#### Replace 1.1 with the following:

- 1.1 The Event shall be known as the APX Suspension Manumbar Rally and will be conducted on Forestry Roads in the Nanango, Gallangowan and Elgin Vale State Forest areas on **Saturday 16 March 2024**.

The Event is a 2024 Motorsport Australia State Championship Competition Special Stage Rally conducted under a Motorsport Australia permit which will be on display at Rally Headquarters.

#### Replace 16.3 with the following:

- 16.3 The Event will be an all-daylight event, conducted in two distinct Heats. Heat 1, the Event will start at the Nanango Showgrounds. Heat 1 will consist of three stages with a refuel **and service** allowed at Nanango Showgrounds between **each of SS1 and SS2, and SS2 and SS3**. At the conclusion of SS3, crews will liaise to the Service Park located at the Nanango Showgrounds for **an additional** service between heats. Heat 1 culminates at TC3A.

**In the interests of clarity, there is no regroup control between SS1 and SS2 or between SS2 and SS3. Any time utilised for service and refuel does not affect, in any way, competitors' due time at subsequent Time Controls. Competitors are advised to plan their service time accordingly.**

Heat 2 will consist of five stages, with refuel permitted at a location in Elgin Vale between SS4 and SS5, and service and refuel allowed at Manumbar Campdraft Grounds between SS6 and SS7.

At the conclusion of SS8 crews will return to the Service Park for event finish and presentation of trophies. All competitors are **strongly** encouraged to attend.

All competitors who are undertaking remote scrutiny will present at Nanango Showgrounds at 0630hrs on Saturday 16 March 2024, to apply championship and event provided decals and promotional material, prior to a scrutineering represent. Due to time pressures, lateness will not be tolerated.
