WELCOME - the Organizing Team thanks you!

We are excited to have everyone back in Rangely for this event! On behalf of the entire Organizing Committee and the local community, thank you for supporting the rally, Rio Blanco County, and businesses in the area.

- We will again be hosting a **Parc Expose** at the Rangely Automotive Museum, with FOOD TRUCKS, followed by the **Ceremonial Parade** through downtown Rangely.
- The **course** will be made up of six different stages, with three stages run twice the same day, with a service in between the three runs.
 - Saturday is made up of challenging roads to the south of town, with some intriguing mountain switchbacks; plus, a completely new stage that we know you will like.
 - Sunday's competition, to the north and east of Rangely, will challenge competitors with stunning vistas, intriguing terrain, and varied road conditions on the stages.
- **Service** will be held both days in the same location on a large grass surface in Elks Park, which is located just a few blocks south of the host hotel (the Blue Mountain Inn).
 - Nearby downtown has food, ice, auto parts, gas, hardware stores, etc.
 - The service park is full of trees, public restrooms, and covered areas for shade.
- This year the rally will again use the RallySafe and RSlite tracking and timing system.
- For **weather**, we are anticipating highs in the 90's and lows in the 50-60's, be prepared with sunscreen and plenty of water!
- Merchandise will be available for purchase at Park Expose and Registration/Service.
- Drugs are strictly prohibited during the event.
- Please note per the SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS there will not be printed copies of this document – please print your own copies for the competitor and crew.

RALLY COMMUNICATIONS

The Rally will use a directed Safety Net via a combination of 2m Amateur Radio frequencies; stages are run with their own frequency, and they communicate to NET CONTROL via a dedicated COMM CAPTAIN on an "executive" frequency. In most cases stage crews can also contact Net Control directly.

Because of remoteness and the terrain, cellular phone access is intermittent.

Frequencies may change if conditions change; below is the current plan.

CHECK-IN INFORMATION

Competitors, crew, media, and volunteers **MUST** be licensed and pre-registered, and must have passed all administrative checks prior to the event.

ALL team and crew members and media **must** hold an ARA license and be registered; details are in the Supplemental Regulations.

Once licensed and registered, you then must check-in at the event during the dates and times listed in the Supplemental Regulations. Check-in is at the **west end** of **Elks Park**.

• Technically this is **903 Taos Drive** but use the GPS location 40.082842, -108.812255 *or* go SOUTH on RIVER RD and follow the arrows on the map below to the check-in location:



- Present your registration info to the check-in volunteer.
- Each Team will receive:
 - 1 Wristband for each: Drive/Co-Driver/Crew Member
 - 2 Event Headers
 - 1 Competitor Routebook
 - 1 Recce Identification place on passenger-side windshield of recce vehicle California Rally Series stickers
 - Rally Colorado Stickers

RECCE CHECK-IN

Prior to Recce, BOTH competitors MUST check-in *per the previous page*. Both driver and codriver must be present in their recce vehicle.

RECCE PROCEDURES

You will need your route book, these recce instructions, and the Recce Identification on your recce vehicle. *See the Supplemental Regulations for specific rules.*

- Recce is allowed only during the schedule listed in the Supplemental Regulations.
 - We will have workers on the stages before and during recce. They are always alert for unauthorized driving of the stages.
- Note you must be back for **Friday's mandatory Parc Expose then Parade**, per the schedule listed in the Supplemental Regulations or as modified in a Bulletin.
 - Note you must enter Parc Expose between the times shown in the Supps or Bulletin.
- Drive with your headlights ON
- **SPEED LIMIT IS 30mph** on the stages; take your time.
- All stages are ONE WAY, the same direction as in the routebook
 - $_{\odot}$ $\,$ you are not allowed to go reverse direction
- There may be an Observation Control.
- During recce you may encounter oncoming traffic, off-highway vehicles (OHV, UTV, SXS), road graders, gas & oil workers, livestock (moo), wild trampling horses (neigh), residents (hey!), and our stage crews (yay). Please use appropriate caution while driving there are many corners and crests on the stage roads where visibility is very limited.
- RallySafe LITE (RSlite) will be used for recce, and <u>is required</u>. See the Rally Safe section.
- GPS locations for controls and midpoints are below.

