# **FURTHER REGULATIONS**

## Replace 13.4 with the following:

13.4 A competitor who has registered for the 2024 Motorsport Australia Rally Championship and has their door numbers complying with the ARC Series Regulations must not display those door numbers. Such competitors will be seeded according to Article 25 of these regulations. Refer to Articles 3.3.2 and 3.5 of the 2024 Queensland Rally Sporting Regulations.

# Replace 15.2 with the following:

The Event will consist of two heats. A Competitor must start Heat 1 to be eligible to start Heat 2. A competitor who fails to complete the first heat will be allowed to re-join the rally at the start of the second heat (**TC3B**), provided they have approval from the CRO prior to commencing the second heat. Approximate distances for the Motorsport Australia QRC will be **271** kilometres, comprising **122** kilometres competitive distance and **149** kilometres liaison distance.

### Replace 15.5 with the following:

15.5 A competitor in the Motorsport Australia Queensland Novice Series may nominate to run the full event distance and pay the full event distance entry fee. However, the scoring of event points towards the Queensland Novice Series will be calculated at **TC3A** as shown in the event itinerary.

### Replace 16.3 with the following:

The Event will be an all-daylight event, conducted in two distinct Heats. Heat 1, the Event will start at the Nanango Showgrounds. Heat 1 will consist of three stages with a refuel allowed at Nanango Showgrounds between each of SS1, SS2, and SS3. At the conclusion of SS3, crews will liaise to the Service Park located at the Nanango Showgrounds for service between heats. Heat 2 will consist of five stages with refuel permitted at a location in Elgin Vale between SS4 and SS5, and service and refuel allowed at Manumbar Campdraft Grounds between SS6 and SS7.

At the conclusion of **SS8** crews will return to the Service Park **at Manumbar** for event finish and presentation of trophies. All competitors are encouraged to attend.

## Replace Article 31.1 with the following:

31.1 Notwithstanding the provisions of the 2024 Queensland Rally Championship and Series – Sporting Regulations **Articles 3.8.1.4**, **3.8.1.5**, and **3.9.5**, in order to be eligible for an award the competing crew is required to attend <u>all</u> time controls within their allotted late time. This expressly includes the final event control.
