ARTICLE 3: APPLICABLE REGULATIONS

The 30th Rallye of A Coruña Legend is not a competitive event, but rather an exhibition for historic and classic rally cars, and therefore it will not be governed by any specific technical regulations.

ARTICLE 4: CHAMPIONSHIPS

The 30th Rallye of A Coruña LEGEND will not count towards any championship. Stage times will not be recorded, as the event will be run in exhibition format.

ARTICLE 5: REGULATIONS AND RUNNING OF THE EVENT

It is mandatory to complete all special stages. In the event of a mechanical failure, rejoining the event (SuperRallye) will be allowed by reporting to the regrouping point at least 30 minutes before the theoretical start time. If arriving later, the organizer will attempt to assign a starting position, always within the Legend category.

Both driver and co-driver must wear all duly homologated safety equipment (fireproof suit, helmet, balaclava, HANS device, fireproof underwear, gloves and boots).

Vehicles will be inspected by the technical scrutineers, and those that do not meet safety requirements will be declared non-compliant. Teams will be given the opportunity to rectify any issues. If they cannot be resolved, the vehicle will be declared not authorized to start.

The starting order during the event will be led by the Legend category, with car numbers identified from L1 to L30, as 30 is the maximum number of entries in this category.

Driving during the event, despite being an exhibition, must never endanger other vehicles in the rally. Driving against the course direction, performing donuts, stopping in areas without visibility, or any other action that could compromise the safety of competitors, officials or spectators must be avoided at all times. Failure to comply with this rule will result in exclusion from the event.



ARTICLE 11: RECCES

11.1 Authorized days and times

Teams may choose one of the following options:

- **Option A:** Saturday February 21 and Sunday February 22, from 09:00 to 21:00.
- **Option B:** Wednesday February 25 and Thursday February 26, from 09:00 to 21:00.

The use of GPS during recce is mandatory. The device must be switched on at all times and will be monitored by the organizer. Failure to comply may result in exclusion at the stewards' discretion.

11.2 Passes and speed

Participating teams may make as many passes as they wish on the stages, provided they remain within the days and times established in point 11.1 above.

The shakedown must be recce'd within the same time slots as the special stages.

Maximum speed on special stages during recce is 80 km/h, unless otherwise indicated by road signage, which shall always prevail.


The GPS device to be used during both recce and the rally will be the Spica system from Anube Sport.



● S.O.S. NOTIFICATION

To request immediate medical attention, or to notify that a vehicle totally blocks pass to other participants.

+ Press buttons Red and Green simultaneously for 2 seconds.



● BREAKDOWN NOTIFICATION

To notify vehicle is stationary but do not block other vehicles.

Press Red button for 2 seconds.




● QUESTION OK?

Clerk of course requests participants state. Participants have 3 possible answers:

To notify **everything is ok**

+ To notify **S.O.S.**

To notify Breakdown



● RED FLAG

The screen shows the "RF" letters (Red Flag), alternating with full red screen.

Participant must press Green button to confirm reading.



OK FUNCTION



Race control requests information about the status of the participants, who can respond with SOS, Breakdown, or everything is fine.

- To indicate that **everything is fine**.
- + To indicate **SOS**
- To indicate **breakdown**

SOS OPERATION FUNCTION



Press red and green buttons simultaneously for 2 seconds.

Immediate medical attention request or notification of a vehicle blocking the passage of other participants.


RED FLAG ALERT



FLASHING RED LIGHTS

CAUTION FUNCTION




Press red button for 2 seconds.
