Park safely well away from competitor escape routes.</p> <p><b>HAMS:</b> When a Stage is HOT, only the Stage Crew, Net Control, Advance, Pace, and Sweep crews may transmit on the stage frequency. Others MUST call Net Control on Net Control Frequency and get permission to call on the stage frequency. In case of enacting a contingency plan for either Stage frequency or Net Control Repeater; this will be determined and announced *only* by Net Control or Chief of Communications, followed by Stage Captains / Chiefs advising their crews of the change.</p> <p>If QRM or QRN is encountered on your stage simplex frequency, please advise your Stage Start / Captain immediately, by phone call if needed.</p> <p>*Only* Stage Captain + Start HAM + Net Control will determine and announce any frequency rotation to alternate "Alpha" or "Bravo".</p> <p><b>ROAD MARSHALS:</b> Please keep a log of all cars starting - MOST IMPORTANT: <u>In the event a car does not pass your position within THREE cars of its starting sequence, get this information to the Stage Captain, who may initiate search procedures.</u></p> <p>Everyone must follow all <u>Amateur Radio rules</u> at all times: ID at least every 5-10 minutes if communicating.                  No profanity; be courteous at all times to anyone on the frequency. Always move to the <b>Chat frequency 147.52</b> for non-essential</p>
