Advice for NSW Competitors

The regulations for the 2024 Tyres & More Hemmant Working Dog Rally contain a couple of differences to a “normal” NSW Championship round ... some of which could affect your day in a not so good way ... this note outlines some of the differences ...

Late at Time Controls

Booking in Late to a time control will use up some of your late time AND will also add real time to your results.

For every minute late you will have 5 seconds added to your stage time.

For example, if you are due to check-in at say 10:15 (so any time between 10:15:00 and 10:15:59) but don't arrive at the TC until 10:18:20 you will have 15 seconds added to your stage time.

Arriving at 10:16:00 would be a 5 second penalty, arriving at 10:16:59 is still 5 seconds – that's the same minute! Arrive between 10:17:00 – 10:17:59 – 10 second penalty, 10:18:00 – 10:18:59 – 15 seconds ... and so on.

If you think you have a really good reason for being late come and talk to a CRO!

Early at Time Controls

This is the same as usual – book in early except at TC9A and you will have penalty time added to your stage time – 1 minute per minute or part of a minute ... (you have been reminded!)

Service Park Time Controls

Yes they do exist and will be operated as real controls with penalties applied for early and late arrivals ... you cannot gain “extra” service time by rushing back from the stages

End of the Event

The event finishes at TC9A – Parc Ferme In back at the Service Park – you need to get back to here under the vehicles own power ... unlike NSW events where you are deemed to have finished at the last ‘stop’ point – come back on a trailer or the end of a tow rope and you will NOT be a finisher for the event.
