# OFFICIAL BULLETIN

This bulletin is issued under the provisions of the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code Article 18 in confirmation that the following amendments, notices or points of clarification have been authorised to the text of the Supplementary Regulations issued for the above named event. It is recommended that in addition to retaining a copy of this bulletin all parties modify the text of the regulations according to the following:

# Supplementary Regulations Part 2. (National Competition)

#### 1. Remote Refuel Zones

Refer Road Book

A maximum speed of 40km/hr monitored by Rallysafe shall apply through all remote refuel zones as follows:

- Page 9. Between Instructions 25 and 26
- Page 35. Between Instructions 6 and 7
- Page 58. Between Instructions 16 and 18
- Page 71. For 500 metres past Instruction 9

#### 2. Rejoining

- The Road Book contains a 'Temporary Withdrawal' form, a 'Final Withdrawal' form and a 'Rejoining form'.

- No competitor will be permitted to restart the rally once they have handed in a 'Final Withdrawal' form.
- If a competitor believes that they may be able to restart after an incident they should complete
  a 'Temporary Withdrawal' form and hand it to an appropriate official.
- If a competitor then wishes to re-join the event, they must only do so either (a) at the 'out' control of a Service Park or (b) at the start control of a stage. They must rejoin at a time that does not cause any delay to the event. They must hand in a 'Rejoining form' to the Post Chief. They must rejoin within the Division they started in. If this is not possible then they may be required to proceed to another stage before rejoining.
- All cars that have suffered accident damage must be checked and cleared by an appointed Scrutineer or designated official before rejoining.
