## Recce Written Briefing – refer also to the Supplementary Regulations

Rally Convoy Lead Car - Cory Saxton Intermediate Cars Tail Car - Allan Baird

All in radio contact with each other, and will traverse the stages in the order given below. In order to try to relieve some of the congestion & delays that can occur on a large recce convoy, a new

system for recce is being tested this year.

For the Forestry Stages, recce will still take the form of a controlled convoy as in previous years.

Please ensure you are at the Start of these stages at the prescribed times.

These are the only times the Forestry Stages are open for recce.

Thurs 3rd April

Start time for first pass of SS10 7:30am - 7:45am Start time for first pass of SS1 & SS12 1:45pm - 2:00pm

Stages 1, 12, & 10 are WORKING FORESTS!

Forestry rules state a 50km/h speed limit.

Be prepared for logging trucks, YOU MUST GIVE WAY, NO EXCEPTIONS!

Lead car has radio contact with forestry operations.

Stay as close as it is safe, it's a long convoy.

For the remaining stages you are free to do them in the order and time of your choosing.

The following schedule is the Rally Organisers' suggestion of the most time efficient way to complete the recce.

Thursday Recce order: 10, 10, 9, 11, 9, 11, 14, 14, 15, 15, 1/12, 13, 1/12, 13. Allow approx 9.5 hrs for these stages, plus travel to and from the first & last.

Friday Recce order: 2, 2, 4, 5, 3/6, 4, 5, 3/6, 7, 7.

Allow approx 7.25 hrs for these stages, plus travel to and from the first & last.

These routes are indicated in the supplied Recce maps.

GPS positions of Stage starts and finishes are in the Road Book.

Most Stages will have an official at the start, logging vehicles as they enter the Stage. Wait for confirmation from the official before proceeding into the Stage.

You will be monitored throughout recce by the Rallysafe Light application.

Please ensure that you download the Rallysafe Lite app before you start recce and have it on at all times. You may need to check its operation throughout the Recce.

Except for the Forestry Stages, travel at no more than 80 km/h through the stages and expect to meet oncoming vehicles at any time.


Normal road speeds on touring between stages.

Keep left, don't cut blind right hand bends. The roads are open to the public.
