5.1 COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY

- 5.1.1 Drivers holding a current International Competition Licence and a Valid Road Driving license are eligible to enter. Co-Drivers holding a current National Competition Licence are eligible to enter. All foreign competitors must have a letter of authorization from their respective ASN's.

Drivers and Co-drivers who do not have a Competition Licence may purchase an East African Safari Classic Rally Club Membership Card for US \$50 which will grant them eligibility to participate in the Event. Please contact sporting@eastafricansafarirally.com to purchase the Club Membership Card. All Drivers will also require a valid Road Driving Licence.

8.2 QUANTITY OF TYRES

- 8.2.1 The maximum number of tyres Competitors may use during the Event is ~~36 (thirty-six)~~ **44 (forty-four)**. Competitors found to have used more than this quantity will be reported to the Stewards.



14.20 ROADBOOKS AND SERVICE BOOKS

14.20.1 Each crew will receive a **Digital** Roadbook and **Paper** Service Book per Leg.

Digital Roadbooks will take the form of Organiser supplied Digital Tablets (Samsung A9+ Type), issued at Administrative Checks on Tuesday 2nd and Wednesday 3rd December. Each crew will be issued 2 Tablets, one being a spare in the Event of a Tablet failure.

Each Digital Tablet will have the Event Sportity App pre-loaded before issue. Each Tablet will also have a link to Live Stage Results pre-loaded before issue.

All Digital Tablets will be GPS Enabled with Organiser provided SIM Cards for Connectivity.

On Thursday 4th December at 10:00AM (EAT), the Roadbooks, Route Notes, Stage Maps, Leg Maps, KML Files and Service Books for Legs 1, 2, 3 and 4 will be published on the Event Sportity Channel.

On Tuesday 9th December at 10:00AM (EAT) (rest day), the Roadbooks, Route Notes, Stage Maps, Leg Maps KML Files and Service Books for Legs 6, 7, 8 & 9 will be published on the Event Sportity Channel.

There remains the possibility that certain Route Notes may need to be updated depending on feedback from Advance Crews, after the initial document issuance. Any updates will be notified to every Competitor via the Event Sportity Channel.

Competitors are encouraged to download and make available offline all documents provided on the Event Sportity Channel.

Competitors are permitted to print paper copies of Roadbooks and Route Notes and any other Documents published on the Event Sportity Channel.

Competitors are required to maintain power supplies (USB Type C Connector) within their car for the Digital Tablets.

Competitors are permitted to send KML files issued via Sportity to their personal telephones for safety guidance during stages.

Competitors are required to return both Digital Tablets to the Organiser at the Final Time Control, or at the point at which they retire completely from the Event.

Competitors are required to pay a US \$200 (total) deposit for the Digital Tablets upon collection at Administration, which will be released to the Competitor upon satisfactory return of the Tablets.



14.23.5 Slow Zone Protocols

A tolerance of 10% is added to the average speed or to the radar measured speed to determine the maximum allowed speed. The maximum allowed speed in a slow zone is **50 30 KPH** or as defined by the Clerk of the Course in the road book or communication. This is the basis for determining over-speeding. An infringement occurs by exceeding the maximum allowed speed in slow zone. Infringements will incur penalties as per penalty listed in [Appendix 6](#).
