be on first come first serve principle. Those skaters who have not paid their entry fees till the entry fee deadline will be replaced by skaters next on the waiting list.

Planned Program Content Sheet

- Skaters/clubs from Austria should check if their uploaded PPC's at the Skate Austria Portal correspond to the entered category at Feldkirch Trophy.
- Skaters from all other countries must send the **Program Content Sheet** along with the **Entry Forms** to the Organizing Committee till **February 2nd**, **2025**, by email to: <u>nicole@pepperpot.at</u>

Entries will only be confirmed if the entry fee is paid via bank transfer by February 8th, 2025. Reimbursement of entry fees can only be offered for cancellations done latest by February 8th, 2025. In very special cases we may offer reimbursement also later (medical attests need to be sent along with withdrawals).

Attention: Please send all entry fees as one payment for the whole club. The entry fee will be forfeited if you do not show up or cancel your registration after the entry deadline.



Categories

Starting in several groups (within one discipline) is not permitted.

	A Pre-Novice Skater is a Skater who has met the following requirements before July 1st preceding the competition: Pre-Novice - not yet 10 years old
JUVENILE (Chicks) Girls & Boys	In accordance with Skate Austria Richtlinie 2024/2025
	A Juvenile Skater is a Skater who has met the following requirements before July 1st preceding the competition: Juvenile - not yet 10 years old

A well balanced Free Skating program for Pre-Novice (Cubs) Girls & Boys and Juvenile (Chicks) Girls & Boys must contain:

- Maximum of 4 jump elements There may be up to two (2) jump combinations. Jump combinations can contain only two (2) jumps.
 - Juvenile (Chicks): Double and Triple jumps are not permitted.
 - Only one (1) single jump may be executed twice.
 - Pre-Novice (Cubs): Triple jumps are not permitted.
 Only one (1) single or double jump (incl. Double Axel) may be executed twice.
- There must be a maximum of two (2) spins (different abbreviations)
 - one Spin without a change of foot in a basic position with a minimum of 4 revolutions, no level features shall be shown, max. Level Base, flying entrance is not allowed
 - one spin of free choice with a different abbreviation (for example: USp and SSp are different abbreviations), minimum of 4 revolutions, max. Level 1, flying entrance is not allowed
- There must be a maximum one (1) step sequence with a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only. The step sequence must cover the ice surface and include a free skating move to be counted.
 - o Juvenile (Chicks): Maximum Level Base, difficult turns or step are not obligatory
 - Pre-Novice (Cubs): Maximum Level 1: a minimum of one (1) correctly executed difficult step or turn must be included (Rocker/Counter/Bracket/Twizzle/Loop/Choctaw)

The Program Components are judged in

- Composition
- Presentation
- Skating Skills

The Factor of the Program Components is 1.67 Deductions (e.g. falls, time violation): -0,5
