7.2 Quantity of tyres (replace with)

The maximum number of tyres for the rally (including shakedown) is **36** for Rally1 cars and **26** for all other cars. In accordance with Art. 13.2.5 of the 2025 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, the maximum number of tyres of the alternative choice for all 4WD cars is either 8 or 12.

The FIA must be notified at wrc-technical@fia.com before the start of the Shakedown of the number of tyres of the alternative choice that the competitor wishes to use (P1 competitors must notify of their choice by Tuesday, 3 June 2025, 18:00 hrs). Alternative compound tyres are not required to be used in the Shakedown.

This choice neither increases nor decreases the maximum number of tyres for the rally. If the competitor wishes to have 12 alternative compound tyres for use in the rally instead of 8, the number of tyres of the first choice will automatically be reduced by 4 tyres.

12.27 Vehicle Circulation within the Service Park (new article)

From **Wednesday 4 June at 12:00** the inner area of the service park will be reserved for spectators and therefore designated as a **pedestrian zone. No motorized vehicles will be allowed.**

Competitors are reminded that **all vehicles** (incl. scooters, mopeds, forklifts, ATVs etc.) used inside the service area **must be insured and must only be used on the driveways designated for vehicles.**

Extreme care must be taken when using **silent electric vehicles**, especially in the inside service areas, as the spectator pathways are very close to the driveways.

Bulletin 1, Attachment 1

This year, separate collection of urban and special waste will be carried out with precise rules to which all competitors must adhere in accordance with Article 12.25 of the Supplementary Regulations.

URBAN WASTE

The organisation will provide each team with :

1. a kit consisting of 5 bins marked with an identification code associated with the team that has it at its disposal;
2. It absolutely forbidden to use black bags
3. Every Team has to provide their own bags any color but not black

The bins, with bands of different colours according to the category of differentiated waste to be delivered, as described in the table below

Unsorted municipal waste	Grey colour with GREEN BAND
Biodegradables from kitchens and canteens	Grey colour with BROWN BAND
Plastic	Grey colour with LIGHT BLUE BAND
Paper and cardboard	Grey colour with YELLOW BAND
Grey with BLUE BAND	Grey colour with BLUE BAND

All teams must sort the waste they produce into the five identified categories, as indicated in the tables above. The company in charge will collect the bags containing the sorted waste directly from the stands two or three times a day as necessary, with simultaneous on-site verification of the correct disposal, noting any irregularities that will be communicated to the event organisers.

What can be conferred for each category identified above is detailed below:

URBAN INDIFFERENTIATED, NON-RECOVERABLE - Grey with GREEN BAND

Unusable used clothing; tampons, cotton balls, used cotton, face or body lotion, disposable razor blades, dental floss, rubber and latex gloves, erasers and chewing gum; sandpaper, greasy deli or cheese paper, soiled with glue or other chemicals, carbon and wax paper, photographic paper, greasy pizza box; sponges, greasy rags; rubber bands, adhesive labels, adhesive tape remnants of smoking products, lighters, imitation jewellery, buttons, travel bags, candles, mirrors, leather belts and leather in general, shoelaces, gaskets, glasses, umbrellas, crystal objects (very small, free of electrical and electronic parts and/or in any case unusable); Compact Disc (CD), Digital Versatile Disc (DVD), Blue Ray Disc (BRD), Video Home System (VHS); anything else not included in the other categories.

BIODEGRADABLE FOR KITCHENS AND CANTEENS - Grey with BROWN BAND

Raw or cooked food leftovers, even if spoiled (meat, eggs, small bones, bread, etc.); egg shells, dried fruit, shellfish and crustaceans (in small quantities); fish and fish bones; vegetables, fruit and fruit peelings; coffee grounds and tea or herbal tea filters; white paper napkins, handkerchiefs and absorbent paper; matches and toothpicks.

PLASTIC - Grey with LIGHT BLUE BAND

Empty and thoroughly rinsed containers for turpentine, acetone, alcohol, bleach, ammonia and detergent; cosmetic containers and tubes for toothpaste, mayonnaise and creams (empty), deodorants for personal use (sprays and sticks); polystyrene packaging and netting for fruit and vegetables; plastic containers and canisters not containing toxic or flammable products (lacquer, etc.); plastic containers, jars or canisters (small household size) without food residues; disposable plates, glasses and cutlery without food residues; coat hangers; empty blisters; bags, shoppers, pouches and bags or trays for food (pasta, salad, etc.) ; plastic crates, plastic film (bubble wrap) for foodstuffs, cellophane and plastic film; plastic and metal packaging nylon and strapping for tying packages, plastic or polystyrene food trays and jars (empty);

Bulletin 1, Attachment 1**PAPER AND CARDBOARD - Grey bin with YELLOW BAND NO PLASTIC PACKAGING**

Paper, cardboard, paper or cardboard cards, trays and sheets or bags; cardboard boxes and cartons (empty pasta boxes, food trays, egg cartons, etc.); pizza boxes (if not too dirty); paper shoppers and tablecloths (if not too dirty); books, newspapers, magazines, photocopies, notebooks; cardboard and cardboard packaging (small size); empty tetrapak and pure-pak containers for beverages, milk juice, fruit juice, wine, cooking cream, etc

GLASS (EMPTY CONTAINERS) and CANS - grey bin with BLUE BAND

Perfume bottles; jars; glass bottles without caps; phials; glass containers, flasks and small demijohns, glass trays, glass jars and containers without lids, glass beakers; aluminium containers and canisters not containing toxic or flammable products (lacquers, etc.); steel containers, jars or canisters (small for household use); tinfoil, tinfoil and cans for oils, soft drinks and food preservation; metal caps and lids; aluminium foil and aluminium trays (clean); empty metal tubes (for mayonnaise, shoe polish, etc.)

SPECIAL WASTE

As far as special waste is concerned, an ecological area has been set up in the service park (see annex to RG 2 - Service Park layout) in which the following special waste may be disposed of

- Car batteries;
- Light bulbs;
- Engine oil;
- Other emulsions;
- Oil filters;
- Absorbents, filter materials, rags and protective clothing contaminated with hazardous substances

Used tyres must be disposed of by the suppliers, if this is not possible they must be deposited in a special area of the ecological zone. Competitors who need to dispose of the special waste listed above are obliged to inform the person in charge **Mr. Fabio Frasconi, tel. +39 339 740 1272**, e-mail: f.frasconi@rallyitaliasardegna.com who will arrange for the applicant to be accompanied by an organiser's employee to the ecological area, located inside the service park, where the special waste can be disposed of by depositing it in the dedicated container.

WASTE WATER DISCHARGES OF DOMESTIC SEWAGE

It is forbidden to discharge domestic waste water from toilets, kitchens or washbasins in general onto the ground or into the sea. They must be collected in special tanks, either private or provided by the organisation, which will empty them three times a day.

WASHING CARS OR PARTS THEREOF

1. The washing of cars or parts thereof in the stands is prohibited.
2. Cars may be washed in the car wash indicated on the general map of the city.
3. Spare parts and other car parts (e.g. rims, etc.) may be washed in the car wash area (see annex to RG 2- service park layout) equipped with waste water collection grids.
