## **SAFETY COMMUNICATION**


Following the challenging and adverse weather conditions observed during the Recce, the Organizer and the FIA want to assure all EKO Acropolis Rally Greece 2023 participants that there shall be no compromise on safety.

The FIA has three (3) experienced Safety and Medical delegates working with the Organiser's medical, safety and rescue teams to maintain and run the Rally's Safety Plan. The FIA Medical Delegate drives each stage 90 minutes before it starts, and the FIA Safety Delegate drives each stage 30 minutes before it starts of every stage. These delegates observe and act upon the published Rally Safety Plan and relay critical information back to Rally HQ to ensure that the appropriate safety measures and contingencies (be it road vehicles, helicopter, and/or personnel) are in appropriate positions ahead of any car's entry into the stage.

Hence, and as part of the FIA's standard method of operation, a meeting with the safety and rescue teams has taken place to ensure that 4-wheel-drive ambulances are to be utilized and will be able to intervene if the need arises.

Redistribution of safety and rescue personnel, vehicles and helicopters shall be adjusted as weather conditions develop.

**Like in all other rallies: No stage shall start if there are any safety concerns or doubts.**