RALLYSAFE

The rally will use the RallySafe tracking and timing system, and a RallySafe unit must be installed in the competitor vehicle to compete.

If needed, rental RallySafe <u>fitting</u> kits are \$40 each; *they must be ordered and paid for during online entry*.

RallySafe is the primary timing system; timecards will still be used as they are the ultimate source of truth if issues occur with RallySafe - the accuracy of timecards is the competitor's responsibility.

RSLite is REQUIRED to be used for RECCE

Please make sure you review this info and ARA Bulletin 2024-4 before you arrive at check in.

It requires an iPhone or Android phone with data. You MUST have data **active on the phone** while tracking and it cannot be in airplane mode.

The speed limit shown on the app will include the 5MPH buffer allowed within the ARA rules. So, if the speed limit is 25MPH, the app will show 30MPH. This means, if the app shows you as speeding, you are IN the range to which penalties may be applied.

- Most of the issues we have seen with the app are due to an outdated version being used. Make sure you have automatic updates on and that you are using the latest version of the app. The newest version for Apple and Android is 1.11.7. Go to SETTINGS to see the version you have.
- Be prepared to have the app checked when you arrive at check in. We may be making sure the most recent version of the app is in use to minimize issues.
- You will receive the unique INVITE code (log in code) when you check in to the event.
- We have received questions regarding the app data usage. When being used, expect approximately 0.2MB of data usage per hour.
- To <u>start</u> tracking, <u>you are required to be in cell service</u>. Make sure to start <u>tracking before going out</u> on the stages, as connection WILL be spotty.
- Activate the "Always" tracking option in your phone settings for the app. This can be disabled after recce.
- The app will only be operating/tracking if it is active on the screen. *It does not operate to full capacity in the background*. When you are on the stages, the app must be the active foreground app.


OPTIONAL REMOTE REFUEL

Saturday (due to a scenic transit) has an OPTIONAL REMOTE REFUEL, between Stages 2 & 3, and then **again** between the second running of the same stages.

The refuel area is located at the **intersection of CR 114 and CR 23** (also called White Ave/Big Park Rd/Rangely Dragon Rd). This is: **39.876464, -108.940833** and *is on the 6.89 mile transit between Stages 2&3 then later 5&6.*

If on time, the first car is expected to finish stage 2 at 10:48 and should be at the start of Stage 3 at 11:14; similarly, the first car is expected to finish stage 5 at 15:47 and should be at the start of Stage 6 at 16:13.

Per Bing and Google, it is 18 miles to this location, and it will take you 30 minutes to get there from the north side of Elk's Park in Rangely.




The REMOTE REFUEL AREA is a simple open area on CR 114 where it meets CR 23. Although traffic is light, please leave room for cars to pass on CR 114 – note *CR 114 is used in the transit from Stage 3 back to Rangely* **BUT IS NOT A AN OPTIONAL REFUEL POINT during that transit**.




Rally Colorado will have a volunteer manning this location – the competitor team is responsible for cleanup and retrieving any fuel and fuel containers you may bring. :eave nothing behind.

Note this is a REFUEL ZONE and not a SERVICE.

SERVICE AREA OVERVIEW MAP








TRAILER PARKING MAP



SATURDAY OVERVIEW MAP




SUNDAY OVERVIEW MAP




STAGE 1/4 MAP (Cathedral)




STAGE 2/5 MAP (Dragon Trail)




STAGE 3/6 MAP (Under the Dragon)

SCRUTINEERING

To ensure scrutineering can be done in a timely manner, per RCR 9.3.1 all event required stickers and identification are to be on the competition vehicle **prior** to scrutineering. *Note each Team will receive two Flatirons Subaru sponsor stickers and two Grassroots Motorsports sponsor stickers that they are required to put on their car (unless the stickers are in good shape from a previous year).*

- Note we <u>require</u> a metal shovel for spill cleanup & for fires, per BLM request (Supplemental Regulations 10.5.f). Avoid using chemical-based fire extinguishers on the ground.
- Scrutineering schedule is **based on your registration order**, currently as follows:


