

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

- DSS K38: Winding rolling track, with stones, lots of changes of direction
- K38 K69: Alternating fast tracks and off-piste, rolling, stony and winding track
- K69 K98: Fast, sometimes sandy track
- K98 K137 : Sandy track in canyons
- K137 K206 : Very fast track
- K206 K250: Alternating sandy off-piste and rolling track, some areas with stones, navigation is difficult
- K250 K336: Alternating fast track and less rolling track, but still with lots of changes of direction
- K336 ASS : End of the special in the Al Ula canyons (Prologue & Stage 1)



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

- PKO The special starts on fast and winding tracks on a long plateau, gravel, big stones to avoid, the pace is slow
- PK39 Winding and bumpy tracks between stones, the terrain changes, alternating between sand, stones and gravel
- PK75 The pace changes, tracks are really fast on a long gravel plateau
- PK85 Winding tracks on a long bumpy plateau, gravel, some sectors are stony, the pace gets slower
- PK101 Area of small canyons (made of black stones), the canyons are opening and the pace is higher, the terrain is gravel
- PK128 Wide valleys and dry rivers, gravel
- PK140, Tracks in wide valleys, dry rivers, the pace is higher, alternating sandy terrain and gravel
- PK169 Leaving the valleys, gravel plateau, very fast, by-passing a mountain "cordon", tracks and off-piste are really fast
- PK179 Neutralisation, then fast gravel plateau



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

- PK206, Wide canyons and sandy valleys with gravel, the landscape is beautiful, between big colorful rocks, tracks are not easy to see, the navigation is difficult
- PK228 Dry river with soft sand, lots of holes
- PK230 Canyons area, more or less open, gravel, bumpy track, navigation is difficult, especially in the stony area
- PK234 Bumpy gravel plateau with winding tracks, the pace is low, the navigation is difficult, tracks are unique
- PK244 Sandy river, but there is lots of stones, difficult to see
- PK248 Very fast tracks on a long stony plateau
- PK271 Beautiful canyons in the Al Ula area with big colorful stones and sandy terrain
- PK288 Wide valleys area, bumpy, gravel, the pace is getting higher
- PK293 The pace is getting higher, on a fast plateau with major gravel tracks
- PK299 Alternating winding tracks and long plateaus with crossing sandy valleys, navigation is difficult, lots of tracks
- PK319 Sandy tracks in Al Ula canyons until the end of the special
- PK371 ASS



"" VIGILANCE POINTS ^

- Crossings of tracks and ruts from previous stages
- K198.44: Danger 2 ightarrow Big hole, pile of earth, careful in the dust




