Chapter 4 : Accommodation / Transportation

All entrants who plan to stay at the hotel in the Mobility Resort Motegi for this event must make their hotel reservation through TOBU TOP TOURS, the official travel agent of the Mobility Resort Motegi.

TOBU TOP TOURS also arrange and make reservations for airline tickets and ground transportation services on behalf of entrants.

1 - Hotel accommodation

Entrants are responsible for making their accommodation reservations in Japan.

However, TOBU TOP TOURS can make reservations of the hotel located in the Mobility Resort Motegi (the Mobility Resort Motegi Hotel) on behalf of entrants. Please fill in the "Reservation Request Form" and send it to TOBU TOP TOURS by Email by [Friday, 5th April 2024](#). While priority will be given to the requests of teams and entrants to stay at the Mobility Resort Motegi Hotel, please understand that the request may not be met depending on the availability of rooms.

As for hotels in the nearby area, there are a very limited number of business type rooms available, and they are located in Utsunomiya or Mito City located roughly 40 km away from the venue. Booking of these hotels must be done by the entrants. As the official travel agent of this event, TOBU TOP TOURS has wide experience in tourism and will be able to help the entrants with their travel arrangements. ■ Notes on The Mobility Resort Motegi Hotel

1) Entrants who are registered as annual participants of the World Championship series

- [The Mobility Resort Motegi Hotel has reserved 48 twin rooms for riders coming from overseas. The riders can stay at the hotel for four nights free of charge. The allocation of the rooms is decided on by the FIM who will notify the riders and Mobility Resort Motegi.](#)

One (1) rider is entitled to one (1) room at the Mobility Resort Motegi Hotel free of charge. All rooms are twin rooms, and up to one (1) person in addition to the rider (total of two persons) may stay in one room free of charge. However, the number of free rooms we can offer is limited.

Traffic rules in Japan

- All drivers are required to carry a valid international driving license.
- Please observe Japanese Road Traffic Laws.
- Cars must keep to the left in Japan. Making a left turn on a red light is not permitted. However, if a green arrow traffic light is lit, you can turn at the red light in the direction indicated by the green arrow.
- Please ensure that the driver and all passengers fasten their seat belts, as this is mandatory under the laws of Japan.
- Speed limits apply on all roads, whether ordinary or toll roads. Please comply with the relevant speed limit and drive safely.
- Using mobile phones in any manner while driving is subject to penalty. Please refrain from using mobile phones while driving.
- Penalties for drinking and driving are extremely severe in Japan. Penalties apply not only to the driver but also to passengers. Never drive after drinking, even a single drop. If caught, the driver is usually jailed and is subject to criminal charges.
- In the event that you are found to be the cause of an accident, you will be severely punished. It will affect your entry into Japan in the future. Accidents involving personal injuries may lead to criminal prosecution.
- Please be aware that the Race organizer cannot intervene in police cases.
- The speed limit is 30 km/h inside the Mobility Resort Motegi.

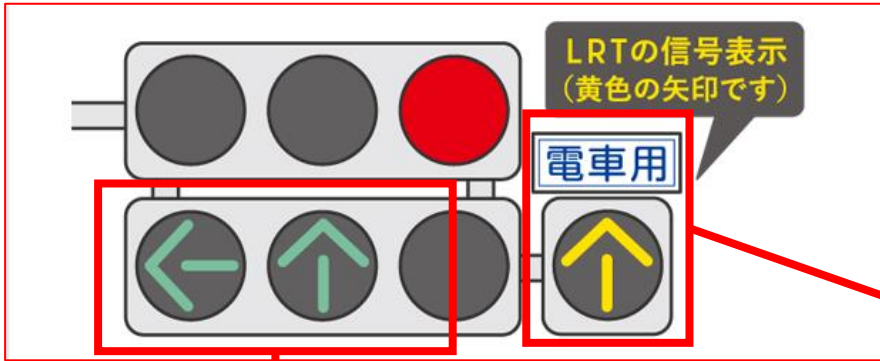

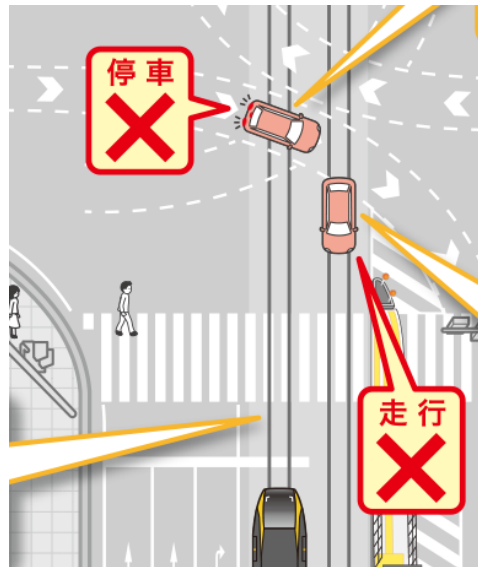
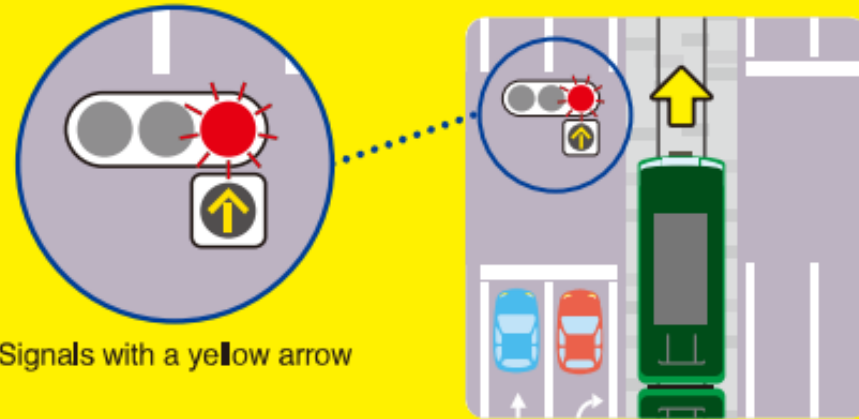
Haga-Utsunomiya LRT (Light Rail Transit)



Green arrows are for vehicles.
Vehicles may proceed in the direction indicated by the arrow even if the signal light is yellow or red.

Signals with a yellow arrow are for trams.

When the yellow arrow is on, automobiles are obliged to stop.



Do not drive down tram lanes.

Tram lanes are for the use of trams only. You can only cross them to turn right or make a U-turn. When doing so, exercise due caution.
