



ENTRY CONFIRMATION

Dear participants,

We are very pleased to receive your entry for the SG Toolbox Mühlstein Rallye powered by Baumentor. We can confirm with that we have accepted your entry, subject to receipt of the entry fee.

The starting numbers were assigned to the best of our knowledge and belief, taking past results into account. Requests for re-ordering must be submitted in writing with a corresponding explanation no later than the administrative scrutineering. The rally management will make adjustments to the starting order if necessary.

Roadbook

The rally headquarters is located in the **Steinbach company building at Aistinger Straße 2, 4311 Schwertberg**, directly west of the service area. Roadbook distribution will take place there during the following period:

Thursday, 06.08.2026, from 19:00 to 20:00

Friday, 07.08.2026 from 07:30 to 10:00

The vehicle used for the reconnaissance (make, color, license plate number) must be specified when the roadbook is issued. If the entry fee has not been received by the organizer on time, the roadbook cannot be issued!

GPS tracking

The Mühlstein Rallye uses the same GPS system for both the rally and reconnaissance as the TEC7 ORM (Austrian Rally Championship). A **deposit of €200** is required for the GPS device. **This deposit must be paid in cash when the roadbook is issued. No roadbook will be issued without a deposit.** The deposit, minus a €30 system usage fee, will be refunded in cash upon return of the undamaged device to Rally HQ. Participants may remove the system themselves after SS7, before TC 7a Parc Fermé IN.

Instructions for assembly and operation are available at Sportity. A mounting bracket is required for installation in the rally car. You can either use your own bracket or purchase a suitable one from Rally HQ.

The device must be continuously active during the reconnaissance and the rally – **the screen must be switched on at all times** , otherwise no data will be transmitted. **It is the participants' responsibility to ensure the device's battery does not run out.** It is recommended to charge the device in the car. If this is not possible, please be sure to charge it overnight from Friday to Saturday!

To mount the equipment in the rally car, a standard 1-inch Ram Mount ball is required, which must be permanently attached to the vehicle. Teams can purchase and install this 1-inch ball themselves. Alternatively, such 1-inch Ram Mount balls can be purchased on-site at the event.

Recce

Period for the recce of the special stages:

Friday, August 7, 2026, from 8:00 to 16:30

Each special stage may be driven **a maximum of 3 times** .

The reconnaissance will be conducted according to the applicable AMF RSR (Art. 35). Please adhere to the specified times and, above all, the **speed limits**, and avoid causing **unnecessary disturbance to residents** – on special stages and liaison sections! Some routes are no longer approved for rallies due to complaints from residents about excessive reconnaissance. Please behave responsibly so that we can all continue to enjoy our sport! Special caution is advised at the **Mitterkirchen shakedown: this special stage, as well as the route to the start, partially follows the busy Danube Cycle Path R1. Please be particularly careful of cyclists and do not endanger them!**

Service area and trailer parking

The service area is located in Schwertberg at the ENGEL company parking lot, south of the train station. Access to the service area is possible from 9:00 on Friday, August 7, 2026. The parking area for trailers is located northwest of the service area in an asphalt parking lot on Aisttalstraße , north of the building at Aisttalstraße 35.

A deposit of EUR 50 will be collected for the service area during the administrative scrutineering. The **deposit** is be returned by the responsible personnel **directly at the service area no later than Saturday, August 8, 2026, at 20:00**. Returns after this time are not possible! The service park and the parc fermé must be vacated by Sunday, August 9, 2026, at 9:00.

Administrative scrutineering

Location: **Steinbach Company, Aistinger Straße 2, 4311 Schwertberg**

Period: **Friday, August 7, 2026, from 7:45 to 16:30**

A time slot must be booked for the administrative approval – this time slot must be adhered to! It is first come, first serve:

Technical scrutineering is only possible AFTER administrative inspection – please book the time slots accordingly! **We kindly ask participants who do NOT wish to participate in the shakedown to book their scrutineering at the end of the day!**

The following documents must be submitted during the administrative acceptance inspection:

- Applicant license
- License for 1st driver and 2nd driver
- Driving licence 1st driver
- ASN approval (applies to foreign participants)
- Documents/registration certificate of the rally car
- Proof of insurance for rally vehicle (green insurance card)
- Declaration of consent from the vehicle owner (if the driver is not the owner)
- Service area deposit (€50 in cash upon receipt of the order)
- Entry form is available in printed form – additions may be necessary



Technical scrutineering

Location: in the parking garage at the parking lot of ENGEL company, 4311 Schwertberg (same location as Regrouping, see map on previous page)

Period: **Friday, August 8, 2026, from 9:00 to 13:30 and 14:00 to 19:00**

A time slot must be booked for the technical scrutineering – this time slot must be adhered to! It is first come, first serve:

Technical scrutineering is only possible AFTER administrative inspection – please book the time slots accordingly! **We kindly ask participants who do NOT wish to take part in the shakedown to book their technical inspection after 17:00.**

The following documents must be submitted and will be checked:

- Car pass, Car pass Historical, FIA HTP
- Homologation certificate (original)
- Certificate of the security cell (cage)
- Safety tank certificate (if required in vehicle category)
- SOS/OK sign (DIN A3)

Drivers' briefing

The drivers' briefing will take place **on Saturday, August 8, 2026, at 8:00 in the entrance to the parking garage** at the service area, parking lot of ENGEL company in Schwertberg. According to the AMF-RSR attendance is mandatory for at least one person per team, which will be verified with a signature list.

Official Notice Board

The official notice board is available on the homepage and in the **Sportity app (password: muehlstein26)**. With the Sportity app, you will receive a push notification on your smartphone (if enabled) as soon as a document is uploaded. Documents are downloaded directly (if enabled) and are then available offline, e.g., without a signal.

Shakedown

Time: Friday, August 7, 2026, from 5:00 PM to 8:00 PM

Length: 3.1km (of which 1.7km is asphalt and 1.4km is gravel)

Only participants who have passed the administrative and technical scrutineering are permitted. Participation is only possible if all special stage rules are followed (start numbers and advertising complete, clothing as in the competition, etc.). At the administrative scrutineering, participation in the shakedown must be registered and the shakedown fee of €80 must be paid (except for class RC2, for which the shakedown fee is included in the entry fee). Any passenger on board the vehicle during the shakedown who is not registered for the rally in question must sign a liability waiver from the organizer and must wear safety gear (helmet and HANS device). Passengers must be at least 18 years old. This will be checked at the start of the shakedown.

Shakedown can be run **an unlimited number of times** within the allotted time frame. Starts will be at **30-second intervals** to allow for as many runs as possible. We recommend using the time slot from the beginning. Experience shows that many participants want to run towards the end of the time – however, we must end the shakedown promptly at 20:00.

Caution: expect **dust** on the gravel section of the shakedown.

Jump Challenge: At the end of the shakedown, the most impressive jump will be awarded a prize by a jury. Main sponsor SG Toolbox is offering a Bosch GDS 18V-450 cordless impact wrench including a power socket, two batteries, and a charger as a prize. Important: The most impressive jump will be rewarded, it doesn't necessarily have to be the longest. A clean landing is essential.

Licenses

Day licenses can **no longer** be applied for on-site during the administrative scrutineering, **only at your ASN**.
