



SERVICE GUIDE & RALLY VILLAGE INFORMATION

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Service Park, Headquarters, Camping and Rally Village is at Bonalbo Showgrounds off Woodenbong Road, Bonalbo (GPS coordinates & map below). The Service Park opens from 8am on Saturday Morning. Camping is available from Friday midday.

Please be mindful that Spectators have been invited to come and watch the cars at the service park throughout the weekend. The first car leaves the Service Park at 7:30am **NSW Daylight savings time** Sunday 6th October.

The **ENTRY** and **EXIT** of the Service Park is at the Southern end of the Showground. During the running of the event, Rally Cars will have exclusive access to the main gate. Service vehicles and spectators will use the public entrance to the left as signposted. Service Bays have been designated for each team and crews are reminded that there is limited space. You **MUST** adhere to your allocated service bay. The Service Bay allocation map is below and will be also released on SPORTITY.


The Service Park Manager is **Grant Coleman**, he can be contacted on **0418 203 006**. Toilets and showers are located around the grounds as indicated on the service park map. Please advise headquarters or staff at the bar or canteen if the toilets or showers need cleaning, toilet paper restocked etc.

Please make use of the various café's, shops and food outlets, and make sure you tell them you are here for the WORKING DOG RALLY!

Whilst Cards (eftpos) are accepted almost everywhere except the BBQ at the spectator points, remember **CASH IS KING**. Bring some cash. it's a small town and we expect the ATM to run out at some point over the weekend!

Important note: The Showground Arena is for servicing ONLY. All camping is to be outside the arena as marked on the attached Service Park map. The ONLY exception will be if your bed is inside your trailer or affixed to your Service vehicle. There will be no tents, caravans, motorhomes permitted inside the Service Park arena.

OPTIONAL REMOTE REFUEL - TABULAM

The Optional Remote refuel area is located at Tabulam. (GPS coordinates & map below).


Please park in Clarence Street for 70M either side of the road as shown on the Diagram below. It is also permitted as per Bulletin issued to deviate adjacent to the refuel area and use the new ''Tabulam Local Servo'' for fuel if you do not wish to send a service crew. (98 pump fuel is available). Event Officials will be present to ensure **NO** Servicing is carried out.

Note: Local residents will not be used to the high volume of traffic on these roads. Be courteous of other road users and leave plenty of time to get to the remote refuel. Police will be in attendance at the event throughout the weekend.

Specific Notes on Travel times:


You should be able to comfortably view your team at either Spectator point 1 or 2 and then get to the remote refuel well before them.

BONALBO SHOWGROUNDS TO TABULAM – ROUTE INSTRUCTIONS

The follow instructions begin at the exit of the Showground (Service Park) on Woodenbong Street (Clarence Way).



Return to the showground using the opposite route.

RALLY HQ

CAMPING

Camping at the showground for the rally is FREE!

There is NO camping in the Service Park Arena.

There is ample room for all to camp in the designated Camping areas as per the Service Park map.



Any vans, motorhomes, tents etc erected or parked in the Service Arena will be asked to move. The ONLY exception will be if your bed is inside your trailer used for servicing or affixed to the top of your Service vehicle.

There are several toilet and shower buildings around the grounds. Whilst they will be cleaned regularly it is up to you to let organisers know if anything needs attention.

TRAILER PARKING

Trailer parking areas are indicated on the Service Park map. Unless your trailer is an integral part of your servicing it MUST be moved to the trailer parking areas once you have set up. There is limited space in the service park arena for trailers. If you are asked to move your trailer, please respect the organisers request.

FIRES

Small fires off the ground are permitted at the showgrounds.

There will also be a ''Large firepit'' at the Bar area which has been approved with the issuing of a permit from RFS.



REFUEL AT SERVICE PARK ARENA

The entire Service Park Arena (inside the showground ring) is designated as a refuel area. It is permitted to refuel your car at your service bay.

It is recommended to have a fire extinguisher next to your vehicle for refuelling or alternatively leave a door open on the car for access to the onboard extinguisher.

HOT WORKS AREA

An area designated for ''Hot Works'' has been allocated as indicated on the Service Park Map. Grinding, Welding etc. As the entire service park arena is a refuel area absolutely <u>NO</u> Hot works activities can be carried out at your service bay.

CEREMONIAL START- SATURDAY 5[™] OCTOBER 5PM

This is the big one. Who will get it wrong? Saturday Night New South Wales starts Daylight Savings so best to move your phone, watch, sundial 1 hour forward for the next day of racing so you aren't that person that is late for the start. For those that struggle with it

Staging Arrival Times for Ceremonial Start Set Up


Rally Cars must be lined up in their start order to be able to leave the start to travel to TC0 to check in - so please arrive as set out below.
