2. Trailer Park:
 - Trailer Park is located within the official service park complex in the "Store-All" Facility, Aglish Road, Springmount, Dungarvan, X35 AP83.
GPS Coordinates: N 52.090249, W -7.643450
 - Please follow the marshals instructions and do not leave your trailer / service vehicle unattended after unloading causing an obstruction. Due to the high volume of entries. space at the Trailer Park will be at a premium and we ask for your cooperation with the marshals onsite.



3. Mechanical Scrutiny:

- Please note the change of time of Mechanical Scrutiny from the Published Regulations **Mechanical Scrutiny will now take place from 15:00 to 20:00hrs**
- Mechanical Scrutiny will take place as per the published regulations in the “Store-All” Facility, Aglish Road, Springmount, Dungarvan, X35 AP83.

- Please make every effort to arrive early and on time for scrutiny to avoid delays due to the high volume of entries.
- Safety Tracking Systems (STS) can be collected at Mechanical Scrutiny in advance of completing mechanical scrutiny and **MUST** be fitted to the car before attending Mechanical Scrutiny.
- Please attend Documentation Scrutiny promptly on completion of Mechanical Scrutiny so as to avoid any unnecessary delays.
- On Completion of Mechanical Scrutiny, cars must proceed immediately into and remain in Parc Ferme situated within the “Store-All” Service Park Facility. Marshals will be onsite to assist with parking. Competitors are reminded that the carrying out of any works on cars within the Parc Ferme Area is strictly prohibited. All cars must be in Parc Ferme by 21:30 Friday 11th April 2025.

4. Documentation Scrutiny:

- Please note the change of time of Documentation Scrutiny from the Published Regulations **Documentation Scrutiny will now take place from 15:30 to 20:30hrs**
- Documentation Scrutiny will take place in the Rally HQ, Lawlors Hotel, Bridge Street, Dungarvan, Co. Waterford. X35 DT04. GPS Coordinates: N 52.090758, W -7.620759
- Competitors are required to please ensure that you bring your Competition Licence / Digital Licence to Documentation Scrutiny where your licence will be checked.
- It is the onus of the competitors, in particular overseas crews to ensure and familiarise themselves with the scrutiny requirements for Irish events and check the relevant **IRDS / BRDS** Insurance and ensure they are on the **current IRDS / BRDS Database**.

5. Competitor Safety Briefing:

- Please note the competitor safety briefing will take place on Saturday morning 12th April 2025 at 08:00hrs in the Rally HQ, Lawlors Hotel, Bridge Street, Dungarvan.
- It is Mandatory for both Crew members to attend the briefing, Timecards will be handed on signing in / entrance to drivers briefing, please arrive in sufficient time to collect your timecards so that the briefing may start on time.
- All J1000 Crews are reminded they must have a Parent or Guardian present.



6. Service Park:

- The Service Park is located within the “Store-All” Facility, Aglish Road, Springmount, Dungarvan, X35 AP83. GPS Coordinates: N 52.090249, W -7.643450]
- The Service Park Manager is Bill Sheehan.
- Competitors and Service Crews are kindly requested to ensure you Please remove all litter from the service park at the conclusion of the event. Refuse Bins will be provided in the service park – **please use them**. Should Service Crews ignore this instruction, penalties may be applied to the relevant competitors at the discretion of the organisers
- All Service Crews must have and use non-porous ground sheets. If your service crew does not adhere to this instruction they will not be permitted in the service area. Failure to comply with instruction may result in penalties being applied.
- Absolutely no personnel allowed to stay overnight within the confines of the service park which will be locked overnight, please liaise with the Service Park Manager for any necessary alternative overnight arrangements
- Competitors are reminded of the regulations in relation to the Service Area is a **NO SMOKING AREA** for the duration of the event and competitors are reminded of the Motorsport Ireland protocols in relation to rally service areas.
- Competitors are reminded of the Motorsport Ireland regulations regarding fire extinguishers requirements for service crews.

7. Refuel Zone:

- A refuel area will be in operation at the event in accordance with Motorsport Ireland refuelling guidelines and regulations. The event refuel zone based **after** the Service Out Control in the service park, strictly **NO RE-FUELLING** will be allowed within the main service area – this will be strictly monitored for compliance. Crew **must exit** the car during the refuelling process. **Strictly no smoking** or use of mobile phones are permitted within the refuel zone. Access to the Service Park Refuel Zone is restricted and access permitted only by competing crews or their service / refuel crew as required – no exceptions.

8. Super Rally:

- The event will have available to competitors Super Rally regulations. Please ensure you read and fully understand the rules and regulations of re-joining under Super Rally regulations – please refer to relevant section of the regulations. A dedicated Super Rally coordinator has been appointed to assist and monitor compliance with the re-start procedures. Winnie Sheil +353 (87) 6209312 is the nominated coordinator and all enquires / re-start requests are to be directed to the Super Rally Coordinator.

9. The event Scrutineers may carry out spot checks at stage starts and at random locations and will pay particular attention to the proper fastening of safety harnesses and wearing of Hans Devices.



10. General Information:

- Pacenotes will be available for sale by Third Parties. The club has no involvement in their preparation, and accepts no responsibility or liability for their accuracy or otherwise.
- There will be A3 colour competitor route maps available at documentation.
- There will be no start ramp / time control. Competitors will go straight from PF Out to Service Out Time Control.
- All queries must be made on official headed paper only (available in rally office)
- All named officials are Judge's of Fact. Additional judges of fact will be named on the official Digital notice board as required.
- Competitors requested to attend the finish ramp will have their timecard addressed by officials.
- Competitors Relations Officer (C.R.O.) is Pat Shiel – Phone Number 087-2821700
- The onus is on the competitor to ensure they are entered in the correct class.
- The onus is on the competitor to fill in their own competing number on their timecards.
- Competitors are reminded that no outside assistance is allowed (other than to re-join a stage). Servicing will only be allowed in the area defined as the service park in the events roadbook. Stage Exits will be monitored for associated team vehicles and penalties will be applied to the competitor involved.
- Reminder – all competing crews are required to enter and remain in Parc Ferme for 30mins after their “recorded time in” at the conclusion of the event.
- Abuse of rally officials, marshals including judges of facts will not be tolerated – there will be a zero tolerance with regards to this.
