GENERAL DESCRIPTION

DSS - K149: Fast tracks in sandy canyons, with small stony passes to

go from one canyon to another.

- K149 - K155: Winding off-piste tracks, camel grass

K155 - K160 : Fast tracks with many changes of direction

- K160 - ASS : Very fast track next to the sea

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

- PKO The special starts on fast gravel tracks in wide mountain canyons.
- *PK14 The valleys are smaller, with winding, tight passages on small mountain crests.*
- *PK19 Change of pace, the valleys are much faster and flatter.*
- *PK33 CP1, then fast gravel and sandy tracks in wide valleys.*
- *PK56 The pace drops a little, the canyons are tighter, the terrain is gravelly and sandy.*
- *PK72 The pace picks up again, the tracks are faster, in wide valleys, navigation is difficult.*
- *PK92 Large sandy river with vegetation, in some areas the track is barely visible, it is essential to follow the caps*
- *PK95 Zone of canyons with gravel tracks, the terrain becomes sandy, the pace is high*
- *PK107 Zone of small gravel canyons, navigation is not too difficult*
- PK129 CP2 then small canyons, gravel terrain, the pace is high
- PK147 CP3, then a large gravel canyon, the pace is getting fast
- PK150 Off-piste on a long bumpy plateau with vegetation
- PK155 CP4, then lots of parallel secondary tracks, navigation is difficult
- PK160 WRC-type main track, parallel to the sea, very nice spot
- *PK174 ASS*

POINTS DE VIGILANCE 🛆

- Bad Trial → K45,93 K46,05 K46 au K58 K93,38 K107,70 K121,59
- Hidden stones → Stay on the tracks
- K48.62 \rightarrow Two red stakes to mark a large rock between the tracks
- Camps over the first 150 km
- Track by the sea \rightarrow very fast, beware of a few bends on sight / possible presence of public






