Stewards Decision #1

To: Driver and Co-Driver of car 155, Car 0, and Colorado Rally Officials

I have received notice from the Clerk of the Course of a report of Illegal Servicing (RCR 6.4.6) of Car 155 on the transit from FTC 2 to ATC 3 as observed by Car 0, and posted on line 15 on the official inquiry form. All improper Procedure Infractions are referred by the Clerk of the course to the Stewards per GCR 6.4.

Findings

I interviewed the driver of Car 0 and they stated that they saw a service vehicle parked with Car 155 on the service route and transit to Stage 3. They stated that the hood and doors of Car 155 were open, and people were around the front of the car, and that a person was working on the inside of the car in the footwell. They did not see anyone else working on the car.

The driver of Car 155 was interviewed and agreed with the statements of Car 0. They stated that only the driver and co-driver of Car 155 worked on the car, and that the service crew at the scene was not their service crew, but Car 902's service crew. They also stated that the crew of Car 155 was adjusting the clutch pedal in an attempt to fix a clutch problem.

I then interviewed the service crew for Car 902, and they stated that as ex-competitors they knew not to touch or help the crew of Car 155, and that they did not help, just observed.

Decision

I have determined that no improper procedure infractions occurred. That the observed service crew were on the official service route to the remote refueling and that no help or assistance was given. With no further evidence, no penalties will be assessed.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance to Article 9 of the ARA General Competition Rules.
